The Parable of the Talents



Matthew 25:14-30 (NKJV)

Look, there you have what is yours.’ ²⁶But his lord answered and said to him, ‘You wicked and lazy servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed. ²⁷So you ought to have deposited my money with the bankers, and at my coming I would have received back my own with interest. ²⁸So take the talent from him, and give it to him who has ten talents. ²⁹For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away. ³⁰And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.’





"Marami tayong pinagkaka-busyahan sa buhay pero bakit natin pinipili na mas maging busy sa Panginoon?

Dahil alam natin na mas mahalaga ang pagmamahal natin sa Diyos. Ang mensahe ng Panginoon sa iyo ay gusto ka Niyang paalalahanan sa duty mo at doon sa mga danger na haharapin mo. Marahil ang ilan ay hinaharap na nila iyon. Kaya ang sabi Niya, 'You pursue peace.' Alam nating lahat na sinabi ng Bible sa Book of Matthew na 'blessed are the peacemakers.' (beatitudes). Memorized ng mga bata iyan, pero bakit kaya dito sa Book of Hebrews, maliban sa salitang 'peace' ay may idinagdag pang isang word. Ang sabi Niya, 'You pursue peace with all people.' Tapos, ang sabi Niya 'and holiness'.

Sabi ng Bible 'Blessed are the "pure in heart" for they will see God.' Ibig sabihin ba noon ay nagko-contradict iyong sinasabi sa Beatitudes at iyong sinasabi doon sa Hebrews? Hindi. It only makes sense.

I would like to illustrate to you how important it is that we need a life of holiness. Ang sabi ng Salita ng Panginoon, 'You pursue peace with all people and holiness.' Kapag tiningnan mo, sabi pa Niya ay 'without which no one will see the Lord'. As you can see, the message is very direct. Ang mensahe ng Panginoon ay hindi paikot-ikot, hindi siya parable. Sinasabi ng Panginoon, 'Gusto niyo ba Akong makita? You pursue peace with all people and holiness.'

Sa ngayon, we live in a world full of corruption and evil. Maraming tao, in a way, care little or they care less. Definitely, maraming tao ang nagpapabaya at walang malasakit sa kapwa. These are the

people who are evil and corrupt. There are times that people are careless toward other people as well. Ang gusto nila ay ang gusto nila. Masama pala iyon—iyong gusto mo ay gusto mo. Kasi dapat lagi tayong may tinatawag na malawak na pag-unawa because every time iyong gusto mo ang gusto mo, selfishness pala iyon. Hindi puwedeng mag-compromise tayo sa Salita ng Diyos.

Ang sabi ng Salita ng Diyos ay kung gusto mo raw makita ang Panginoon, you pursue peace with all people. Hindi Niya sinabi with many people. Hindi Niya sinabi na some people. Hindi Niya rin sinabing few people. Ang sinabi Niya ay 'all'.

Ano ba ang ibig sabihin ng all? Lahat.

Kailangang maintindihan natin na ang peace na dapat nating i-pursue is within the bounds of holiness. Sometimes, nagkakaroon tayo ng misconception about peace. Minsan ay mayroon tayong ibang klaseng measure. Ibig sabihin ay gumagawa ka para magkaroon ka ng kapayapaan. Iyong kapayapaan na sinasabi mo, kapalit noon ay iyong buhay ng iba. Nagkakamali na tayo kasi doon nagkakaiba ang mga teaching ng ilang mga paniniwala. Iyong peace nila ay para lang sa kanila. Hindi ka kasama doon. Ang peace na sinasabi ng Panginoon dito ay 'tayo'. Bilang mga peacemaker, nae-extend dapat natin ang peace na iyon. If it is possible, of course. Kasi, may sinasabi rin ang Bible sa Book of Luke na, 'Go to

different houses and you say peace, if there would be a man of peace, then come in.' Kapag wala, pagpagan mo ng paa at pumunta ka sa iba.

Ang Diyos mismo ay nagbibigay ng katuruan regarding peace, pero walang sinabi ang Diyos na kapag hindi ka tinanggap doon sa bahay ay pasabugin mo

ang bahay kasi hindi mo iyon kasama o iyon ay kaaway mo. Walang sinasabi ang Bible na ganoon. Ang sinabi ng Bible, 'You say peace.' Kapag hindi ka tinanggap, then pumunta ka sa iba pero nandoon sa loob mo na alam mo that you pursue peace.

YOU CHASE. YOU RUN AFTER. BELIEVERS ARE TO PURSUE PEACE.



Why Read the Book of 1 Kings?

The Book of 1 Kings starts with Solomon and ends with Elijah. The difference between the two gives you an idea as to what lies between them.

Solomon was born after a palace scandal between David and Bathsheba. Like his father, he had

a weakness for women that would bring him down. Solomon did well at first, praying for wisdom and building a temple to God that took seven years to construct. But then he spent 13 years building a palace for himself. His accumulation of many wives led him to worship their idols and be led away from God.

It also recounts the ministry of the prophet Elijah among the northern ten tribes of Israel. After Solomon's death, Israel was ruled by a series of kings, most of whom were evil and idolatrous. The nation

fell further away from God, and even the preaching of Elijah could not bring them back. The Temple in Jerusalem, where God's Spirit would dwell in the Holy of Holies, foreshadows believers in Christ in whom the Holy Spirit resides from the moment of our salvation. Just as the Israelites were to forsake idolatry, so are we to put away anything that separates us from God.

By studying this book, readers can learn truths that will help them understand the importance

of worshipping the Lord in His temple, marrying in the covenant, making righteous choices, and listening to the still, small voice of the Lord.

We are His people, the very temple of the living God. In 2 Corinthians 6:16, it tells us "What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: 'I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people.'"
