### Introduction

The measure or level of our faith is "directly proportional" to our knowledge about the Lord Jesus Christ. The more we know Him, the higher is our faith in Him. The deeper we know Him, the deeper is our love for Him. It is essential that we know Jesus Christ very well, because it will lead us to worship Him and obey Him. Every Christian should know three (3) significant things about our Lord Jesus Christ; His deity (being God); His humanity (being a true man) and His character (for us to follow).

### I. Christ's Deity

a. Christ was the coming Messiah, through a virgin birth, that is, God was coming to live with men.

Jesus was the Messiah and eternal God.

# UCA goes above and beyond

United Christian Academy (UCA) has been providing high quality education for over 25 years ago. The school went to various accreditation, certification, and other evaluations to prove its attainment of the vision and mission and the authenticity of the school's operation.

These past few months, UCA had been preparing for another recertification program, from the required documents up to the live video interview. UCA has undergone the FAPE Recertification Activity, with School Head Rev. Dr. James Sy as focal person last October 12, Tuesday—a whole day of interview and assessment. But since the interview finished smoothly and quickly beyond the school's expectation, it occupied only half of the day.

A series of interview for different groups of the faculty, staff, and students were conducted by FAPE evaluators and assessors.

The conference began with an interview attended by ESC voucher recipients and other chosen representatives of the school. It was followed by a conference with the Junior High School teachers who were also asked about their ways of teaching, assessment, and methods. Moreover, the evaluators also asked how UCA Online was able to finish all its video lessons, how it started, and how it was like in the beginning.

Aside from that, School Head Rev. Dr. Sy and Assistant Principal Mrs. Angelica Oafallas had a separate one-on-one interview with the FAPE evaluators. Other department heads were also interviewed with only a few questions because the evaluators said that the documents sufficed all their questions, and they were satisfied already.

The evaluation which was expected to be serious and long turned the other way around. With this, the school knew that the Lord has given another favor in this recertification. The evaluation results will come out after three (3) months. By faith in God, the school and all its workers believe for another Above Standard ratings.

Rev. Dr. James Sy to the evaluators:

The teachers' greatest award is to bring a child to Jesus Christ.

We focus not on monetary awards but on recognition of their loyalty and services through the years.





All the faculty and staff of the school were interviewd by the FAPE evaluators through Zoom regarding their modes of teaching, the journey in developing UCA Online, and other relevant details about the school.



No matter how dark your past is, surrender it to the Lord and arise. Cross over the things or situations that hinder you toward the promise of God. What God wants is for you to just take a step. 

# Understanding the calling of God

by UCF Pastors | Bible Study on the Air with Rev. Dr. William Sy Season 7, Episode 2 | October 13, 2021

### Genesis 12:1-3 (NKJV)

'Now the Lord had said to Abram: "Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you. 'I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing, 'I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

#### Introduction

Abraham's call was very special. God called him out of a rebellious world to be a conduit for salvation. He is a pivotal character in redemptive history. As we study him, we will learn a great deal about living a life of faith (Hebrews 11:8–19). But, specifically in this passage, we learn about God's call.

### Matthew 22:14 (NKJV)

"For many are called, but few are chosen."

### 2 Timothy 1:9 (NKJV)

Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began.

### Proverbs 19:21 (NKJV)

There are many plans in a man's heart, Nevertheless the Lord's counsel—that will stand.

What are the characteristics of God's call as discerned from the call of Abraham?

### God's call is a call to obey God's revelation.

In one sense, there is a general call for all believers as revealed through God's

Word. God calls for all of us to make disciples, to spend time with Him daily through His Word and prayer, to be involved with and serve a Bible-preaching church, and to turn away from sin. These are aspects of God's general call for all believers. However, God also has a specific call for every believer.

 a. To know our specific call, we must apply the principles of the Scriptures.

 b. To know our specific call, we must faithfully fulfill God's general call.

### 1 Samuel 16:6-7 (NKJV)

'So it was, when they came, that he looked at Eliab and said, "Surely the Lord's anointed is before Him!" 'But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

### Luke 9:22-25 (NKJV)

<sup>22</sup>Saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day." <sup>23</sup>Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. <sup>24</sup>For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. <sup>25</sup>For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost?"

