Ephesians 3:14-21 (NKJV)

¹⁴For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, ¹⁶that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, ¹⁷that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—¹⁹to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. ²⁰Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, ²¹to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Introduction

Is being filled important?

As children of God, we should come to God through the following:

I. Be humble before God.

Ephesians 3:14-15 (NKJV)

¹⁴For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵from whom the whole family in

heaven and earth is named.

A. Kneeling before God in prayer seems to communicate humility and loyalty to God, understanding who God is and who we are in relationship to God.

B. Don't forget that we are saved by grace, this is not from ourselves. We did not earn our relationship with God. We are in Christ, before God, and we have come to God only by His magnificent love and grace. So, we should be humble before God.

C. Not only should we come before Him humbly because He is King, but also because He is the giver of life to all!

D. Salvation is available to any and all who will come to God in Christ, through the work of Jesus, and the power of the Holy Spirit.

E. Paul points out that all the people of the earth owe their existence to God. Everything that has breath and life, in heaven and on earth, owes its very heartbeat to God, who is the Father of all things.

F. So, not only is our salvation found only in Christ, from God; but also,

our created-ness is owed to God, the Creator; the one from whom every family on earth is named. Every family, every people, and every nation owe their very existence to God!

II. Be filled with God.

Ephesians 3:16-19 (NKJV)

¹⁶That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, ¹⁷that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—¹⁹to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

A. The strength for our inner being is given by God's Holy Spirit (v.16).

Ephesians 1:18 (NKJV)

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.

- We need God's Spirit to strengthen us daily, hourly, and every minute of

our existence.

B. The dwelling of Christ in our hearts through faith (v.17)

- Though we are in Christ, Paul also prays that Christ would dwell in us; that His presence will be with us and live within our inmost being.

C. Be firmly rooted and grounded in love (v.17).

Matthew 22:37-40 (NKJV)

³⁷Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." ³⁸This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

D. That we may comprehend the greatness of God's love (v.18)

1. Paul uses this language that is not even perfectly discernible in the Greek in terms of what type of measurement he is using. He speaks of length and width, and height and depth.

2. Paul is praying that the Ephesians will know how greatly God loves them and that they will know the

Ang sabi sa Revelations, 'I am the Alpha and the Omega. I am yesterday, today, and forever.' Siya ang Diyos na walang katulad at walang kaparis. Sapagkat sa langit, ang Kaniyang Pangalan lamang ang ibinigay sa buong sanlibutan para sa ikaliligtas at sa ikatututo ng bawat isa sa atin.

Kawaan o Proverbs, binigyang-diin ni King Solomon ang tungkol sa buhay ng isang taong mayroong personal

"Ang mahalaga, kahit tayo ay mapagod, mapagtaas ng loob tayo na umaasa na mayroong Diyos na tutulong sa atin."

Napakahalaga ng word na 'commitment'. The word 'commitment' is the dedication of our body and mind. Sapagkat tayo ay nasa pisikal pa na katawan ng lupang ito, kailangan ay mayroong kaagarang paghahanda. Kailangang malinaw para sa atin ang word na 'commitment'. Dito natin makikita ang true commitment—naminsan ay nagkakahiwalay o nagkakalayo tayo dahil sa matinding pangangailangan pero nandoon pa rin iyong true commitment sa bawat isa. Pero ang commitment na pinaguusapan dito ay ang indibidwal nating commitment sa Panginoon. Sa larangan ng pisikal o personal na pangangailangan, kailangan maintindihan natin ang tunay na commitment natin sa Diyos. Kailanman ay hindi natin ito dapat isantabi dahil ang Diyos lamang ang nagbibigay ng tamang direksyon sa bawat plano, sa bawat pangarap at sa lahat ng ating gagawin.

Sabi sa Salita ng Diyos, itiwala mo sa Kaniya ang lahat ng iyong mga gawain upang ikaw ay magtagumpay. Dito sa Romans 12:1-2, mayroong pangungusap si Paul. "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sister, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship." In the translation, this is the act of true worship. Lalay daw natin ang ating mga buhay bilang handog na banal sa harapan ng Diyos. Ito ang pangungusap ni Apostol Pablo. Verse 2 says, 'Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.' Mahalaga ang dalawang bagay na iyon. First, commit our body to the Lord. Kailangan natin i-dedicate sa Lord ang ating mga isip. Dahil kung ano ang nabuong mga plano na galing sa ating mga isip ay bumababa sa ating mga puso. Kung ang Diyos natin ay hindi nakaupo sa ating mga puso, walang direksyon ang buhay natin.

'Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing, and

perfect will.' Sa lahat ng pagkakataon, ang tamang purpose ay sa Diyos lamang nagmumula. Kaya mahalaga na mangako din tayo sa Panginoon. Minsan, mayroong failure sa buhay habang tayo ay tumatahak. Ang mahalaga, kahit tayo ay mapagod, mapagtaas ng loob tayo na umaasa na mayroong Diyos na tutulong sa atin.

One importance of commitment is offering something to God. Isa sa mga bagay na mahalaga sa buhay ay ang i-denry ang ating sarili. Hindi na iyan ang sarili nating vision kung hindi ang vision na mag-commit sa Panginoon—ang vision, ang pangarap o plano na nakakonekta sa tamang direksyon o daan ng ating Panginoon.

"Ang Diyos lamang ang nagbibigay ng tamang direksyon sa bawat plano, sa bawat pangarap at sa lahat ng ating gagawin."

Kapag kasama natin ang Panginoon, mayroon laging tagumpay. We are more than conquerors. Napatunayan ko na ang Diyos lamang ang magdadala ng tagumpay ng isang nilalang sa mundong ito. Kapag walang pagsunod, walang tagumpay. Sabi ng Diyos, 'Huwag kang mag-alala. Kapag kasama mo Ako, magagawa mo ang lahat ng bagay.'

Covenant

Covenant is a special promise. In the Old Testament, covenant was made by God between His chosen ones. God made it before all men who had followed Him faithfully and obediently, and entrusted their lives to Him despite all uncertainties, persecutions, weaknesses, and even shortcomings. Some of the covenants that we can read in the Bible are with Noah, Abraham, Moses, and David. God made a covenant to His people, may it be conditional or general in context. It always begins with the obedience of God's people so God will bless them. The old covenant is made specific for God's chosen people (Deuteronomy 7:6), the nation of Israel, which was also mentioned in the Bible as "the cultivated olive tree" (Romans 11:24).

Not only that, the new covenant was extended to the entire world (Acts 28:28; Romans 11:11) and is no longer limited to the chosen nation. We, as Gentiles, were wild olive trees according to the Bible but were given the opportunity to be grafted in (Romans 11:24) and receive God's blessing.



transforming power that God's love has!

E. That we may know Christ's love (v.19)

1. Paul prays that the Ephesians will know something that is beyond knowing: Christ's love. He says the love of Jesus surpasses knowledge.
2. The love of Jesus is so great that we could never know it fully, but Paul's prayer (and this should be ours as well) is that followers of Jesus will know the love of Jesus more and more!

F. That we may be filled with the fullness of God (v.19)

1. All of these blessings result in us being filled with the fullness of God. Not in the sense that we have everything that God has; that's not what Paul is saying.
2. Rather, God has so much to give—He is so full—that He can fill us up all the way so that we can be all that He has called us to be, all that He has created us to be, and all that He desires for us to be!

III. Be mesmerized by God.

Ephesians 3:20-21 (NKJV)

²⁰Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, ²¹to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

A. These verses beautifully point back to the greatness and glory of

God. Paul is giving his readers and us a reason to be mesmerized by God.

B. To be mesmerized means to focus your attention on something so much that you lose focus on anything else.

C. Know who God is.

1. God is able to do above and beyond anything that we ask: God can!
2. God is able to do above and beyond anything that we think: God has a better plan!

D. God deserves all the glory!

1. The glory of God is manifested in Jesus Christ, seen in His obedience, His faithfulness, His suffering, His death, His resurrection, His ascension, and His work of salvation.
2. So also, the glory of God is manifested in the Church, which is the body of Christ, the vehicle through which God blesses the world, and the dwelling place of God's presence.

Just as the obedience that results in God's blessing, the priority of the temple and priesthood, and the unconditional promises to the house of David.

different perspective on the life of Jesus, the Book of 1 Chronicles presents Israel's history with a purpose different than the other historical books. The books of Chronicles, written after the time of the exile, focus on those elements of history that God wanted the returning Jews to meditate upon—

David's prayer in 1 Chronicles 29:10-19 summarizes the themes that the chronicler wished to communicate: glory to God, gratitude for gifting David's family with leadership of the nation, and the desire that David's descendants continue to devote themselves to God—remaining faithful to God would reap blessings.
