## Where is your treasure?



### Matthew 6:19-24 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup>"Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; <sup>20</sup>but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup>For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

To answer the question, "where is your treasure?" we need to find out "where our heart is".

### Proverbs 4:23

Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life.

### Biblical examples:

#### The story of Achan (Joshua 6:17-18, 7:1-26)

In verse 18, God instructs the children of Israel to attack Jericho, to abstain from the accursed things, and to bring all the silver, gold, and vessels of bronze and iron to be consecrated to the Lord into the treasury of the Lord. Now as they attack Jericho, one of the men disobeys the command of the Lord and keeps for himself a beautiful Babylonian garment, 200 shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold weighing

50 pounds. Because of this man's sin, Israel is defeated at the battle of Ai, and this man is put to death because his heart coveted after these riches instead of honoring the Lord and doing as He had asked.

#### The Rich Young Ruler (Matthew 19:16-22)

In this story, a rich young ruler comes to ask Jesus a question. The question he asks is how he might have eternal life. Jesus answers the man by telling him that he needs to obey the commandments, and the rich young ruler responds, "Which ones?" Jesus responds, "'You shall not murder,' 'You shall not commit adultery,' 'You shall not steal,' 'You shall not bear false witness,' 'Honor your father and your mother,' and 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'" The young ruler responds that he has kept all these things and asks, "What do I still lack?" This is where Jesus says, "Go, sell what you have and give to the poor" and "Follow Me."

#### I. Where is your heart attuned?

Where was this young man's heart? You can tell by his reaction. His heart is controlled by his wealth and riches. This young ruler is wealthy and he is not willing to let those

things go in order to follow Jesus. He is willing to love his neighbor and do the commands that pertain to his fellow man, but when it comes down to loving the Father and having no other gods before Him, he is not willing to let go of the wealth he obtained here on earth in order to gain eternal life.

Both Biblical examples tell us that people's heart can be corrupted if not kept with all diligence.

#### II. What do you deem as valuable?

What you deem as valuable shows you where your heart is. Maybe it is money and wealth; maybe it is power and the desire to be recognized as a leader; maybe it is looking spiritual on the outside so that people think you have it together. Maybe it is popularity and acceptance through nice clothes, a home, or owning a latest gadget. Maybe it is your family and how you have raised great kids.

Jesus is calling us to change our minds from the temporary to the eternal, from the things that are passing by to the things that are permanent.

#### III. How to lay treasures in

#### heaven?

The answer is by living the way God has asked us to live and following after Him in all that we do.

For example, loving your neighbor as yourself – if a man has a need for a shirt and you have extra, give him one – being a cheerful giver, honoring God in your marriage, guarding your mind against adulterous thoughts, sharing the Good News of the Gospel with those around you. There are so many things which all narrow down to loving the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength, and loving your neighbor as yourself.

#### Challenge

When we set our hearts on the things of this earth and fall to the temptation of being worldly in our ways, we are committing idolatry because we are no longer serving God. Rather, we have put our riches above God, and we are serving them. They have become our god and our life. If your treasure is on earth and the things of this world, your heart will be there as well. If your heart is focused on the Father and on laying up treasures in heaven, your heart will be there.

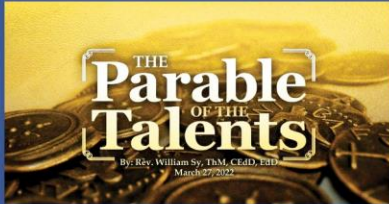

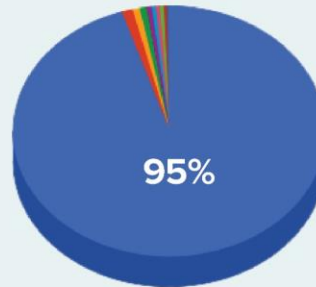

Let us reflect on the different situations of time in our lives. It's time to seek the

