Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

Introduction

A compass is a device that shows the cardinal directions used for navigation and geographic orientation. The uses are:

- Tell which direction you are travelling or heading
- Tell which direction an object is from you
- Keep you following a straight line of travel
- Map orientation

In the military, a compass aids in determining the location of their target enemy.

A Christian also has a compass that gives him direction in his everyday life for a holy and righteous living, which when he follows, he will not get lost. The Christian compass is no other than the Lord Jesus Christ.

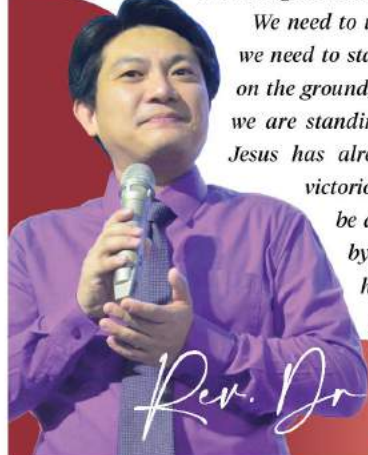

The Bible says the source of our strength must come from the Lord because if the source of strength comes from us, then human strength is defeated or will be defeated by the enemy.

The Word of the Lord gives us a clear picture about spiritual warfare. There is really a spiritual warfare going on. There is what we call the forces of good and the forces of evil. You either on the side of the good (the side of God) or you are on the other side. We all know that Jesus already gained the victory on the cross. We are already declared as victorious. That is why the Bible declares us as more than conquerors, meaning Jesus has already declared victory. Now, because Jesus is victorious on the cross, then there is no more war. But then, the Bible gives us a definition of standing on our ground.



We need to understand why the Bible says that we need to stand on our ground. When we stand on the ground, we are not standing to attack, but we are standing on a point of victory. It means Jesus has already conquered. Jesus is already victorious. But that part of victory can still be attacked by the enemy or reclaimed by the enemy. That position that you have can be stolen by the enemy if you do not stand on your ground

and defend the victory that Jesus did. Jesus has given us weapons and armor.

I want to discuss about the source of that power. It has been frequently discussed especially on small groups, "Wear your armor. Wear the armor of God before you pray. Always wear your armor every day." But sometimes, you tend to forget that wearing the armor is not merely about wearing them. Remember, this armor is our spiritual armor, and these are not physical in nature. Most of the time, instead of depending on God, we depend on the armor as if it is really the armor that protects us. Remember, it is not the armor, but the one who gives the armor. It is not how effective the armor is or saying that 'Lord, please give me the breastplate of righteousness because I need the breastplate right now. I need the shield of faith. Please, grant me the shield of faith.' It is as if the armor can be attained individually. And so, when we pray, we are saying, 'I am wearing this and this and this. So, for this day, I am just wearing the following armor. The other armor will be worn later on.' Well, that is not the case.

The Bible says the source of our strength must come from the Lord because if the source of strength comes from us, then human strength is defeated or will be defeated by the enemy. You cannot use your own strength to win against spiritual being. So whenever you say 'Lord, give me the armor', and you have that imagination that you are using the armor to defeat the enemy, that is not Biblical. How can you defeat the enemy? Your source of strength and source of your power must come from the Lord.

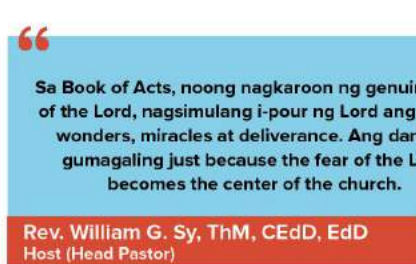

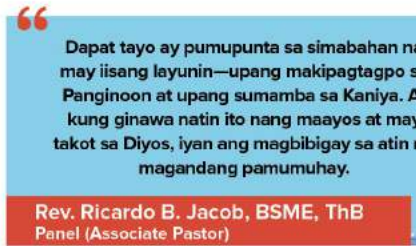

What happens when the fear of the Lord is missing inside the church?

- A counterfeit and perverted fear takes place.
- The counterfeit of truth is deception.
- The counterfeit of knowledge is carnal knowledge.
- Perfect love casts out fear (worldly fear).
