In Luke 1:26-38, ito ang passage kung paano sumunod si Mary sa plano ng Diyos sa buhay niya at kung paano rin tayo maaaring sumunod sa plano

ng Diyos. I will share to you three things so we could learn how to submit to God.

First, in Luke 1:30, sabi doon ng anghel, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor before God." And how are we going to submit to God? Like Mary, she found favor from God. When you say favor, it is something you cannot give on your own. Ang magbibigay lang noon ay ibang tao. Paano ka makakuha ng favor na iyon? You only earn favor, just like your parents, kapag inalam mo kung paano mo malulugod ang magulang mo. It is the same with God—we need to know how we can please God. Paano mo ba malulugod ang Lord sa buhay mo?

"ANUMANG PROBLEMA ANG NARARANASAN MO SA BUHAY, IF YOU PUT YOUR FAITH UNTO GOD AND YOU FOLLOW GOD, YOU CAN STILL FIND FAVOR FROM HIM."

Hebrews 11:6 says, "And without faith, we cannot please God". Ang ninanais ng Panginoon sa atin ay tayo ay manampalataya sa Diyos. Maski anumang problema ang nararasan mo sa buhay, if you put your faith unto God and you still follow God, you can still find favor from Him. Bakit? As you seek God, maski may persecution sa pamilya mo, you still go on to search for God, then God sees your heart. Kahit na may sakit ka, kapag sinabi mo, "Lord, a-attend ako kasi nananampalataya ako na mayroon kang gagawin sa buhay ko," and if you have that faith unto the Lord, then the Lord sees your heart and He is pleased in what you have done. Kaya the Lord will bless you more. Whatever you have in all aspects of your life, learn to find

favor from God. Kaya papasok na diyan ang paglilingkod. Kapag naglilingkod ka sa Panginoon, definitely you will find favor from the Lord; if you are serving God according to His purpose. Just like how Mary found favor in God.

Second, Mary sought how God will move. In Luke 1:34, after sabihin ni Angel Gabriel na si Mary ay magdadalang-tao at ang dadalhin niya sa tiyan niya ay Siyang magliligtas ng mga tao sa buong mundo, Mary sought how God will move. Magsubmit tayo sa plano ng Panginoon. Hanapin natin kung paano gagalaw ang Diyos sa buhay natin. Ang Lord ang magtuturo sa iyo kung paano mo masolve ang problema mo sa buhay. It is God who knows everything. Kaya nga hinayaan ng Panginoon na lumapit ka sa Kaniya para lalo kang maghanap sa Diyos ng solusyon sa problema mo.

Lastly, Mary submitted herself to the plans of God. Sabi sa passage ng Luke 1:38, "And Mary said, 'Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to Your Word.' Mary submitted her life to the plans of God.

"WHAT GOD WANTS IS FOR YOU TO SUBMIT. SUBMIT YOUR PLANS TO THE PLANS OF GOD."

Ang Diyos ay may plano sa iyo, mayroon Siyang mas magandang plano. Ang ninanais ng Panginoon ay mag-submit ka. Hayaan mo na lalo kang magtiwala sa Diyos. Magtiwala ka dahil with God, nothing is impossible. What God wants is for you to submit.

Submit your plans to the plans of God. Hindi natin alam dahil sa ating buhay marami tayong kakaharapin, pero sa Panginoong Diyos, lagi tayong mayroong kasiguraduhan. We have an assurance that God is a God who doesn't change. And He is a God who works on the people in the past. How God moved to them is the same on how God will move into your life.

Gusto mo ba mag-submit sa ninanais ng Panginoon sa buhay mo? God is looking unto your hearts.

"KAPAG NAGLILINGKOD KA SA PANGINOON, DEFINITELY YOU WILL FIND FAVOR FROM THE LORD; IF YOU ARE SERVING GOD ACCORDING TO THE PURPOSE OF GOD."

Let us do these three things. Let us find the favor from our God. Hanapin mo kung paano mo malulugod ang Diyos sa buhay mo. Pangalawa, seek how God will move unto your life. And lastly, if you have found God's favor and you have found how He will work, submit to the plans of God.

LIFE THEN, LIFE NOW PRAYING

Prayer is a wonderful privilege that Christians have. Through Jesus Christ and His death for our sins, and by the ministry of the Holy Spirit in our hearts, we have access to God the Father in prayer (Ephesians 2:18). That is a magnificent, life-transforming, and joyful privilege. And yet we need to be taught how to use this privilege; we need to be taught how to pray. During Old Testament times, prayers are also in the form of psalms.

In the New Testament time, Jesus gave His disciples the pattern of the Lord's Prayer when they asked him to teach them to pray (Luke 11:2–4; Matthew 6:9–13). In many ways, the Psalms are the expanded version of the Lord's Prayer. Just as the Lord's prayer expresses, in brief, adoration for the majesty of God's holiness, a yearning for God's will to be done on earth as it is in heaven, a supplication for God to provide for us all that we need, and concern to live with purity in a sinful world, we shall find that the Psalms express all these expansively and majestically.

God hears us when we ask according to His will (1 John 5:14) and in Jesus' Name (John 14:14; 16:23, 26). That is why prayer is important. Prayer was given to us by God in order to communicate with Him who is unseen.

WHY READ THE BOOK OF EZRA?

The Book of Ezra records two different time periods following the 70 years of Babylonian captivity. Ezra 1–6 covers the first return of Jews from captivity, led by Zerubbabel. Ezra 7–10 continued the story after more than 60 years when Ezra led the second group of exiles to Israel (458 BC). Book of Ezra shows the rebuilding of the new temple and the unity of the returning

have shared common struggles and challenges as they work together. Later, after the original tribes had stopped work on the city walls and spiritual apathy ruled, Ezra arrived with another 2,000 people and had a spiritual revival. By the end of the book, Israel had renewed its covenant with God and started following His will.

Ezra's story reveals two main issues faced by the returning

exiles. One is the challenges faced in restoring the temple (Ezra 1:6–22) and the second is the need for spiritual reformation (7:1–10:44). Both were needed in order for the people to renew their fellowship with the Lord.

Another purpose is also revealed: God keeps His promises. With the help of the prophets, God had ordained the return of His chosen people after a 70-year exile. Ezra's account also proclaims how God keeps His Word, and it shows that when the people of God remained faithful, they will be continually blessed.

IV. Psalms 103

a. Our responsibility

Psalms 103:1-2

¹Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name! ²Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits.

- executes righteousness and justice (v. 6)


