The Parable of the Talents



Matthew 25:14-30 (NKJV)

¹⁴For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them. ¹⁵And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey. ¹⁶Then he who had received the five talents went and traded with them, and made another five talents. ¹⁷And likewise he who had received two gained two more also. ¹⁸But he who had received one went and dug in the ground, and hid his lord's money. ¹⁹After a long time the lord of those servants came and settled accounts with them. ²⁰So he who had received five talents came and brought five other talents, saying, 'Lord, you delivered to me five talents; look, I have gained five more talents besides them.' ²¹His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.' ²²He also who had received two talents came and said, 'Lord, you delivered to me two talents; look, I have gained two more talents besides them.' ²³His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over

a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.' ²⁴Then he who had received the one talent came and said, 'Lord, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not scattered seed. ²⁵And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground. Look, there you have what is yours.' ²⁶But his lord answered and said to him, 'You wicked and lazy servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed. ²⁷So you ought to have deposited my money with the bankers, and at my coming I would have received back my own with interest. ²⁸So take the talent from him, and give it to him who has ten talents. ²⁹For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away. ³⁰And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'

Introduction

After reading the parable of the talents, it gets into my mind and I ask myself, what type of God's servant am I?

It reminds me of my limited times and days in this world and begin to assess and reassess my service to the Lord from time to time. I have been doing my ministry for more than forty years now, reminding myself of the condition of service that I have committed so that I will not fall out of His grace when the time comes.

I begin to ask myself

- Which servant group do I belong to?

- What type of God's worker am I?

Note:

I know that God is going to require an accounting of my service, even so to each one of us. Our obedience, our faithfulness, and our responsibility to our ministry will determine the position we will occupy in eternity in God's Kingdom in this last day.

- Why is the church so weak today?

The church nowadays has trusted in the wisdom and the abilities of man rather than in the Word and in the power of the Holy Spirit.

The fear of the Lord is nowhere to be found today, but instead the fear of material things and self-

centeredness are the common things seen in many church practices. They fear sickness and diseases, rather than trusting God for His purpose and healing works.

People begin to thwart their faith in human logic and reasoning, rather than trusting in God's Word. People begin to look for an alternative ministry, rather than trusting the Holy Spirit to direct their ministry call.

People begin to look for the material things and needs, rather than obeying the "put God first" priority in serving God.

People come out with many reasons and sorry slogans in life, rather than standing courageously to the call of God no matter what it costs.

People will always say they believe and love God, but do not obey His commandments.

People become man's pleasers rather than God's.

People always look for short and quick solution rather than the eternal promise and purpose of God in our life.

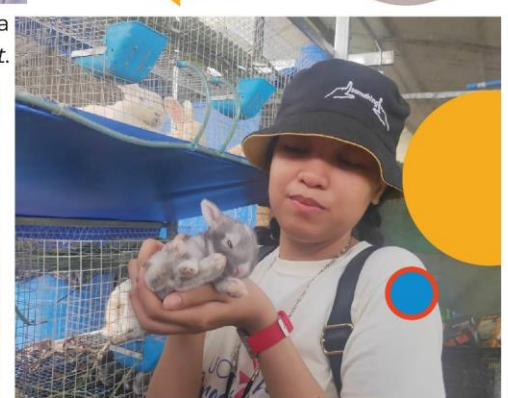

UCA is selected as a COVID-19 vaccination site both for adults and the younger ones on Thursday, April 28 in connection with the vaccination efforts of the Parañaque City Local Government Unit.

Available vaccines provided include Janssen & Janssen, Sinovac, AstraZeneca, Pfizer, and Moderna for first dose, second dose, and booster shots of adults. Meanwhile, those aged 5-17 years old are given Pfizer and Moderna vaccines.

With the help of the LGU officers and volunteer medical practitioners, a total of 255 people are vaccinated in UCA.

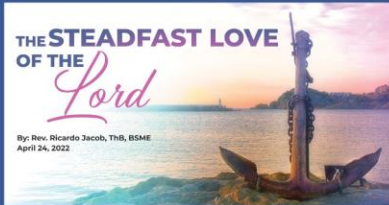

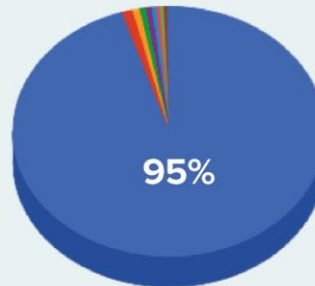

LIFE THEN, LIFE NOW CHURCH

In the Old Testament, the whole tabernacle was considered holy as it was set apart for worship and sacrifices to God (Exodus 26). However, the tabernacle was separated into three areas, the Outer Court, the Holy Place, and the Most Holy Place (or Holy of Holies). Priests and Levites ministered in the Outer Court as they offered sacrifices for sin and guilt as well as the other sacrifices (Leviticus 17:5). In the center of the Outer Court was a tent that only the priests could enter. This place was set apart—it was holy (Exodus 27:9-19). The tabernacle and the temple emphasized the presence of God in the midst of His people. God was always there and accessible. At the same time, the Holy Place and Most Holy Place emphasized God's holiness and His inaccessibility due to the sins of the people.

When Jesus died on the cross, the curtain dividing the Holy Place and the Most Holy Place was supernaturally torn in two (Matthew 27:51; Mark 15:38; Luke 23:45). The torn curtain symbolized that the way to God was now open to all through the death of Christ. The blood of an animal was no longer needed.

In the New Testament, the word church comes from the Greek word "ecclesia", which means a called-out company or assembly. It refers to people—it can be a mob (Acts 19:30-41), the children of Israel (Acts 7:38), and the body of Christ (Ephesians 1:22; Ephesians 5:25, 32). We are the church. It is not a physical infrastructure, but rather it is the body of Christ—believers of Christ.

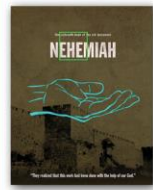

WHY READ THE BOOK OF NEHEMIAH?

The Book of Nehemiah is about reestablishing the people of God both physically and spiritually because the Jews have returned home and have rebuilt the temple in Jerusalem after 70 years in exile. They are able to worship God in their own land, but the city still lay in ruins.

In the first part of the book, Nehemiah restores Jerusalem in a physical sense. When Nehemiah

hears that "the wall of Jerusalem is broken down and its gates are burned with fire," he gets permission from Persian King Artaxerxes to rebuild the city. The governors of surrounding territories opposed Nehemiah's efforts, but the wall was finished in just 52 days.

In the second section, Nehemiah and Ezra brought spiritual revival to Jerusalem. Ezra reads the law of Moses aloud to the people, and the nation rededicates to obeying God.

Later on, Nehemiah works diligently to point people back to the law of Moses. This book also focuses on the Lord's protection of His people, the need for their faithfulness in keeping the Torah (the Mosaic law), their faithfulness in worship and in joyfully giving their resources, and how the Lord works providentially.

At the end, God is teaching His people in this book to be on guard against their own moral weakness and not to be afraid despite the struggles because God will protect them.
