Christian Living: *True Gospel*

Galatians 1:3-5 (NKJV)

³Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ, ⁴who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, ⁵to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

Apostle Paul greets the Galatians with an expression of the gospel.

1. Paul prays that the Galatians might receive grace and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
2. Paul emphasizes that the Lord Jesus Christ gave Himself for our sins in order that He might deliver us from this evil age in accordance with God's will.
3. In view of the good work of Jesus, Paul praises God.

Galatians 1:6-10

⁶I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, ⁷which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. ⁸But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. ⁹As we

have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed. ¹⁰For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ.

Apostle Paul identifies the reason for his writing.

1. Paul is amazed that the Galatians have so quickly deserted the Lord who called them by the grace of Christ for a different gospel.
2. Paul recognizes that there are some who are stirring the Galatians up and who want to distort the gospel of Jesus.
3. Paul pronounces a curse upon anyone who might proclaim a gospel that overturns the one which he preached to them (the apostolic team, an angel, anyone).
4. Paul is speaking to persuade men as a servant of God and not to please men.

What is the True Gospel?

The True Gospel was given a preliminary definition in verses 3-5 and can be discovered by the true seekers of God throughout the Bible.

- The results of the gospel are grace and peace to those who received it by faith.

- When we accepted Jesus, we accepted the grace and peace of God.
- When they rejected Jesus, they rejected the grace and peace of God.

The gospel is the result of the finished work of Jesus Christ. His death on the cross fulfilled the law and created the way for us to be forgiven of our sins and be delivered from this present evil age.

So, those who believe and received Jesus (faith)

- is given the right to become children of God (the will of God) (John 1:12)
- will inherit eternal life (the promise of God) (John 3:16)
- can do good works (His workmanship) (Ephesians 2:10)

What is the other gospel?

- Any teachings which make the finished works of Jesus inadequate
- Any teachings which pervert (distort or change) the gospel of Christ

A man-made message (not rooted in the gospel of Christ) is made to please men. It leads us to believe

(deceive us) that anything we do can please God altogether.

- through sacrifices (1 Samuel 15:22 - to obey is better than sacrifice)
- through good works (Ephesians 2:9 - not of works, lest anyone should boast)
- through abstinence to certain food and doing various rituals (fleshly ordinances) (Hebrews 9:10)
- concerned only with foods and drinks, various washings, and fleshly ordinances imposed until the time of reformation)

The Gospel is the standard which must be practiced and preserved. The Gospel is not a one-time experience (when we receive Jesus). It is the message which we continue to believe and to live (holiness).

The communion represents the essence of the Gospel. It reminds us that the salvation we have obtained is through the death, burial, and resurrection of our Lord when we eat the bread (the body of Christ) and drink the blood (the life of Jesus). We are reminded that even when we believed in the gospel, it can

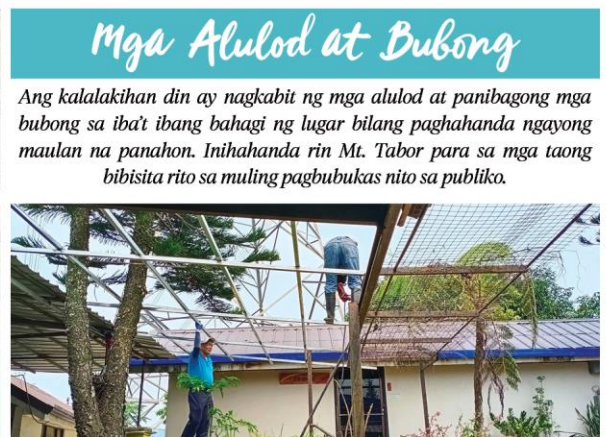

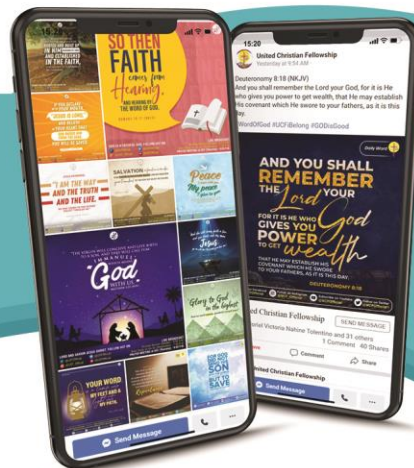


ONLINE WORSHIP SERVICES

2 Timothy 2:3-4

³You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

⁴No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.

A Christian believer is to be a strong soldier for Jesus Christ.

As a soldier for Jesus, we have this cause/purpose which is to reach out for a dying world with the message of life.

Message: People can have life now—a life that is abundant and overflowing. And they can live eternally with the loving Father.

1. A strong soldier endures, suffers, and shares hardship with all other soldiers.

A strong soldier does not:

- lay behind
- avoid or neglect his duty
- seek to escape the battle
- refuse to carry his load
- give in to the enemy
- deny the cause/purpose
- reject the commander (Jesus)
- hide from toil

A strong soldier stands with other soldiers and suffers the hardship of the struggle with them. A strong soldier is in the “military” (fellowship of the believer) and do not fight the battle alone.

A strong soldier sacrifices all that he/she is and has for Christ and His cause.

- He/she gives all his mind, body, and soul to Christ and His cause of salvation.
- He/she gives all of his time and energy to Christ and His promise of eternal life.
- He/she gives all of his possession to Christ and His mission of world evangelism.

A strong soldier of Jesus Christ suffers hardship – no matter what the hardship is.

- He/she suffers hardship so that other people may be saved from sin and starvation, evil and disease, corruption and emptiness, wrong and loneliness, and death and judgment.

Matthew 10:22

And you will be hated by all for My Name's sake. But he who endures to the end will be saved.

1 Corinthians 15:58

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.

1 Timothy 6:12

Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

James 1:12

Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

2. A strong soldier does not become entangled with the affairs of this world. He stays focused on the cause of Christ.

A strong soldier never diverts from

the cause. He does not become entangled with the affairs of this world. His purpose is not:

- to make money
- to party
- to seek possessions
- to focus upon this life
- to covet position
- to indulge the flesh
- to live in pleasure

Romans 12:2

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

2 Corinthians 6:17-18

¹⁷Therefore “Come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you.” ¹⁸“I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty.”

2 Thessalonians 3:6

But we command you, brethren, in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you withdraw from every brother who walks disorderly and not according to the tradition which he received from us.

3. A strong soldier pleases and obeys his commander-in-chief.

He/she seeks to please the King who has chosen him/her to be a soldier.

A strong soldier focuses upon his Commander and His words. He does not look to anyone else.

- Not to another commander, for another commander is a false commander
- Not to himself, seeking to satisfy the lusts of his own desire
- Not to loved ones, who would have his time and waste his energy
- Not to those in the world, who seek his energy and pleasures

A strong soldier is loyal and committed to his Commander-in-chief. He/she obeys his Commander and focuses upon pleasing Him and Him alone.

Matthew 7:21

Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.

1 Thessalonians 2:4

But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, even so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts.

Conclusion

A strong soldier knows his Commander and is loyal to Him and His call.
