



#### Ephesians 5:15-17 (NKJV)

¹⁵Kaya't mag-ingat kayo kung paano kayo namumuhay. Mamuhay kayong tulad ng matatalino at di tulad ng mga mangmang. <sup>16</sup>Gamitin ninyo nang lubusan para sa mabuti ang bawat pagkakataon, sapagkat puno ng kasamaan ang kasalukuyang panahon. Greatness in God's kingdom is a matter of service. If you want to become great, you have to serve the Lord. Serve like servants, not as lords. Serve like a slave, not as kings. We have to serve God. If you want to be great in the kingdom of God, serve the Lord. Let us be servants. Do not act as lords. Do not act as kings. We have to be servants of God.

Greatness of God's kingdom is a matter of humility. Whoever wants to be first, must be a slave of all. What is the difference between a servant and slave? In the New Testament, kapag sinabing servant ay malaya ka. Pero pagdating sa Old Testament, kapag sinabing slave ay wala ka nang Kalayaan—binili

ka na ng amo mo habambuhay. But you have the chance na puwede kang umuwi, puwede kang maggive up after seven years pero kung gusto mo pang mag-stay, you can extend your contract as a slave.

If you want to become great,
you have to serve the Lord.

Serve like servants, not as lords.

Serve like a slave, not as kings.

Ano ba talaga ang ginawa ng Panginoon sa ating buhay? He is an example of humility. Ibinigay ni Hesus ang Kaniyang buhay sa atin bilang mga tao. He gave priority to all of us. Binigyan Niya ng kahulugan ang ating buhay. Binigyan Niya tayo ng patuloy na pagpapala. Dahil ang nagpapakababa ay itinataas ng Diyos.

Jesus is looking for a person who is humble. The highest virtue that Jesus is looking for is humility. It is a virtue of all virtues. Without humility, all the kindness, goodness, and faithfulness of a person ay hindi uugnay o tatama sa buhay ng isang lingkod na walang kapakumbabaan. Ang isang Kristiyano ay nagpapakumbaba sapagkat ang mga Kristiyanong



nagpapakumbaba mayroong kapayapaan kaniyang puso. Ang Kristiyanong nagpapakumbaba mayroong pagpapalang nakalaan sa kaniyang buhay. Ang Kristiyanong nagpapakababa patuloy na itataas at itinataas ng ating Diyos sa Kaniyang kaluwalhatian.



People are always thinking on what position they can be. Ang tawag doon ay, 'Lord, paano naman ako maglilingkod kung wala akong posisyon?' Well, position is not serving, but the view of the world is that you have to be in position for you to serve. Ito ang isa sa pananaw ng anti-Christ, ang pananaw na kailangan nasa posisyon ka para ikaw ay makapaglingkod. Sabi niya, 'Kasi pastor ang daming mga balakid kapag wala

ako sa posisyon.' Sabi ng Salita ng Diyos, 'If God is with you, who will

be against you?' If God is with you. Now, that is a big if.

Iba ang pananaw ng mundo sa pananaw ng Diyos. First, greatness is of God. Laging sa Diyos lang. So, God is preparing to bestow such honor (to sit on His right and on His left) upon some. God alone determines who will reign with Him.

God measures the level

of your commitment by your

dedication and by the level

of your commitment to the Lord.

Second, greatness is not dominion over others. Mayroong dalawang pananaw. First is that people look at them sa kanilang power, fame at recognition. Kaya nga ang iba nakikita ko

kapag pumupunta ako sa opisina nila, maraming certificate ang nakasalpak sa kanilang pader. Because they want to show the people that they are somebody. In this world, it is applicable. But in the kingdom of God, it is not.


Anything that you do that is not rooted in the Word of God will come to ruin. Sabi ng Bible, 'Those who exalt themselves will be humbled and those who humble themselves will be exalted.' Kaya ang hirap maglingkod sa Diyos kasi ang pananaw ng tao ay hiwalay sa pananaw ng Diyos. How can you change the view of the person? It must be based on the Word of God.

Now this is the question, how can you become great? Sabi sa John 5:42-44, 'But I know you. I know that you do not have the love of God in your hearts. I have come in my Father's Name, and you do not accept Me; but if someone else comes in his own name, you will accept him. How can you believe since you accept glory from one another but do not seek the glory that comes from the only God?'

Ang Salita ng Diyos ay hindi nakabase sa edad o estado mo. Nandiyan ang Salita ng Diyos. Basahin mo. Paano mo sasabihin na tinawag ka ng Diyos kung ang pananaw mo ay nasa mundo pa rin? Ang glory na inaasam-asam mo ay sa mundo pa rin. Kaya ang gusto nila ang high and mighty. Ang hindi nila naiintindihan, what is high and mighty without God? It's nothing.

Third, greatness is serving others. Sabi ng Bible, great are those who minister. Pero ang greatest daw ay those who are servants. Pero ang tanong, among sa

mga naglilingkod, who is the greatest? Siya ang servant. At binigay Niya ang example na iyon by washing their feet. God measures the level of your commitment by your dedication and by the level of your commitment to the Lord. At iyon ang malaking pagkakaiba kasi ang Diyos ang mabibigay sa iyo ng honor.



