John 14:1 (NKJV)

"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me."

A. Jesus claims to deserve equal faith with God.

Jesus affirms us that seeing Him is the same as seeing the Father. You cannot separate faith in God

from faith in Jesus. And since Jesus is the eternal Son of God, who created all things, and who was in control over all the events surrounding His death, then you can trust Him in whatever overwhelming circumstances you are facing. Nothing is too difficult for Him.

John 14:7-9

He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

B. Jesus claims to be the exclusive way to God.

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

Jesus did not say, "I know the way to heaven and I can point you to it." Rather, He says, "I am the way."

Jesus also said, "I am the truth." Again, He did not say, "I can teach you the truth." He said, "I am the truth." In this context, He means not only that He is totally dependable, but also that He Himself is the only true way of salvation.

Jesus also said, "I am the life." Again, He did not say, "I can tell you how to have life," but rather, "I am the life."

Exploring the world of math and science

To commemorate and highlight the importance of math and science in our everyday lives, United Christian Academy (UCA) held its Math and Science Week 2021 last September 27-October 1, Monday to Friday, with the theme "Wonders of the World". Through this week-long program, students got the chance to explore, understand deeper, and appreciate various concepts and principles regarding math and science. This surely challenged students' knowledge on the said subject matters as they participated in various activities.

Math-Sci Vlogs

To showcase the creativity of students and get hands-on experience on creating their own masterpiece while applying principles of math and science, students starred in their own Math-Sci Vlogs featuring various projects. Here, they demonstrated step-by-step how they crafted their creations, showing how they relate to principles in math and science.

Ice Cube Color Mix



Through freezing colored water then combining two different colored ice cubes in a container, students learned about mixing colors and changing states of matter.

Clay Making



Students demonstrated how to make clay from scratch using mainly flour, oil, and water.

Walking Rainbow



Using colored water and tissue, students showed how water can move against gravity, which is also known as capillary action.

Ally, the Alligator



They learned math by using the alligator's mouth in comparing two numbers.

Soap Making



Students made soap in order to learn more about changing states of matter.

Rob, the Walking Robot



Students were able to make a simple walking robot with the use of popsicle sticks and a battery-operated motor.

Mousetrap Car



With the use of a mousetrap, students were able to make a moving contraption.

Heart Model



To understand how the heart works, they developed a heart model with tubes that act as veins.

Clay Plate Boundaries



By sculpting clay, students presented how plate boundaries move in various situations.

Students conducted an experiment on calculating projectile motion in different angles using a self-made ramp with binder clips and rubber band.

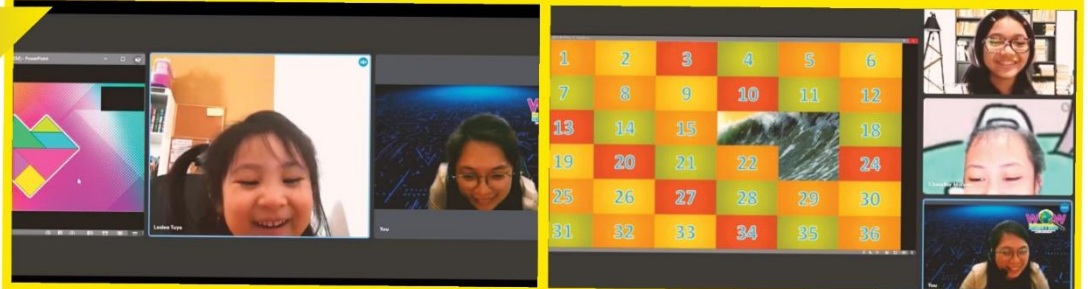
Solar System Model

Introduction

In this world, believers are always under the attack of the enemy and its circle of influence (attacks on physical, emotional, mental and spiritual). But God, through His power and mercy, prepared for our sustenance that far outweighs these attacks.

What are the sustenance of the believers?

4. Our faith in God sustains us.

2 Corinthians 4:13

And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak.

When nothing else sustains us, our faith will sustain us. Believers often times get tempted to give up. The trouble and pressure around us may be great that we are tempted to leave the ministry. Our faith will not allow us to become discouraged to such point that we will leave the ministry. By faith, we believe and hold onto the promises of God. By faith, we overcome the world.

1 John 5:4

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.

5. The hope of resurrection sustains us.

2 Corinthians 4:14

Knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with

Jesus, and will present us with you.

As we bear in our body the dying of our Lord Jesus, we are also assured that we will experience resurrection just as Jesus was resurrected by the Father. That glorious day of resurrection is the day of our full redemption.

John 6:40

"And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day."

John 11:25

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live."

We then who are strong ought to bear with the scruples of the weak, and not to please ourselves.

b. We are to lead people and glorify God.

Matthew 5:16

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

John 15:8

By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

Understanding these, fulfilling our ministry sustains us and gives us great sense of satisfaction.

7. Our inner man sustains us.

2 Corinthians 4:16

Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day.

Though our "outward man" is perishing, our "inner man" is renewed day by day.

Outward man:

- Earthen vessel
- Human body
- Mortal flesh

Inner man:

- Spirit that has been born again
- The spirit that is dead in sin and trespasses and quickened and made alive in Christ
- The new creation, the new man
- Our deepest part where the Holy Spirit dwells

As believers and workers of God, we are renewed day by day when we draw near to God for strength and growth, for relief and deliverance from trials, pressure, and trouble. It is the presence and the power of God within us that renews us.

We are to understand two significant points:

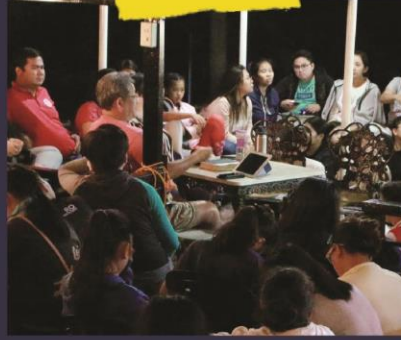
