Okra



Ang okra ay mayaman sa *antioxidants* na maaaring makabawas sa tiyana ng pagkakaroon ng maluluhang sakit at pamamaga ng katawan. Makatutulong din ito sa pangkalahatang kalusugan.

Higit na kapansin-pansin na ang okra ay mayroon *polyphenols* na makatutulong sa kalusugan ng puso at utak.

Ang okra ay mababa sa *calories* ngunit puno naman ng nutrisyon tulad ng Vitamin C at Vitamin K. Ang Vitamin Cito ay tumutulong sa pagsusuporta at pagpapalakas ng *immune system*.

Ang prutas na ito ay walang katulad dahil nagbibigay ito ng protina—isang bagay na wala sa ibang mga prutas at gulay.

Ilang mga pag-aaral din ang nagpapakita na ang okra ay nakatutulong sa pagkontrol ng lebel ng *sugar*. Dahil sa okra, nababawasan ang tsansa na makakuha ng *sugar* habang nagtutunaw ng pagkain.

Sili Sigang



Ang siling sigang o siling haba ay magandang solusyon para sa pagpapapayat. Dahil mabilis tumunaw ng taba ang sili, nakatutulong ito sa pagpapapayat at nagpapabilis ito ng metabolismo ng ating katawan.

Maliban dito, nakatutulong ang sili para mabawasan ang tsansang magkaroon ng iba't ibang mga sakit tulad ng atake sa puso at stroke dahil nakakapagpababa ito ng kolesterol.

Epektibong lunas din ito para sa mga *anemic* dahil itong likas na mapagkukunan ng *iron*.

Dalandan



Ang dalandan ay maaaring hatiin at ihalo sa mga *fruit bowl* o *green salad*. Ang katas naman ito ay maaaring ihalo sa mga *shake* at *smoothie*. Puwede rin itong gamitin upang makagawa ng matamis at malasang salsa para sa isda.

Ang dalandan ay naglalaman ng *Calcium* at *Vitamin A* na siyang nagpapanatili ng kalusugan ng mga buto at mata ng isang tao. Ang *antioxidant* na kasama ng *Vitamin C* at *antibacterial* na katangian nito ay ang dahilan kung bakit maganda ang dalandan para sa ating balat.

Kangkong



Ang kangkong ay mayroong mataas na lebel ng *iron*. Para sa taong *anemic* o may mababang dugo, maganda itong idagdag sa pagkain upang malabanan ang *anemia* dahil nakadadagdag ito ng *hemoglobin* o dugo. Inirerekомenda rin ito para sa mga buntis na hangangailangan ng *iron* sa kanilang katawan.

Ang kangkong ay sagana sa *zeaxanthin* at *lutein* na siyang taglay din ng mata ng tao. Ito ang pumoprotektika sa ating mga mata mula sa masamang epektong dulot ng sikat ng araw. Bukod pa rito, ang *zeaxanthin* at *lutein* ay makatutulong upang maiwasan ang *macular degeneration* at katarata na siyang pangunahing sanhi ng pagkabulag.

Baguio Beans



Ang green beans o Baguio Beans ay mataas sa *Vitamin K* at naglalaman din ito ng tamang dami ng *Calcium*. Ang mga nutrisyon ito ay mahalaga para sa pagpapanatili ng malalakas at malulusog na buto.

Ang pagkain ng Baguio Beans ay maaaring makatutulong sa pagbabawas ng tiyansa ng magkaroon ng sakit sa puso, atake sa puso at stroke dahil mayroon itong mataas na lebel ng *flavonoids*.

Madre de Agua



Ang bawat parte ng isang puno ng langka ay mayroong kaniyang praktikal na gamit. Ang mismong prutas nito ay maaaring konsumuin ng mga tao bilang pagkain.

Samantala, ang mga dahon naman ng puno nito ay maaaring imaging pagkain ng mga hayop.

Ginagamit naman ng mga karpintero ang kahoy at mga sanga ng puno upang makagawa ng iba't ibang mga kagamitan at istruktura.

Sa kabilang banda, ginagamit ang ugat ng punong ito bilang isang uri ng tradisional na gamot para sa lagnat, *diarrhea*, hika at mga sakit sa balat.

