

Acts 2:36-47 (NKJV)

³⁶ Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." 37Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" 38Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call." 40 And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation." 41 Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. ⁴²And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. 43Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. 44Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, 45 and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. ⁴⁶So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food

with gladness and simplicity of heart, ⁴⁷praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

Introduction

What are the differences of a living and a dead?

As children of God, we need to understand a living Christian life:

I. God is the beginning, middle, and goal of the Christian life.

A. The Christian life begins with God.

1. God is the Caller. (v. 39)

John 6:44 (NKJV)

No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.

a. The Christian life begins as God calls people to Jesus. And God calls people to himself the Holy Spirit filled preaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. b. The Christian life begins in no other way. Every person must be personally called by God through the preaching of the Gospel.

2. God is the Forgiver. (v. 38)

a. Sin separates. The only way for there to be reconciliation between you, the rebellious sinner, and the infinitely holy God is for your sin to be removed.

b. And you cannot remove your own sin. No amount of working or praying or faith can remove your sin. Christ alone removes sin.

c. The forgiveness of sins is found only in the Name of Jesus Christ. He really took your sins on Himself on the cross. And God removes our transgressions from us as far as the east is from the west. It is God who forgives because of the work of Jesus Christ.

Psalm 103:12 (NKJV)

As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us.

B. The Christian life depends on God.

1. Christians live by, walk by, and are led by the Spirit. (v. 38)

a. We live because the Holy Spirit brings the life of Christ to us. (Romans 8:9-11) b. We obey because we have the power of the Holy Spirit in us. (Galatians 5:16-25)

c. We think of God's thoughts because the Spirit knows the mind of God, and through the Spirit-inspired Scriptures, our minds are renewed. (1 Corinthians 2:10-13; Romans 12:1)

Christians depend on the Spirit of Christ empowering and indwelling you.

John 15:5 (NKJV)

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing."

Philippians 1:9 (NKJV)

And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment.

Romans 8:9 (NKJV)

But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.

C. God is the goal of the Christian life.

1. God calls us to Himself.

 a. God does not call us to Himself because He is the means of salvation.

b. God does not call us to Himself so we can enjoy heaven.

c. God equips us for heaven so that we can be with Him and enjoy Him there.

2. Justification and a clear conscience are not the goals of the Christian life.

a. Forgiveness is not the end; it is the means to God.

b. Glorification is not the end; it is the means to God.

3. Being eternally with the glorious God is the goal of Christianity.





Seek The Lord

Magkaroon tayo ng panawagan sa Diyos at higit sa lahat ay panahon upang pakinggan natin ang Salita ng Panginoon. Ito ang sinasabi ng Bibliya (Isaiah 55:6-9), "Seek the Lord while He may be found, Call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon. 'For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways,' says the Lord. 'For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts."



This could be a wake up call. Paalala mula sa ating Panginoon. It is an invitation by the Lord and an urgent call, universal in scope. It addresses a deep spritual longing to seek the Lord while He may be found, habang may panahon at habang may pagkakataon. It is the call to everyone in this time of crisis, to all religions and even to the non-believers as well, that we may call upon Him while He is near.

Sinasabi ng Banal na Kasulatan na malinaw ang tawag ng Panginoon. Napapanahon nang makita natin ang kahalagahan nang tawag Niya. Bihira na tayo makakita ng tao na naghahanap sa Diyos. Kapag sinabi natin na darating na ang Panginoon, walang masyadong pumapansin. Pero nang sinabi nating nariyan na ang COVID-19, lahat ay natatakot. Lahat ay naghahanda. Lahat halos ng tao ay ayaw umalis ng bahay. They are confused and scared. Fear is in the surroundings.

The Bible says, "Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord." Ang sinasabi ng Panginoon dito na ang tinatawag Niya ay iyong mga wicked and unrighteous. Nais ng Panginoon na magkaroon tayo ng pagbabago. We will have a new paradigm, a shift from being wicked and unrighteous to returning to the Lord. The Lord is calling the wicked and the unrighteous to return to Him. Kapag tiningnan natin ang word na 'the wicked', ang ibig sabihin niyan ay morally very bad, napakasama.

And throughout this country and the world, there are practices na karumaldumal sa Panginoon at ang kasalanan ay umabot na sa sukdulan. Ito ay umabot na sa langit.

In Isaiah 55:7, "Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon." Naghayag ang Diyos ng ganitong mga panukala sapagkat una sa lahat, alam natin na ang pag-ibig ng Diyos ay higit. Ang sabi ng John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son for whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." Ganoon na lang ang pagsinta ng Diyos at ang pagmamahal Niya sa Kaniyang mga nilikha. He will have mercy upon him, and to our God He will abundantly pardon.