### Romans 11:29 (NKJV)

For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

### Juan 14:21 (MBBTAG)

### God's call is a call of sovereign election.

Why did God call Abraham? What made him special?

Abraham was from a family of idolaters. There was no special reason for God to call him. In fact, as we follow his story, we will watch him fail God many times. He lies about his wife twice and, at one point, marries another woman. He allows his wife, Sarah, to abuse his new, pregnant wife. He fails God in many ways.

What makes him special is God's election. God chose him from among all the pagans to bestow special grace on him, and this grace was not just to bless Abraham but to bless the entire world through him. The Messiah, Jesus Christ, eventually came through his lineage.

God called people in the Bible based on His sovereign right as King. They were chosen not because of what they have done but because of God's election:

- Jacob Even though he is not the eldest, he received the inheritance.
- Israelites They were not totally obedient, but God chose them to be His nation.
- Samson Even though he chose Delilah as his wife and put his life in danger, he was still considered as one of the judges of Israel.
- Paul-He persecuted early Christians, but God elected Him to preach the Gospel to the Gentile nation.

Why is it important to understand God's election when considering one's call?

 a. Understanding election helps us trust God instead of being angry at Him when we consider our situation or others'.  b. Understanding election helps us to be humble instead of prideful when God prospers us.

 c. Understanding election helps us worship God.

### Philippians 3:13 (NKJV)

Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead,

### 2 Peter 1:10 (NKJV)

Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble.

### Hebrews 3:1 (NKJV)

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus.

### 3. God's call is costly.

Abraham was called to leave his country, his people, and his father's household. In order to follow God's call, he needed to leave everything.

This is not only true of Abraham's call but ours as well. If anyone is going to follow Christ, he must deny himself and take up his cross.

### Deuteronomy 31:6 (NKJV)

"Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you."

# 4. God's call is a call to faith and dependence.

Abraham, by leaving his people and his father's household, left his security. God was calling Abraham to a life of faith—a life of depending upon Him.

Eventually, after Abraham left his country, God revealed where he was going. Many times as we follow what God has revealed, He reveals the next step to us. This is the life of faith.

Our life of faith begins at salvation. God calls us to give up our striving for salvation through good works and to trust solely in Christ's finished work. Also, as Christians following God's call, the Lord continually teaches us our insufficiency and His sufficiency. Essentially, He teaches us how to depend on Him and live the life of faith.

### Mark 12:31 (NKJV)

"And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'
There is no other commandment greater than these."

### Proverbs 3:5 (NKJV)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding.

### Matthew 28:19 (NKJV)

Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

### Matthew 16:24 (NKJV)

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me."

### 1 Corinthians 15:58 (NKJV)

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.

# 5. God's call is a call to separation from the world and sin.

Probably, part of the reason that Abraham needed to leave his country, family, and household was because of temptations associated with them. Ur, though a prosperous city, was full of idolatry and Abraham's family worshiped idols.

This is our call as well. If we are going to follow Christ, we must turn away from sin and all temptations to sin.

### Romans 8:28 (NKJV)

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

### John 16:33 (NKJV)

"These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

# 6. God's call includes great promises for those who obey.

God's call comes with many great promises. When God calls us or moves in our lives, many times He doesn't give us reasons or calm the waves of our curiosity. He may not answer questions like, "Why?" or "What for?" Sometimes He doesn't even tell us "Where?" or "How?" but He always gives us promises.

What promises did God give Abraham?

# a. God promised to give Abraham a land.

This promise is later expanded. In Genesis 12:7, God says, "To your offspring I will give this land." God promised to give his offspring the land of Canaan.

However, it must be known that God's promise of a land was not just earthly—it was also heavenly.

# b. God promised to make Abraham a great nation.

At the time Abraham received this promise, he was childless. His original name Abram meant "exalted father" while his later name Abraham meant "father of a multitude."

In that culture, it was shameful to not have any children. Here, God promises to remove that shame and not only give them a child but to bring a great nation from him. This nation would be the nation of Israel.

