


UCA continues its mission

Present suffering, future glory

All Bible verses are in NKJV.



Romans 8:18-25 states that, "18For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with

the glory which shall be revealed in us. 19For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. 20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; 21 because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. 22 For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now. ²³Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body. 24For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees? 25But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.

Why do negative things happen in your life? The present time is marked by sufferings because of man's fall into sin. It is stated in Romans 8:19-22, "19 For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. 20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; 21 because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. ²² For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now.

The whole creation suffers because of man's fall into sin. It is written in Genesis 3:17-19, "17Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it': "Cursed is the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat of it All the days of your life. 18 Both thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you, And you shall eat the herb of the field. 19In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread Till you return to the ground, For out of it you were taken; For dust you are, And to dust you shall return."

All believers suffer because of man's fall into sin, as stated in Acts 9:16, "For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name's sake." It is also written in 2 Corinthians 11:23-28, "23 Are they ministers of Christ?—I speak as a fool—I am more: in labors more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequently, in deaths often. 24From the Jews five times I received forty stripes minus one. 25Three times I was beaten with rods; once I was stoned; three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I have been in the deep; 26in journeys often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils of my own countrymen, in perils of the Gentiles, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren; 27in weariness and toil, in sleeplessness often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness-28 besides the other things, what comes upon me daily: my deep concern for all the churches. Isaiah 53:3 says that "He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

We need to think biblically about

suffering so that we will grow through it rather than be destroyed by it. "For I consider" means reckon, think about, and ponder. Romans 8:18 states that, "For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us." It is written in, 1 Peter 5:8-10, "8Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. 9Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world. 10 But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you. It is said in 2 Corinthians 4:16-18, "16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. 17For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, 18 while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal

The fact of suffering does not undermine the fact that God has a plan and that He will accomplish His plan. The creation was subjected to futility "in hope". Romans 8:20-22 says that, "20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; 21because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. ²²For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now." The analogy of birth pains; the outcome is the hope of new life.

The future will be marked by glory for believers as God fulfills all that He has promised us. First, the future

glory is not totally revealed to us yet, but it includes the revealing of all that God has promised for us. It is written in 2 Thessalonians 2:14, "To which He called you by our gospel. for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ." Glory includes all of God's promises to bestow on us the unfathomable riches of Christ. Ephesians 3:8 says that, "To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ."

Second, the future glory includes the full renewal of creation to its original perfection and purpose.

Third, the future glory includes our freedom from sin and its corruption, including the full redemption of our bodies, as stated in Romans 8:21, "Because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God."

Fourth, the future glory is guaranteed by our present possession of the Holy Spirit, the first fruits of our redemption. The privileges of being God's adopted children as written in Romans 8:15-16, "15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." 16The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God."

Keep your eyes on the future promised glory and you will preserve in present sufferings with hope. It is written in Romans 8:25, "But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance."

The key of persevering in suffering with hope is to keep your eyes on the promised future glory. It is said in Romans 8:28, "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose."

1 SAMUEL 12:24 (NKJV)

Only fear the Lord, and serve Him in truth with all your heart; for consider what great things He has done for you.






