Great Sacrifice

1 Peter 2:21-24 (NIV)

²¹To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps. ²²He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth. ²³When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly. ²⁴He himself bore our sins" in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; "by his wounds you have been healed."

Introduction

The Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:1-5

"The former account I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, ²until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen, ³to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God. ⁴And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; ⁵for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

Introduction

The Promised Holy Spirit

- After being "born again", saved by grace
- Cleansed and washed by the blood
- Justified
- Sanctified

The promise is to wait for the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 19:1-6

¹And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples ²he said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" So they said to him, "We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit." ³And he said to them, "Into what then were you baptized?" So

they said, "Into John's baptism." ⁴Then Paul said, "John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus." ⁵When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. ⁶And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

Acts 1:4-5

⁴And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; ⁵for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

What is Baptism in the Holy Spirit?

Baptism in the Holy Spirit is an operation of the Spirit distinct and separate from His work of regeneration.

Just as the Spirit sanctifying work is distinct work complementing His regenerating work, so baptism in the Holy Spirit complements the regenerating and sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit.

On the day of Christ's resurrection, He breathed on His disciples and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit" (John 20:22), indicating that regeneration and new life were given to them.

Then, later they were told that they must be "clothed with power" by the Holy Spirit.

Acts 1:5, 8

⁵"For John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.

⁸"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Note

One can be regenerated and indwelt by the Holy Spirit, but still not baptized in the Holy Spirit.

Acts 19:6

And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

Note

To be baptized in the Holy Spirit means to be filled with the Spirit (this is equipping).

The book of Acts presents speaking in tongues as an initial sign accompanying the baptism in the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:4

And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 10:45-46

⁴⁵And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. ⁴⁶For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God.

Acts 19:6

And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

After the preparation of the saints, the promise is to wait.

Baptism in the Holy Spirit will bring personal boldness and power of the Holy Spirit in the believer's life

1 Corinthians 2:4

And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.

To accomplish mighty ministries of Christ

Deeper love and understanding of God's Word

The baptism in the Holy Spirit is sustained in the believer's life by:

- Prayer – Acts 4:31
- Witnessing – Acts 4:31-33
- Holiness – Romans 12:1-2
- Singing and praising God – Ephesians 5:18-19

Note

If these things are not present, the experience will soon become a fading glory.

The baptism in the Holy Spirit occurs only once in a believer's life in consecrating, witnessing, righteousness, and power in the believer's life.

The Bible teaches that there may be “new filling” with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 4:31 (Renewed)

And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Ephesians 5:18 (Maintained)

And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit.





"God's discipline makes us great. Disiplinado ba tayo? O puwede pa ba tayong idisiplina? Kasi kapag daw ang puno ay matanda

na, mahirap na raw baliin. Kapag ang tao ay may edad na ay mahirap nang turuan. So, let me define what is discipline. According to the dictionary, it is to punish or penalize for the sake of enforcing obedience and perfecting moral character. Training corrects, molds, or perfects the mental faculties or moral character. Ang disiplinang ay ang paraan para tayo ay ma-correct at ma-mold sa tamang pag-uugali at tamang way of life para hindi tayo mapariwara.

Doon sa military, may tinatawag na obstacle course. Kapag pumasok ka sa military, dadaan ka sa matinding training at isa doon ang obstacle course. Nakalagay doon, 'Passing through this obstacle will separate a man from the boys.' Hindi pala lahat kapag pumasok sa military ay lalaking-lalaki na. Mayroon palang hindi. Iyong mga obstacle course na dadaanan mo, iyon ang pinaka-training mo para ikaw ay ma-mold. Ang isang sundalo ay kailangan malakas, matapang at malakas

ang loob. Kaya sinabi doon, 'We separate a man from the boys.' Ang hindi papasa doon sa obstacle course na iyon ay ang boys. Ang mga papasa ay ang mga tunay na lalaki. Ganiyan din tayong mga Kristiyano, hindi ba? Marami tayong mga obstacle na dinadaan. Ngayon, kapag pumasa ka roon ay masasabi nating, 'Ito, tunay na Christian ito at malakas ang pananampalataya nito.' Pero kung ikaw ay nagmumukmok sa isang tabi, konting kibot ay hindi mo na alam ang gagawin mo.

"GOD DISCIPLINES US TO REVEAL HIS GLORY."