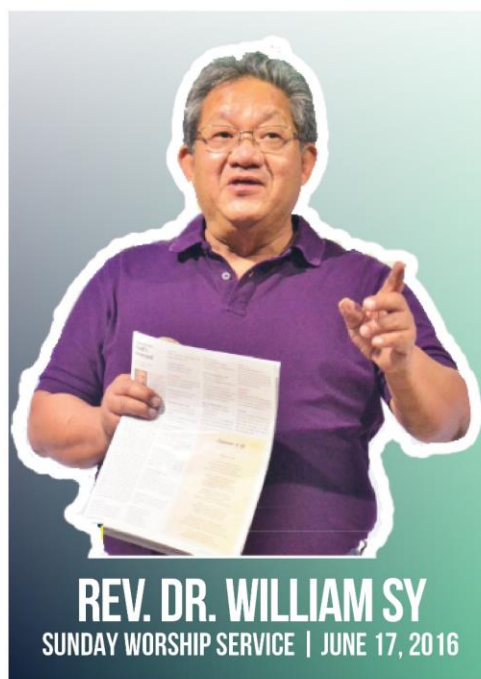

# ATONEMENT OF SINS

There were two mandatory sacrifices in the Old Testament Law. The first was the sin offering. The purpose of the sin offering was to atone for sin and be cleansed from defilement. There were five possible elements of a sin sacrifice—a young bull, a male goat, a female goat, a dove or pigeon, or 1/10 ephah of fine flour. The type of animal depended on the identity and financial situation of the giver. These sacrifices each had specific instructions on what to do with the blood of the animal during the ceremony.

The other mandatory sacrifice was the trespass offering, and this sacrifice was exclusively a ram. The trespass offering was given as atonement for unintentional sins that required reimbursement to an offended party, and also as cleansing from defiling sins or physical illnesses.

The sacrifices in the Old Testament pointed forward to the perfect and final sacrifice of Christ. As with the rest of the Law, the sacrifices were "a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ" (Colossians 2:17). Today, Christians recognize Christ's atoning death on the cross as the only needed sacrifice for sin, offered once for all (Hebrews 10:1-10). His death opened the "holy place" for us (Hebrews 10:19-22) so that we can freely enter God's presence and offer our "sacrifice of praise" (Hebrews 13:15).

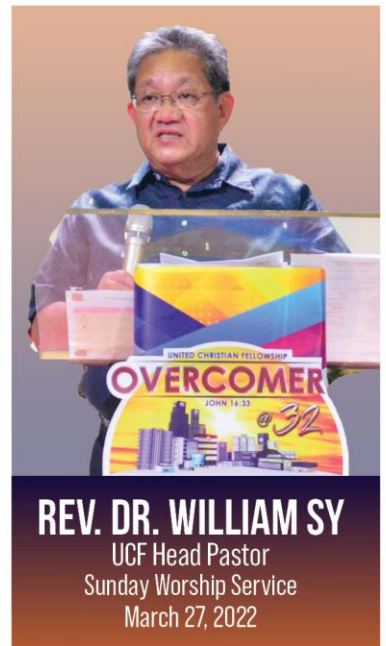

## Why Read the Book of 2 Kings?

The Book of 2 Kings continues the history of the divided kingdom, picking up the story around 853 BC. This describes the history of the Northern Kingdom of Israel and the Southern Kingdom of Judah, focusing on the spiritual successes and failures of each kingdom. The

book also explains why Israel and Judah lost the Lord's protection and were conquered.

The time period covered by 2 Kings saw the emergence of the first writing prophets in Israel. Amos and Hosea went to the people of Israel, while Isaiah, Joel, Micah, Nahum, Habbakuk, Zephaniah, and Jeremiah prophesied in Judah, both groups calling the people to repentance and warning them of God's coming judgments.

The author devoted extensive space to Elijah's successor, Elisha's

ministry after Elijah was taken to heaven. The miracles recorded in 2 Kings are memorable examples of the Lord's power. The book records that the prophet Elijah divided the Jordan River and was taken into heaven in a chariot of fire. Elisha likewise divided the Jordan River, raised the dead, instructed Naaman to bathe seven times in the Jordan River so Naaman could be healed of his leprosy, caused an axe head to float, and prophesied of a famine that lasted seven years.

None of the kings of Israel are

described as having done right in God's eyes; each led the people deeper into idolatry. Several of Judah's kings were righteous, notably Joash, Uzziah, Hezekiah, and Josiah. Hezekiah held off the Assyrians by trusting in the Lord for deliverance. Josiah later instituted an even greater spiritual reformation. Neither effort, however, was enough to stem God's eventual judgment on the nation in fulfillment of the curses of the Mosaic Covenant (Deuteronomy 28).