### c. God promised to bless Abraham. The word "bless" is a rich word.

- It can be translated as happy. God's blessing brings joy in the life of a person—no matter the circumstances.
- Blessing has to do with approval.
   When a man wants to marry a woman,
   he gets her father's "blessing"—
   meaning his approval. Abraham would be approved by God for his obedience.
- It also has the connotation of favor.
   God was going to place His favor on Abraham's life, as we see throughout his story. God prospers him with wealth; He gives him a baby when he and his wife were past childbearing
- The greatest blessing was obviously God's presence. God would speak with Abraham and visit his house (Genesis 18). The Scripture calls Abraham God's friend (James 2:23).

# d. God promised to make Abraham's name great.

In fact, the very first temptation of man was to be like God—to have his glory. Adam and Eve ate of the Tree of Knowledge to be like God, and God disciplined them. However, Abraham was not seeking his own glory, and God promised to exalt him.

This principle is still at work today. The world avidly pursues greatness. Each person pursues a name for him or herself through education, wealth, strength, or popularity. Similarly, each religion teaches people to try to save themselves through good works.

However, God opposes the proud and exalts the humble (James 4:6). He rejects those who come to Him based on their works, but accepts those who come to Him like children—not trusting in their own works but trusting in the work of Jesus (Matthew 18:2–3; Romans 4:5).

# e. God promised Abraham to make him a blessing.

It must be noted that God blessed Abraham not primarily for his enjoyment but so he could be a blessing to many. Abraham blessed those in Canaan.

Psalm 1:3 describes the man who is blessed by God as a tree that produces fruit in season. A tree does not bear fruit for itself. We never see apple trees eat their own fruit. God made trees to bless others.

### Conclusion

God's call to Abraham, together with its characteristics and promises, is still true and applicable in our lives today. God is calling us today.

### John 1:15-19 (NKJV)

# In Christ

Romans 8:1-4
(NKJV)

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who

do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. <sup>2</sup>For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. <sup>3</sup>For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, <sup>4</sup>that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

### Introduction

Romans 8 can be considered as a "victory chapter" in the Book of Romans. It is the answer to Matthew 5:4 (Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.). It tells us of the comfort for us who mourn because of sin.

### Romans 7:24

O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death?

Romans 8 presents us how great and marvellous the work of God to those who are "in Christ".

# A. Those who are "in Christ" are not condemned.

Condemned means...

- Declared to be disgraceful, wrong or evil
- Pronounced guilty and sentenced to punishment
- Officially declared to be unfit for use

When a believer is "in Christ," he is free from the law of sin and death (v. 2).

- We are not judged as a sinner but delivered from the condemnation of death and hell.
- We are not judged to be unrighteous, but counted as righteous.
- We are secured from condemnation now and forever.
- We are not to be separated from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

### Romans 8:38-39

<sup>38</sup>For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, <sup>39</sup>nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- Only the believers who are "in Christ" will not be condemned.
- All non-believers will face condemnation for sin.

### B. Who are those "in Christ"?

 To be "in Christ" means that a person's faith in Christ places him in Christ.

The believer's faith actually causes God to identify him and count him:

- As having lived in Christ when Christ lived on the earth—sinless and righteous
- As having died in Christ and never need to die—the penalty and condemnation of our sins are already paid
- As having been raised in Christ—we receive a "new life"
- 2. To be "in Christ" means that a believer walks and lives in Christ day by day.
- A true believer lives, moves, and has his being in Christ.
- A true believer is united in Christ.
- A true believer lays his life (his past sins and his present behavior) upon Christ.
- A true believer entrusts his present welfare and destiny into the hands of Christ.

To truly believe is to walk, and to

truly walk is to believe.

To live and walk in Christ means that we do not walk after the flesh but after the Spirit. We deny ungodliness and worldly lust; and we live soberly, righteously, and godly in this present world.

To live and walk in Christ means that we bear the fruit of the Spirit.

### Galatians 5:22-23

<sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>22</sup>gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no

# 3. To be "in Christ" is to have life from the Spirit.

The Spirit gives life to men, but He gives life only to those who forsake the flesh and walk after Him. We know that we walk after the Spirit if we love Christ and desires to honor Christ in all we do.