The word 'mercy' means 'compassion'. It is a lenient or compassionate treatment. All you need is to ask mercy. Binibigyan tayo ng sapat na panahon ng Panginoon na makabalik, enough time and enough opportunity to reflect on His Word.



Hindi maintindihan ng tao. This is beyond the human mind. Ganoon ang pag-iisip ng Diyos. Ganoon ang kaparaanan ng Diyos.

Sa 1 Corinthians 2:9, "But as it is written: Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." Kaya nananawagan tayo sa mga tao, sa mga church, sa mga mananampalataya na nagtitiwala, naniniwala at nagmamahal sa Panginoon. Again, this is a wake up call to everybody. Ipinapakita sa atin ng Panginoon na hindi talaga maaaring magkapareho ang kaisipan ng tao at kaisipan ng Diyos.

Maging challenge sa atin na makita natin na ang pagmamahal ng Diyos ay walang hanggan. Even though people continue to sin and rebel against God, ang Diyos ay nagbibigay ng chance sa atin. Maaaring ito ang huling chance natin, for we all know that the coming of the Lord is near. Hindi nga lang natin alam kung kailan pero ramdam natin na ang Panginoon ay malapit nang dumating.

a. If you don't want God, you aren't a Christian.

 b. You may want Christian things but if God is not the goal, you are not a Christian.

II. How to live the Christian life?A. The Christian life is a devoted life.(v. 42)

 To be devoted means to continue steadfastly in the things of God. It means you are strong toward these things. God's things shape who you are, the way you thin, and the things you do. The Father, Son, and Spirit have an impact on your everyday living.

2. These are the lives of devoted Christians. They're really just Christians. There is no such thing as Christians and then devoted Christians. There is only one type of believer.

B. Christians live devoted to God through His Word. (v. 42)

1. They 'continued steadfastly in the apostles' teaching'. Christians are dependent upon Jesus Christ. When we read the Scriptures, it is the living and active Word of God. This Book, by the Spirit's power, reveals Christ Himself. We abide in Christ by abiding in His Word.

2. This continuing devotion to the Word of God characterizes a Christian and a New Testament church. As we listen to God, we are transformed into His image. Those who want more of God look for more of Him through His Word.

C. Live devoted to Christ through His people. (v. 42)

1. They devoted themselves to

fellowship. They devoted themselves to being together.

2. In Acts 2, what was at the center of the fellowship? What must be at the center of our fellowship? The better question is this: Who must be at the center of our fellowship? It must be Jesus Christ.

Matthew 18:20 (NKJV)

"For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

D. Christians live devoted to Christ through the Lord's Supper. (v. 42)

1. Who is the center of the Lord's Supper? Is it not Jesus Himself; the center of us and all that we do? In the Lord's Supper we gather together to celebrate and proclaim the Lord's atoning death until He returns.

2. We are His ransomed people longing for His glorious return. Because the Lord's Supper is a tangible way of celebrating the Christ that makes us Christian, it is no surprise that the church should be devoted to it.

E. Christians live devoted to Christ through prayer. (v. 42)

1. Praying was central to the life of the early church. Praying to God in the temple as these Jews had always done was natural. If God exists and we are His people, then prayer just makes sense. And setting a time to do it every day is not a bad idea either. God's people have always been a singing people and God's people have always been a praying people.

2. The people of God were committed to fulfilling the purposes of God. They knew their insufficiency and God's sufficiency and so they prayed. The moment we feel the weight of the fact that we can't do it, we'll start praying.

III. The Christian life is life together.

A. When Christ is our center, we will see amazing things. (v. 43, v. 47b)

1. When the power of Christ rested upon them, they became strong. Awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles.

2. They were "having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved." The people of God were encountering the presence of God and their neighbors could tell a difference. The presence of Christ made such a difference in their lives that their neighbors were being saved.

B. When Christ is our center, we will be united. (v. 44)

1. All who believed were together. Literally they "are on the same." When we all want the same thing, there will be unity. When we all depend on the same thing happening, there will be unity.

2. When Christ is what we want and the reason we do what we do, there will

be unity. Do you see how believing in Jesus and being together just fit? "And all who believed were together."


C. When Christ is our center, we will meet each other's needs. (v. 45)

 And all who believed were together and had all things in common. And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds as any had need. Possessions and belongings relate to real estate and personal property.

2. When there's a need, you meet it. This also implies that you know people well enough to know when there is a need.