Ang santol ay maganda para sa mga *diabetic* dahil sagana ito sa *fiber*. Ito ay nagpapabagal sa pagtunaw ng pagkain na nababawas ng lebel ng *sugar*. Maganda rin ito para makontrol ang timbang ng katawan.

Visions help us to understand the velocity of serving God - the changes, the greatness, the goodness of God. What your faith will operate is what you keep seeing in your mind. Kailangan maipakita natin sa Diyos na nakahanda tayong sumunod o baka nasanay na tayong mag 'sorry, Lord'. What I will do, I will serve God and I will look only unto Jesus.

My training in ministry helps me to endure the things that I am enduring right now. Bakit ako magrereklamo? Nangako naman ako noong una pa lang sa Diyos. Bakit ako magrereklamo? Alam ko naman na supisyente ang Diyos. Bakit ako magrereklamo? Alam ko naman na ang Diyos ang nagpo-provide ng lahat ng pangangailangan ko. Siya na nga lang ang lahat sa akin, magrereklamo pa ako sa Kanya? If you murmur, then disappointment will always come into your life.

Noong nakaraan binigyan ako ng tungkod sa Tabor. Hirap na hirap kami kasi umuulan. Ang putik kapag bumababa kami papuntang ilog. Ngayon, dalawa na ang tungkod ko. Noong unang araw ay isa lang, Kasi baka kapag isa lang, madulas ako. Kapag nadulas ako sa taas, pupulutin ako sa baba. But it never stopped me. Nobody can stop me. I have to fulfill my promise to God because my promise is not to anybody else but to God. Hindi ako nangako sa tao, nangako ako sa Diyos. Kaya nga ang pangako rin ng Diyos sa akin ay lagi niyang tinutupad because God never fails. He never failed me even a single time.

When things seemed to be a failure, I always look at it as a positive faith. Your life changes. You change it through faith. You don't look at problems, you look at victories. Mayroon kasi sa atin ang ugali, kapag may problema, nakatingin sa problema tapos iiyakan pa. Ang Diyos ang iyakan mo, so we can gain and establish a core of ministry that is called by God. Sabi ng Romans 1:16-17, "For I am not ashamed of the Gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith as it is written, 'The righteous shall live by faith.'

Finally, our slogan in 2 Timothy 2:15, "Do your best to present yourself to God." It says do your best. Kapag sinabi niyang do your best, kung sino ka, because God called you for who you are. You

don't need to pretend. Ang kailangan mo lang ay ilabas mo kung sino ka, kung gaano iyong pagmamahal mo sa Diyos, kung gaano yung pagkatao mo sa Diyos. Ang Diyos kasi ang nakakaalam ng lahat. And He never fails, so do your best to present yourself to God as one approved.

You need to be approved. Ano ba ang ibig sabihin nito? It means you know that you really have to do what is right. It is not according to the flesh. It is not because you do not want to struggle. You will struggle sa paglilingkod sa Panginoon lalo kapag hindi ka sanay.

Kapag sanay ka sumunod sa Diyos, hindi ka magrereklamo. Ang nagrereklamo ay iyong hindi pa nababago ang kaniyang paradigm. Ang kaniyang utak ay hindi pa nabago.

God supplies everything. But the question is this, Siya ba talaga ang Lord mo o Siya lang ang provider mo? It is in the most crucial time of our lives that God never fails. Minsan hindi mo na kailangan humingi kasi alam ng Diyos ang kailangan mo. Hindi ka pagkukulangin ng Diyos. We do not lose hope. In everything that we do, we know God is in control. The devil will try to deceive you. He will try to manipulate you. He would try everything to drive you crazy. It might seem that some things are not in control, but no, God is still in control.

Ang nagsisilbi sa Panginoon ay wala ng sariling ambisyon. Kapag mayroon ka pang sariling ambisyon, hindi ka makakapaglilingkod. You are missing the point of the Biblical call. The Biblical call is for you to change your paradigm. You change your thoughts, you see the visions,

and you begin by faith.

