Heart of Sacrifice

Acts 20:32-35 (NKJV)

³²So now, brethren, I command you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified. ³³I have coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. ³⁴Yes, you yourselves know that these hands have provided for my necessities, and for those who were with me. ³⁵I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'

Introduction

Are you sacrificing?

I. The Recommendation: To God and to the Word of His Grace (v.32)

A. Though Paul gave his all for the Christians in Ephesus for three years, he didn't ask them to depend on him.

B. Paul knew there was trouble ahead for him, and some trouble ahead for the Ephesian Christians.

C. But God and His Word are able to

build up the Christians.

Psalm 119:28 (NKJV)

My soul melts from heaviness; Strengthen me according to Your Word.

Isaiah 41:10 (NKJV)

'Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'

D. But God and His Word are able to give Christians an inheritance in heaven.

1 Peter 1:4-5 (NKJV)

⁴To an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, ⁵who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

II. The Real Reason: Coveted No One's Silver or Gold or Apparel (vv. 33-34)

A. Paul was trying to communicate his heart—his motive in ministry.

B. Paul wasn't in the ministry for his selfish motives nor selfish gain.

Colossians 3:22 (NKJV)

Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God.

C. Paul was a hard worker in the ministry for God's glory.

Colossians 3:23-24 (NIV)

²³Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, ²⁴since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

Colossians 3:17 (NKJV)

And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

D. Paul was in the ministry for the building up of God's people.

1 Corinthians 13:1-3 (NKJV)

'Though I speak with the tongues of

men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. ²And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. ³And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.'

III. The Resemblance: It is More Blessed to Give than to Receive (v. 35)

A. "It is more blessed to give than to receive" is the best beatitude of all. In the sermon on the mount, Jesus told us how to be blessed; here, Jesus tells us how to be more blessed!

Luke 6:38 (NKJV)

"Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

As United Christian Academy heeds to the mandate of the Lord and pursues the delivery of online education amidst the alarming pandemic, UCA Online was conceived by faith in 2020. It was a new modality of learning but UCA is designed to conquer challenges in education.

With renewed hope and confidence in the Lord, UCA chose to provide quality Christian education in the digital age. And last October 6, it has been selected as one of the ten recipients of the Rethinking Education, Championing and Accelerating School Transformation (RECAST) financial grant in the whole Philippines for its dedication to continue despite the odds and limitations.

UCA was officially awarded last November 17, Wednesday, by the Private Education Assistance Committee (PEAC) and The Inteligente Publishing Inc. during a ceremony aired via Facebook Live.



School Head and President Rev. Dr. James Sy gave an acceptance speech for the award and thanked the whole committee of the RECAST program.



Jesus Christ the living water

John 4:7-14 (NKJV)

⁷A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, “Give Me a drink.” ⁸For His disciples had gone away into the city to buy food. ⁹Then the woman of Samaria said to Him, “How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?” For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans. ¹⁰Jesus answered and said to her, “If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, ‘Give Me a drink,’ you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water.” ¹¹The woman said to Him, “Sir, You have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where then do You get that living water? ¹²Are You greater than our father Jacob, who gave us the well, and drank from it himself, as well as his sons and his livestock?” ¹³Jesus answered and said to her, “Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, ¹⁴but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life.”

Introduction

During their time, “living water” was a name for waters that are always flowing and moving (such as a river, spring, or the Sea of Galilee), and “dead water” was a name for waters that are stagnant (such as ponds or the Dead Sea).

I. Living water is “of God” and a “gift of God”.

- Living water comes from God.
- Living water is only given by God.
- Living water is for those who know it.
- Living water is given by asking for it.

1 Thessalonians 5:14-15 (NKJV)

¹⁴Now we exhort you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, comfort the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be patient with all. ¹⁵See that no one renders evil for evil to anyone, but always pursue what is good both for yourselves and for all.

II. Question: The woman saw that Jesus had nothing to draw water with.

- From where did Jesus get this living water?
- Is it for real?
- Is Jesus greater than Jacob?

