A Servant Heart

Philippians 2:5-11 (NKJV)

⁵Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, ⁷but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. ⁸And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. ⁹Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Introduction

Are you happy to serve?

As believers of Christ, we should internalize the following S.I.R. for this kind of heart:

I. A Servant Heart: The Significance

A. Because the condition of the heart determines who we are

Proverbs 4:23 (NIV)

Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

B. Because the condition of the heart determines how we relate to others

Luke 6:45 (NKJV)

A good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and an evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of.

II. A Servant Heart: The Inclusions

A. A Humble Heart like Jesus

Philippians 2:7 (NKJV)

But made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

1. The word "reputation" literally means to pour oneself out, that is, Jesus emptied Himself from being recognized as to who He truly was, that is the Lord, and instead He took upon Himself the form of a slave.

2. That is what bondservants do—they relinquish their rights in order to serve their master. In this

instance, Jesus relinquished His rights and position in order to serve His heavenly Father by serving others.

John 13:5,15-17 (NKJV)

⁵After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.

¹⁵For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you. ¹⁶Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. ¹⁷If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.

3. In humility, we are to consider others.

Philippians 2:3-4 (NKJV)

³Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. ⁴Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

4. Humility isn't denying who God made us to be; rather it's being

honest about our weaknesses and God's strength. Humility is getting the focus off ourselves and putting it upon the needs of others.

B. An Obedient Heart like Jesus

Philippians 2:8 (NKJV)

And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

1. Someone with a servant heart obeys God, not out of convenience, but out of conviction and obedience. Many people will serve God only if it's convenient for them to do so, but a true servant will serve God from conviction and obedience.

2. Jesus was obedient to God and the Father's will, even to the point of dying on the cross. And through His humble obedience, salvation came to humanity.

C. A Sacrificial Heart like Jesus

1. Servants will put others before themselves. They'll relinquish their rights in order to serve others.

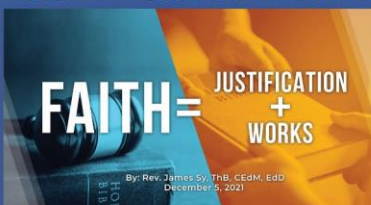

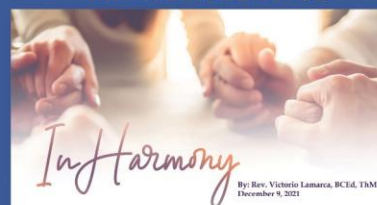

are willing to sacrifice.

Isaiah 53:3-5 (NKJV)

³He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. ⁴Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. ⁵But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

2. The heart of a servant recognizes that by serving others, we serve Christ.

Matthew 25:37-40 (NKJV)