Our church is called by God. And serving God is my utmost joy, love, and peace. He is truly a loving God. I can vouch for that. Sometimes we fail to take note of the most crucial and most important priority in our life. What is that? It is to put God

Serving God is my utmost joy, love, and peace. He is truly a loving God. I can vouch for that.

first. If you put God second, then you are in trouble. That is where the devil will come in. Why? The devil will put himself first. But everytime you put God first, the devil has no room in your life.

God is in control and in everything we do, He is there. Your training in the seminary is just one thing to win soul for Christ – our only success.

Ano pa ang tatapsin ko para makapaghalinga rin ako Lord?' Sabi Niya, 'Anak, hindi ka pa puwedeng magpahinga. Marami pang gagawin.' 'Lord, bakit hindi mo rin sila kausapin?' The Lord was so silent.

Remember this, serving God is doing what you just can do. Hindi ka naman pagagawain ng Diyos ng mga bagay na hindi mo kaya. Kapag inutos sa iyo, magagawa mo. Kaya nga inutos sa iyo kasi alam ng Diyos na magagawa mo. The Bible says, 'God is faithful. He will not allow anything that you will do that you cannot do.'

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

Four Principles

1. Need to change our concept (new paradigm)

- You cannot change what's in your hand, until you decide to change what is in your head (lifestyle).

Introduction

What satisfies the needs of a man?

I. The Seeking Sinner**A. His Prominence (v. 2)**

1. A Man of Position: Zacchaeus was a tax collector, thus he worked for Rome.
2. A Man of Power: By virtue of his position and of his contract with Rome, Zacchaeus was a man of power in Jericho.

B. His Preoccupation (v. 3a)

1. His Desire: Zacchaeus had a desire to see the Lord.
2. His Desperate Need: Zacchaeus may not have fully understood all that was happening in his heart and life, but this man has a desperate need to get to Jesus. He may have disguised his actions as pure curiosity, but deep down, this man had a deep-seated need to come to Jesus Christ.

C. His Problem (v. 3b)

1. The Crowd: Zacchaeus was a little man, and he could not see over the crowd. They were between him and where Jesus was to pass by.
2. The Condition: Zacchaeus had a personal problem that kept him from getting close to the Lord.

D. His Persistence (v. 4)

1. Zacchaeus climbed a tree to get a glimpse of the Lord as he passed by that day. This little man allowed nothing, not the crowd nor his condition, stand in between him and his seeing the Lord Jesus Christ.

II. The Seeking Savior (v. 5)

- A. Jesus Came to Him:** Jesus comes to the dead sinner and offers life through Himself.

Matthew 20:28

"Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

- B. Jesus Considered Him:** When Jesus stopped under that tree that day, He knew everything there was to know about Zacchaeus, yet He still loved him and still had compassion on him.

1 Samuel 16:7

But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

C. Jesus Called Him: Jesus is on the way to Jerusalem where He is to die for the sin of the world, but still He has the time to stop and reach out to this one little, wicked man.

1. It was an Urgent Call: It is still urgent today! The Lord may come. Death may come. Salvation is nothing to be played around with.

2. It was an Unmistakable Call: Zacchaeus knew that the Lord was looking for something more than just a place to visit for the day. Jesus was interested in one thing—He was after his heart.

III. The Spectacular Salvation: Did Zacchaeus get saved?

A. Zacchaeus received the Savior. (v. 6)

1. Obedience: Zacchaeus obeyed the Lord's call.
2. Open Heart: Zacchaeus freely gave himself to Jesus.
3. Obvious Joy: Zacchaeus was overjoyed at the opportunity to be with Jesus. Joy is always a byproduct of genuine salvation.

B. Zacchaeus repented of his sins. (vv. 7-8)

1. There was confession.

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

2. There was a change.

Luke 19:8

Then Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord, I give half of my goods to the poor; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore fourfold."

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

C. Zacchaeus was redeemed with a great salvation.

1. The Mercy of Christ: Jesus took this little wicked man, and, in one instant, saved him forever.

Luke 19:9

And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham."

2. The Mission of Christ: Jesus reminds us that He was here to save sinners and that this is His mission yet today.

Luke 19:10

"For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."