## Pleasing God

2 Corinthians 5:1-10 (NKJV)

For we know that if our earthly house, this tent, is destroyed, we have a building

from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. <sup>2</sup>For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed with our habitation which is from heaven, <sup>3</sup>if indeed, having been clothed, we shall not be found naked. <sup>4</sup>For we who are in this tent groan, being burdened, not because we want to be unclothed, but further clothed, that mortality may be swallowed up by life. <sup>5</sup>Now He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who also has given us the Spirit as a guarantee. <sup>6</sup>So we

are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. <sup>7</sup>For we walk by faith, not by sight. <sup>8</sup>We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord. <sup>9</sup>Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him. <sup>10</sup>For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

A "tent" was a familiar symbol of what was temporary. Our physical bodies are only temporary structures, but God is preparing new bodies for us.

#### How do you keep your eyes fixed on what is unseen and eternal rather than what is seen and temporary?

- What happens if our earthly tent (human body) is destroyed (v. 1)?
- Why do we groan in the meantime (vv. 2-4)?
- What has God given us (v. 5)?
- Walk by faith, not by sight (vv. 6-7).
- While we live, we make it our aim to do what (v. 9)?
- What do we receive there (v. 10)?

#### 1. Our Aim

#### Hebrews 13:20-21

<sup>20</sup>Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, <sup>21</sup>make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

### 2. Find out what is acceptable. Ephesians 5:8-10

<sup>8</sup>For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light <sup>9</sup>(for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), <sup>10</sup>finding out what is acceptable to the Lord.

#### 1 Thessalonians 4:1

Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord Jesus that you should abound more and more, just as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God.

#### 3. Serving God by heart

#### **Galatians 1:10**

For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ.

#### Colossians 3:22-24

<sup>22</sup>Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eye service, as menpleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God. <sup>23</sup>And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, <sup>24</sup>knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

### 4. Lead/living by the Spirit Romans 8:5-8

<sup>5</sup>For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. <sup>6</sup>For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. <sup>7</sup>Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. <sup>8</sup>So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.



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#### 1 Timothy 2:3-4 (NKJV)

<sup>3</sup>For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, <sup>4</sup>who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

merciful to me a sinner!" <sup>14</sup>I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

#### It belongs to those who are persecuted for the sake of Jesus Christ.

#### Matthew 5:10

Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Entering the kingdom of God is a glorious event for every one of us, but there is a warning.

#### -The way to the kingdom is narrow.

#### Luke 13:24-28

<sup>24</sup> Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I say to you, will seek to enter and will not be able. 25When once the Master of the house has risen up and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open for us,' and He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know you, where you are from,' 26then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets.' <sup>27</sup>But He will say, 'I tell you I do not know you, where you are from. Depart from Me, all you workers of iniquity.' 28 There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, and yourselves thrust out."

-The evil doers

#### 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

<sup>9</sup>Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, <sup>10</sup>nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

#### -The self-righteous

#### Matthew 5:20

For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.

# Why is the righteousness of the Pharisees not enough for them to enterthe kingdom of God?

Because they seek acceptance with God:

- By giving God formal worship instead of giving God a confession of unworthiness and their need of Him in a personal way
- By giving God good works instead of giving their hearts
- By giving God a clean and moral body instead of giving God a confession of needing spiritual help
- By giving only a part of their lives instead of giving God the total abandonment of themselves

Unfortunately, some of us are also doing these mistakes. We worship God and do good:

- To be respectable in the community
- -To seek the acceptance of God
- To have the fellowship of others
- Because we are sometimes forced to do so
- To feel comfortable within our own conscience
- To secure the approval of others

-Because we are taught to do good
Some of us feel that we must do good
to be acceptable to God. We tend to
work hard and do anything good in
our perspective in order to secure God's
acceptance.

Have we not learned the truth? We cannot do enough good to be perfectly acceptable to God.

Only the love of God, shown through Jesus Christ, and our faith and trust in Him are enough for us to be acceptable and be able to enter the kingdom of God.

God takes our faith and trust in Him and counts them as righteousness.

We sometimes miss the whole point. What God is after – the only thing that makes a person acceptable to God – is the giving of his all, his whole being over to God.

- Just like the man who sold everything just to take hold of the treasure
- Just like those who left their families and their priorities just to answer the

urgent call of the kingdom of God

- Just like the child who's full trust is in his father
- Just like the poor in spirit who acknowledges his emptiness apart from God
- -Just like the tax collector who humbled himself in front of God and seek His acceptance
- Just like the apostles and men of God who were not afraid of persecution but considered it as privilege to join in the suffering of our Lord Jesus Christ as they give their all to God

#### Conclusion

To enter the kingdom of God is to acknowledge God's love to us and surrendering our all for His glory and honor. God's love is enough.

#### Challenge

Let us serve God because He loved us first and our service is out of our pure love for Him. Our service is not for us to be acceptable; it is for us to accept our call of full surrender and obedience to God.