Sometimes, the Lord disciplines us through trials and sufferings. Ganoon magdisiplina ang Diyos sa atin. Kailangan dumaan tayo sa mga pagsubok at sa mga paghihirap. Pero take note, dalawang klase ang pagsubok o suffering. Mayroong pinahihintulutan ng Diyos at mayroong tayo mismo ang gumawa. Ang paghihirap natin ay resulta ng sarili nating kagagawan katulad na lang noong ginastos ng isang tao ang pera na pambayad ng Meralco dahil sa napadaan siya sa isang magandang kainan. Kinabukasan, lahat sila ay may hawak-hawak na abaniko dahil wala nang kuryente kasi naputulan na ng ilaw. Iyon ay sarili nating kagagawan. Kapag hindi tayo mag-iingat at wala tayong disiplinang, ganoon ang mangyayari sa atin.

Why does God discipline us? First, it is because of our sins. John 5:14 says, 'Afterwards Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, 'See, you have been made well, Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you.' Ito ang kasaysayan ng isang tao na mayroong infirmity—hindi siya makalakad at hindi siya makakilos. Nangyari ito doon sa pool of Bethesda at maraming tao at maraming sakit ang naiipon doon. Ang pool na iyon kapag hinalo ng isang anghel, may bumababa at ang pumupunta doon sa pool ay gumagaling. Hindi siya makalakad at hindi siya makababa doon sa pool. Whenever it is his turn, he can't get down. Dahil wala man lang magbubuhay sa kaniya kaya lagi

siyang nauunahan. Nakita siya ni Jesus. Tinanong siya, gusto mo bang gumaling? Sabi niya, 'Opo, kaso walang magdadala sa akin doon sa pool.' Pero, ang sabi sa kanya ng Panginoon, 'Rise and walk.' At gumaling iyong tao. Dito ipinapakita na ang kaniyang sakit ay resulta ng kasalanan. Kaya sabi doon, 'See, you have been made well. Sin no more.'

Kung minsan ay nagkakasakit tayo, ito ay dahil pabaya tayo sa ating mga sarili. Tayo ang may nagawa. Nagkakasakit tayo dahil mayroon tayong nagawa na kasalanan. Sinabi na ng mga doktor na bawal na manigarilyo dahil masusunog ang baga mo pero sigarilyo ka pa rin nang sigarilyo kaya nagkasakit ka ngayon. Sino ang may kasalanan? Tao. Iyang sakit mo ay dahil sa katigasan ng ulo mo. Ang ating mga sakit, karamdaman o anumang paghihirap ay marahil dahil na rin sa ating mga ginagawa.

Second, God disciplines us to reveal His glory. Sa John 11:4, mayroon ditong isang may sakit. Si Lazarus ay nagkasakit at siya ay namatay, pero ang pangyayaring iyon ay nangyari para i-reveal ang glory ni God. Akala natin kasi kapag nagkasakit tayo at namatay ay talagang parusa na sa atin iyon o doon ang talagang destiny natin, pero hindi pala. Mayroong pangyayari na pinahihintulutan sa atin upang malaman natin ang kaluwalhatian ng Panginoon.

Third, it is to reveal the works of God in us. John 9:2-3 says, 'And His disciples asked Him, saying, 'Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?'; Jesus answered, 'Neither this man or his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him.' Itong tao na ito ay ipinanganak na bulag. Nagtanong ang Kaniyang mga disipulo kung sino ang may kasalanan. Sinagot ni Jesus sa kanila, 'Neither this man or his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed.' The purpose noon ay to reveal the works of God.



HOLINESS

In the Old Testament, holiness was generally connected with God's perfection. To say that God is holy means that he is completely separate from all evil or defect. Or to put it in another way, God is completely and perfectly good. The Lord is worthy of total allegiance, exclusive worship, and loving obedience. In Leviticus, Israel's identity arises because by God's actions, they are holy, yet also because the Lord expects Israel to act holy in practical ways. Israel is called to be holy because the Lord Himself is holy (1 Peter 1:16, Leviticus 19:2).

Meanwhile, in the New Testament, holiness means to be "set apart". All people have sinned (Romans 3:23) and are imperfect. Our only option to be set apart is through the salvation offered through Jesus Christ (John 3:16; Romans 10:9; Ephesians 2:8-9). When we believe in Jesus as Lord, He cleanses us from sin and makes us holy (1 John 1:7).



As continuation of the 1 Chronicles, the 2 Chronicles introduces a new point of view wherein the writer is more concerned with the ways of proper worship than with political matters. It focuses on the story of Solomon building the temple and pays particular attention to Asa, Jehoshaphat, Hezekiah, and Josiah who were faithful and dedicated to bringing the people back to

God. Throughout 2 Chronicles, faithfulness was rewarded; betrayal was judged. Also, it was written to emphasize the blessings of the righteous kings and to expose the sins of the wicked kings. It parallels some parts of 1 and 2 Kings. Like 1 Chronicles, it is written from the viewpoint of a priest who spoke from spiritual perspectives, including revivals. It, too, was written after the exile and focuses on the correct worship of God.
