Equipping for God's ministry

In 2019, UCFTS opened its doors once again to students who were willing to take up the challenge in achieving their full potential to be able to serve the Lord, wherein it offers Bachelor in Theology. Now, even during the pandemic, UCFTS continues its mission to equip workers for the Lord even through online platforms.

With the new normal of education, which is distance learning, UCFTS shifted its mode of teaching to online with the use of Gnomio, prerecorded videos posted in respective Facebook groups, and submission of requirements through Google Drive. Aside from these, students are also provided with modules.

To acknowledge the students' hard work in striving to excel in their



studies, they will be recognized and awarded during its Recognition Day. And once they graduate, some of them may be called to be pastors, teachers, apostles, prophets, or evangelists, who will serve the Lord faithfully.





Psalm 78:38-39

³⁸But He,
being full of
compassion full
of compassion,
forgave their
iniquity, and
did not destroy

them. Yes, many a time He turned His anger away, and did not stir up all His wrath; ³⁹For He remembered that they were but flesh, a breath that passes away and does not come again.

Compassion is a feeling of distress through the ills of others. It refers to God's compassion.

Romans 9:15

For He says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whomever I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whomever I will have compassion."

- To yearn with compassion

Matthew 9:36

But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.

Matthew 14:14

And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.

Matthew 15:32

I. Mercy and kindness flow from compassion.

Matthew 18:33

3. Remember the compassionate Christ on the cross.
