Seeking and Searching the Lord

Isaiah 55:6-9 (KJV)

"Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: ⁷Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. ⁸For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. ⁹For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Introduction

The modern fallacies are that men are no longer seeking the Lord and are not required to:

1. Pray anymore
2. Repent anymore
3. Call on God anymore
4. Confess their sins anymore
5. Do anything else to be saved from sin

The following Bible teachings on how we can find God:

I. Seek (while He may be found)

1. Seek the Lord.

Isaiah 55:6

Seek ye the Lord while He may be found, call ye upon Him while He is near.

2. Search with all your heart and soul.

Deuteronomy 4:29

But if from thence thou shalt seek the Lord thy God, thou shalt find Him, if thou seek Him with all thy heart and with all thy soul.

3. Seek His presence continually.

1 Chronicles 16:11

Seek the Lord and His strength, seek His face continually.

4. Humble themselves.

2 Chronicles 7:14

If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

5. Seek His kingdom and righteousness.

Matthew 6:33

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

6. Believe in God.

Hebrews 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.

II. Repent

5. All people everywhere to repent

III. Confess

1. Confess and believe.

2. He is faithful and just to forgive our sins.

IV. Pray

1. Pray and seek God's face.

2 Chronicles 7:14

2. Prayer is asking God a favor.

Experiencing God's faithfulness in UCA

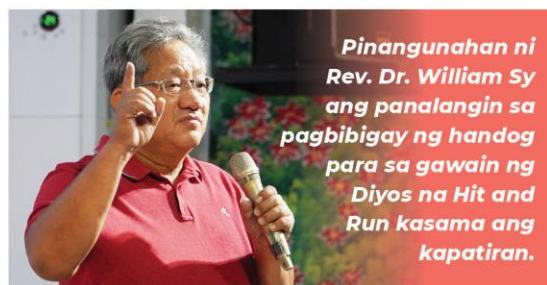

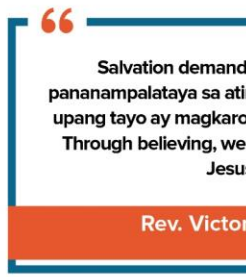

Introduction

John 3:16-18 reveals the heart and purpose of God. God's love is wide enough to embrace all person.

THEOLOGY V (Ecclesiology)

This subject covers the knowledge, skills, and attitudes for studying ecclesiology and its meaning. It also includes the purpose and rituals of the church, the roles of church leadership and church members, and the major periods of church history.

OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY

This subject covers the knowledge, skills, and attitudes required to gather, interpret, and convey information in response to the Bible's Books of the Laws and Books of the Former Prophets.

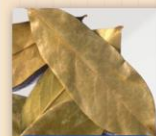

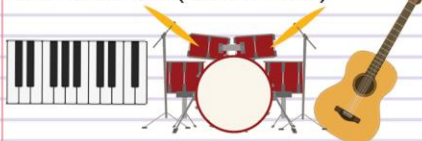

¹¹The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. ¹²I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. ¹³And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. ¹⁴I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

VI. Hear

1. You are of your father, the devil.

John 8:39-47

³⁹They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham. ⁴⁰But now ye seek to kill Me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham. ⁴¹Ye do the deeds of your father. Then said they to him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God. ⁴²Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love Me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of Myself, but He sent Me. ⁴³Why do ye not understand My speech? even because ye cannot hear My word. ⁴⁴Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. ⁴⁵And because I tell you the truth, ye believe Me not.

⁴⁶Which of you convinceth Me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe Me? ⁴⁷He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.

VII. Obey

1. Obedience to the truth

1 Peter 1:22

Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently.

2. Hear God's Word and obey it.

Luke 11:28

But he said, Yea rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it.

3. If you love Me, you will obey My commandment.

John 14:15

If ye love Me, keep My commandments.

Philippians 2:12-13

¹²Wherefore, My beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in My presence only, but now much more in My absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. ¹³For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of His good pleasure.

4. To obey everything God has commanded

Matthew 28:20

Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Challenge

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14

¹³Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep His commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. ¹⁴For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.
