




**Exodus** (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup>Then all the congregation of the children of Israel set out on their

journey from the Wilderness of Sin, according to the commandment of the Lord, and camped in Rephidim; but there was no water for the people to drink. 2Therefore the people contended with Moses, and said, "Give us water, that we may drink." So Moses said to them, "Why do you contend with me? ### Introduction

In times of life's difficulties, trials, and all kinds of adversities, we tend to question God. Where is God? Is there really God? My life is overwhelmed with trials, and God is not there to help me.

This is a sad reality, many professing Christian acts in this way. They forgot that God is God, He never change. In times like these, our spiritual maturity is being put to test.

### How do we respond in these times? 1.Remember God is always present.

He is an omnipresent God, ready to help in times of need. During these times we must exercise our "spiritual maturity". How we react or respond to trials and all kinds of adversity is an indication of how mature and how strong faith you have in God. Trials of all kinds lead us to be totally dependent to God. David declared:

### Psalm 139:7-12 (NKJV)

Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? 8If I ascend into heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there. 9If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, 10 Even there Your hand shall lead me, and Your right hand shall hold me. "If I say, "Surely the darkness shall fall on me," Even the night shall be light about me; 12Indeed, the darkness shall not hide from You, but the night shines as the day; The darkness and the light are both alike to You.

### Hebrews 13:5 (NKJV)

Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake vou."

### Deuteronomy 31:8 (NKJV)

"And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed."

#### 2. Remember God is Faithful.

#### Exodus 17:5-7 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup>And the Lord said to Moses, "Go on before the people, and take with you some of the elders of Israel. Also take in your hand your rod with which you struck the river, and go. 6Behold, I will stand before you there on the rock in Horeb; and you shall strike the rock, and water will come out of it, that the people may drink." And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel. 7So he called the name of the place Massah and Meribah, because of the contention of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the Lord, saying, "Is the Lord among us or not?"

God did not punish, chastise or show anger to the Israelites for their attitude. God just gave instruction to Moses on what to do to the thirsty Israelites. Moses struck the stone with his rod and water came out.

Are you thirsty in life? Jesus Christ alone can satisfy your thirst.

### John 4:13-14 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup>Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, 14but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I

shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

### 3. Trust God when He is silent.

David experiences God's silence in his life.

### Psalm 13:1-2 (NKJV)

1How long, O Lord? Will You forget me forever? How long will You hide Your face from me? 2How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? How long will my enemy be exalted over me? When God is silent, like David, continue to trust Him in faith. Faith is hoping for God's promises and enjoying such promises now, even if they are yet to come in the future.


### Psalm 13:5-6 (NKJV)

To understand God, always trust and have faith in Him. Amen!




