Three Significant Character Traits of a Mature Christian

I. The mature Christian shares the Gospel regardless of trials and circumstances.

A. Paul remained faithful still.

- He did not grumble nor complain.
- He did not whine nor murmur.
- He did not curse God nor go to other religions.

B. The mature Christian never lets circumstances take control.

- Never let circumstances pull you down.
- Never compromise your testimony even in:
- a. trials and persecutions
- b. financial difficulties of bankruptcy
- c. sickness
- d. poverty

If we are living for Christ, we must know that God is in control of our lives. He will strengthen us to bear whatever circumstance may fall upon us. Instead, use the circumstances to witness in the saving power of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior.

II. The mature Christian shares the Gospel out of love and in good intention.

- It is not out of envy and strife, but of good will.
- It is not out of jealous and contentious spirit, but out of love to one another.
- It is not out of wrong motives, but out of unity in the body of Christ.



Top-notch education made accessible

In order to mold students to be globally competent, the Philippines upgraded its basic education program and implemented the K-12 Curriculum in 2015. The K-12 Curriculum covers Kindergarten and 12 years of basic education, which includes six years of primary education, four years of Junior High School (JHS), and two years of Senior High School (SHS). With two additional years, students will get a mastery of various concepts and skills that will help them prepare for future employment.

UCA as one of the SHS pioneers

In April 15, 2015, United Christian Academy (UCA) was one of the first few private schools in the Philippines that was granted with a Provisional Permit to Operate the Senior High School Program. With this, UCA prepared ahead of time in crafting its curriculum and developing modules to fit the new education program.



Granted with SHS vouchers



Aside from this, UCA was also granted with SHS vouchers from the Private Education Assistance Committee (PEAC), which offers tuition subsidy to students who are experiencing financial difficulties. This has truly been a blessing to the students for them to finish their studies without worrying about their tuition fee. Throughout the years, UCA was able to provide more than a thousand students with the opportunity to receive discounted tuition fee until their last year in senior high school.



Foundations for the Assurance of Salvation

1. The Word of God

a. Eternal Life 1 John 5:11-13 (NKJV)

"And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. ¹²He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. ¹³These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God.

John 3:36 (NKJV)

"He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

John 3:16 (KJV)

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Romans 1:16 (NKJV)

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

e. Child of God by Faith

Romans 8:14-17 (NKJV)

¹⁴For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. ¹⁵For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." ¹⁶The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, ¹⁷and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

2. The Works of Christ

a. Salvation is not by our works or merit.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NKJV)

⁸For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, ⁹not of works, lest anyone should boast.

b. Salvation is solely by Christ's person and work as a gift of God.

Acts 4:12 (NKJV)

"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

Philippians 3:8-9 (NKJV)

⁸Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ ⁹and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith.

3. The Witness of the Holy Spirit a. The Holy Spirit is called the Spirit of Truth.

John 14:16-17 (NKJV)

¹⁶And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—¹⁷the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor

knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

Titus 3:5 (NKJV)

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit.

b. The Holy Spirit opens the Word to our hearts.

Acts 14:16 (NKJV)

Now a certain woman named Lydia heard us. She was a seller of purple from the city of Thyatira, who worshiped God. The Lord opened her heart to heed the things spoken by Paul.

1John 4:6 (NKJV)

We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error.

c. The Holy Spirit takes the things of Christ and gives us understanding.

1 Corinthians 2:12-16 (NKJV)

¹²Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. 13These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 14But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 15But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one. 16 For "who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:7 (NKJV)

But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.

Conclusion

We need to draw our assurance from

Psalm 119:11, 16 (NKJV)

¹¹Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You. ¹⁶I will delight myself in Your statutes; I will not forget Your word.

faith in the facts of Scripture and not from our feelings. Our faith and thus our assurance must stand on the sure promises of the Bible rather than on our feelings. The biblical order is: FACTS—>FAITH—>FEELINGS

Feelings are the responders of the soul or heart. They are to follow and to respond to our understanding of the Scriptures, but they are never a safe guide to what we should believe or of the state of our salvation. This leads to the next point. We need to draw our assurance from faith in the facts of Scripture and not from our works. Works or the biblical changes that occur in our lives as a result of the grace of God can confirm the reality of our life with God. We must be ever so careful, however, in making such subjective ground the basis of our assurance, for when a believer is out of fellowship, he or she can have the appearance of an unbeliever especially if the condition lasts for any length of time.

Philippians 1:6 (NKJV)

Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.

John 10:28 (NKJV)

And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

The sustenance of the believer (Part 1)

2 Corinthians 4:7-12 (NKJV)

⁷But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may

be of God and not of us. 8We are hardpressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; ⁹persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed— 10 always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. 11For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. 12So then death is working in us, but life in you.

As sincere and diligent believers who follow the will of God in his life, we face trials after trials. We experience fatigue, weariness, strain, pressure, troubles, doubt, criticism, persecution, conflict, opposition, and even more. That is why we need to have a strong spirit of endurance. We need a special power to sustain us. The question is, what is the sustenance of believers?

1. The presence of God sustains us.

2 Corinthians 4:7

But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.

God's presence is precious and priceless treasure. It enters our earthen vessels. We are weak, worthless, corruptible, and perishable, yet God's wonderful presence is placed in us.

a. God's presence is the power to convert and transform us into new creatures.

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he

is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Colossians 3:10

And have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him.

b. God's presence is the power to put His divine nature into us.

2 Peter 1:4

By which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

c. God's presence is the power to give us life, both abundant and eternal.

John 10:10(b)

I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

No man can convert and transform himself into an eternal being. Only the presence of God, this glorious treasure, can enter our lives and change us from a worthless and perishing vessel into an eternal being. The presence of God alone can sustain us through the power of His Holy Spirit.

2. The power of God sustains us.

2 Corinthians 4:8-9

⁸We are hard-pressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; 9persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed.

As believers and workers of God, we may experience trouble on every side (pressed, oppressed, and pressured), but God's power saves us from distress (being crushed and cramped in a place). We may be perplexed (be at a loss, doubting, wondering which

way togo, or unable to find an answer), but God's power saves us from despair (hopelessness, having no confidence or assurance, or having no sense of security). We may also be persecuted (ridiculed, opposed, slandered, censored, ignored, or abused), but God never forsakes (abandon or desert) those who put their faith and trust in Him. We may be struck down (knocked down, cast down, or smitten down), but God's power does not allow us to be destroyed (perish, die, or strike out). We may sometimes be knocked down, but we will never be knocked out. Our essence of being a Christian is not that we do not fall or fail, but as we fall, we rise up again. We can lose some of our battles, but we are not defeated in our quest for the Kingdom of God.

3. The spirit of dying daily sustains us.

2 Corinthians 4:10-12

¹⁰Always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. "For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. 12So then death is working in us, but life in you.

As believers and workers of God, we have to bear in our bodies the dying of our Lord Jesus, and we are to do it all the time (continually) as we walk about day by day. We are to carry about the dving of the Lord Jesus, to take up the cross of Jesus, and to die to ourselves (own desires and wishes). We are to deny ourselves so that we can live for Christ. We are to die to ourselves, so that Christ might be seen in our body and others might receive life. Because of this, people are led to seek life in Christ-life that is abundant in this world and eternal in the next world.

Galatians 2:20 Philippians 3:8

Let us walk by the Spirit and not by our flesh. Let the presence and power of God sustain and give us new life.

Psalm 100:1-3 (NKJV)

Make a joyful shout to the Lord, all you lands! ²Serve the Lord with gladness; Come before His presence with singing. ³Know that the Lord, He is God; It is He who has made us, andnot we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.