John 3:31 (NKJV)

He who comes from above is above all; he who is of the earth is earthly and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all.

III. Comparison: Jesus compared the water from the well to the water that He gives.

- Physical thirst vs. spiritual thirst

Psalm 42:1 (NKJV)

As the deer pants for the water brooks, so pants my soul for You, O God.

- Within every man's heart is a thirst for:
 - Purpose, meaning, significance, satisfaction, fulfilment
 - Something that is missing, the emptiness, the loneliness, the stress, the anxiety, the pressure

- However, the world also offers water (stagnant water):
 - The love of money and the things of this world, power, position
 - Craving of the flesh, lust, immorality, drunkenness, pride

Jeremiah 2:13 (NKJV)

“For My people have committed two evils: They have forsaken Me, the fountain of living waters, and hewn themselves cisterns—broken cisterns that can hold no water.”

IV. The source of living water

- It comes from Christ.

John 7:37 (NKJV)

On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.”

Mark 16:17-18 (NKJV)

¹⁷And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; ¹⁸they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

Revelations 21:6 (NKJV)

And He said to me, “It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts.”

- It keeps man from ever thirsting again.

Isaiah 58:11 (NKJV)

The Lord will guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones; You shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.

- It is a “well of water” placed in the man.

John 7:38-39 (NKJV)

³⁸He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” ³⁹But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Philippians 4:19 (NKJV)

The peace that Jesus gives

John 14:27 (NKJV)

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Introduction

When encountered with the question "What is peace?", many would answer:

- The absence of war
- The absence of trouble
- Being quiet
- Being serene and tranquil

In the Bible, there were two instances that someone is assuring or teaching about peace, yet they are in a condition wherein they are facing or about to face trouble and hardship.

- Jesus (John 14:27) – He promised to give peace to His disciples, yet He will face death unimaginable.
- Paul (Philippians 4:6-7) – He taught the Philippian church on how to acquire the peace of God, yet he is in prison and in chains.

What then is peace?

The Greek word *eirene* (peace) means to bind together, to join, or to weave together. A person is bound, woven, and joined together with himself, with God, and others.

The Hebrew word *shalom* (peace) means freedom from trouble and much more. It is experiencing the highest good, enjoying the very best, and possessing all the inner good possible. It is wholeness and soundness. It is prosperity in widest sense, especially prosperity in the spiritual sense, having a soul that blossoms and flourishes.

Where can we get peace?

The world can give us peace.

• It is the peace of escapism, avoiding trouble, refusing to face things, and even unreality.

• It is a peace sought through pleasure, satisfaction, contentment, absence of trouble, positive thinking, or denial of problem.

There is peace that Jesus gives.

1. A peace independent of

outward circumstances

- A peace that cannot be taken away by trouble, problem or situations
- We have peace because Jesus already overcame the world that causes us troubles.

John 16:33 (NKJV)

"These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

2. A peace with unquestionable confidence

- Knowing that we are in the hands of God and that all things will work out for good because we love God and we are called according to His purpose
- We have peace because God assured us that He is in control.

Romans 8:28 (NKJV)

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

3. A peace that settles our mind, strengthens our will, and establishes our heart

- We have peace because Jesus guards our hearts and minds; and His truth and promises allow us to focus on His will and plans for us.

Philippians 4:6-7 (NKJV)

⁶Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; ⁷and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:8 (NKJV)

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

John 14:27 (NKJV)

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NKJV)

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

How can we receive the peace that Jesus gives?

1. By justification

Romans 5:1 (NKJV)

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2. By loving God's Word

John 16:33 (NKJV)

"These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

John 14:23 (NKJV)

Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him."

3. By praying in all circumstances

Philippians 4:6-7 (NKJV)

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; ⁷and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

4. By being spiritually minded

Romans 8:6 (NKJV)

For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

5. By staying our mind upon God

Isaiah 26:3 (NKJV)

You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.

