
UCA Founder Rev. Dr. William Sy emphasizes the goodness and faithfulness of the Lord as he officially opens the weeklong celebration.

Students performed to the best of their abilities. They showed their God-given talents in dancing through The Moves. With their amazing dance moves, students received love and support throughout the week.











































