B. Know that the Lord, He is God (v. 3).

- God is a Spirit.





James 1:2-4 (NKJV)

²My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, ³knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. ⁴But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

Introduction

- The word "trial" refers to all kinds of sufferings, persecutions, and troubles.
- Trials are sometimes brought to the believers' lives so that God can test the sincerity of their faith.
- Every trial becomes a test of faith designed to strengthen us.

Romans 8:35-39 (NKJV)

35Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36As it is written: "For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter." 37Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. 38For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, 39nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 5:3-4 (NKJV)

Why does God allows trials to test and try us?

I. They are allowed by God to humble, teach, and discipline us.

- Remember the Lord your God.