Philippians 4:8 (NKJV)

Finally, brethren, whatever things

are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

6. By keeping God's commandments

Isaiah 48:18 (NKJV)

Oh, that you had heeded My commandments! Then your peace would have been like a river, and your righteousness like the waves of the sea.

Philippians 4:9 (NKJV)

The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.

Conclusion

We cannot have genuine peace apart from Jesus because Jesus is the very peace itself. He reconciled us to the Father and gave us back what is rightfully ours.

The world gives us peace that is temporary and conditional (based on how we feel), but Jesus gives us peace that is eternal and true (beyond what we feel).

Hebrews 12:2 (NIV)

Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before Him He endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Mga Kawikaan 16:7-8 (MBBTAG)

"Kung ang buhay ng tao ay kalugud-lugod kay Yahweh, maging ang mga kalaban, sa Kanya'y makikipagbati. Ang maliit na halaga buhat sa mabuting paraan ay higit na mabuti sa yamang buhat sa kasamaan."



Bakit ang kasalanan ay napapatawad? Bakit may kapatawanan sa kasalanan at baki sa kabilang paghingi natin ng tawad, there is still guilt in our heart? First, let's talk about sin. Ano nga ba talaga ang kasalanan? Sin is transgression of law. Ang kasalanan ay ang paglabag sa kautusan. Sabi Niya

sa 1 John 3:4, 'Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness because sin is lawlessness.'

Pangalawa, all unrighteousness is sin. Ano nga ba ang unrighteousness? Sabi ng 1 John 5:17, 'All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin not leading to death.' Ang tanong, ano ba ang tama sa mali? Ano ba talaga ang kasalanan? Ang kasalanan ay transgression of law. All unrighteousness is sin.

Pangatlo, omission is sin. Ano ang sabi ng Bibliya? Sa mga taong nalalamang gumawa ng mabuti pero hindi ginagawa nito, ito man ay kasalanan. Kalimitang sasabihin natin, 'Wala akong kasalanan. Wala naman akong ginawang masama.' Walang transgression of law, walang unrighteousness. Kaso nakalimutan niya ang pangatlo—alam niyang gawin ang mabuti pero hindi niya ginagawa. Marami siyang alam na gagawing tama pero hindi niya ginagawa. Ang sabi ng Bibliya sa James, ito rin ay inaaring kasalanan. We have to do something.

Lastly, 'But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin' (Romans 14:23). Magandang basehan ang sinasabi ng Bibliya. Apat na anggulo ang dapat natting makita nang maliwanag sa buhay natin araw-araw para maintindihan at maunawaan natin kung ano ba talaga ang kasalanan. May tao kasing wala nang inisip kung hindi ang magduda. Anything not of faith is sin. Anumang bagay na ginagawa natin ngunit hindi natin pinaniniwalaan at pinanampalatayaan, ito

ay pagkukunwari.

Now, let's talk about the other side of it. Paano tayo makakalaya sa kasalanan? Nakita na natin kung ano ang kasalanan. Ngayon, kailangan makita naman natin kung paano tayo makakalaya sa kasalanan. Ano ang ibig sabihin ng forgiveness? It is to send off, to send away, or to cut what is wrong. Parang bulok na gulay

ian—ang marumi ay tinatanggal mo para maging karapat-dapat ka. Now, there are four Biblical concepts for the forgiveness of sin.

Number one, why is forgiveness needed? Kung may kasalanan ka at nalayo ka dahil sa kasalanan, kailangan mo ng forgiveness. Forgiveness is needed because of wrongdoing, guilt, and penalty. Because all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23).

Next, although the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus. We need to choose sapagkat ang pagpiling ito ay maghahatid sa atin sa forgiveness of sin. In Romans 8:1, kailangan natin ng pagpapatawad ng kasalanan at ang simula nito ay kay Kristo. Ang sabi Niya, 'Whosoever believes in Me shall not perish but have everlasting life.'
