Wise Witnessing



Colossians 4:2-6 (NKJV)

²Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving; ³meanwhile praying also for us, that God would open to us a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in chains, ⁴that I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak. ⁵Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time. ⁶Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.

Introduction

God called us for a purpose. He wanted us to be His witness, to seek those who are lost, and to bring them to Christ.

Luke 19:10

"For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

Jesus said that we are the salt of the earth and the light of the world. He wanted our lights to shine for people to see our good works for the glory of God.

Matthew 5:13-16

¹³"You are the salt of the earth; but

if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. ¹⁴You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

The two most common witnesses are the silent witnesses and the aggressive witnesses.

The silent won't talk to others/ to strangers about Jesus Christ. They do not want to be placed in an awkward situation. They do not want to be rude or insensitive.

The aggressive are the type who sell products door-to-door or like a telemarketer. They talk literally to everyone and do not mind even if the listeners pay no attention or even interested in what they are saying.

Paul teaches us not to be silent nor aggressive witnesses, but be wise witnesses for Christ.

In private:

I. Continue in prayer with thanksgiving.

Before you talk to a person about God, talk to God about that person.

a. Pray in private.

Matthew 6:6

But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.

b. Pray that God would open to you an opportunity for the Word, to speak the mystery of Christ, and be made manifest as you speak.

Acts 10:44

While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.

c. Pray thankfully. Pray in faith, especially when our circumstances often do not seem to be in our favor.

Ephesians 6:18

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all

perseverance and supplication for all the saints.

In public:

II. Walk in wisdom.

The Book of Proverbs often contrasts the wise man with the fool. The fool disregards God's commandments about how to live, but the wise man skillfully orders his life according to God's Word so that the results are like a finely crafted piece of furniture. To walk in wisdom produces a beautiful life.

We are to live in line with God's Word so that the world may see Jesus Christ in our lives.







The second character is 'hopeth all things'. Puno sila ng pag-asa. Ang pag-asa ay nananatili pa rin sa kaniyang puso at sa kaniyang isipan. Puno ng pag-asa dahil ito ay isa sa mga nagbibigay ng kulay at ng buhay na kaugnay sa ating Panginoon—isang pag-asa na ibinigay sa atin ng Diyos na nagsimula sa Banal na Espiritu na ipinagkaloob sa ating lahat. Kaya hindi tayo dapat mawalan ng pag-asa. Anomang situwasyon na mayroon tayo, umasa tayong may gagawin ang Panginoon.

The third is called 'trusting and believing all things'. May nangyari man na pagsubok, nagtitiwala pa rin sila. Nagtitiwala na, naniniwala pa—pagtitiwala na inilagay na katangian ng Panginoon sa puso't isipan ng mga nanay at paniniwala na

hindi kayang gibain ng kahit anumang balita. Isang bagay na madalas itinuturo at sinasabi ni Haring Solomon, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." Mayroong lakas sa pagtitiwala na hindi kayang sirain o gibain. Kung malawak ang pang-unawa at ang ating pag-iisip, hindi tayo mawawasak. Ako ay naniniwala na kapag ang Diyos ang matibay na namumuno at pundasyon ng bawat tahanan o ng mag-asawa, anomang obstacle, even in times of trouble, ang paniniwala at pagtitiwala ay nasa Panginoon.

Pang-apat, ito ay tinatawag na 'providing hospitality'. Ito ay likas na sa atin. Madalas naririnig natin na ang mga Pilipino ay hospitable at maasikaso pero higit ang mga nanay. Sa pasimula palang ng pagtataas ng pamilya, nawa ay hindi ito magbabago.

The fifth is 'helping the father train the children'. Kailangan ituro natin ang Salita ng Panginoon sa loob at labas ng ating tahanan. It is said in Proverbs 6:22, 'Train up a child in the way he should go.' Kailangan natin silang turuan at kailangang magtulungan ang mag-asawa sa kanilang anak. Habang tinuturuan natin sila sa paglaki nila ay hindi sila magiging sakit ng ulo ng magulang.

The sixth is 'using her skills to provide for the needs of the home'. Isa ito sa mga katangian ng mga nanay. Sila ay nagsisikap na mai-provide ang pangangailangan sa bahay. Sa Proverbs ay inihalimbawa sila sa merchants. Sila ay nagdadala ng kalakal para may maihain sa kanilang mga anak, sa kanyang asawa at sa kanilang kasambahay. Pagod man ay kailangang bumangon at paghandaan ito. Sa pagpasok ng mga anak, kailangang makita mo ang kanilang pag-alis. Ganoon ang katangian ng mga nanay. Kaya mapalad ang mga anak na ang mga magulang ay nagsusumikap na ibahagi rin ang ganitong katangian. Mapalad ang mga anak na nakikita nila ang kanilang mga nanay kung paano sila inaasikaso at nasusabaybayan. Kaya mayroong mga anak na sumusunod sa yapak ng kanilang mga ina. Dahil nakita niya ang isang magandang halimbawa sa kaniyang paglaki.

Ang Panginoong Jesus noong Siya ay pinahirapan sa krus, nilait noon bilang isang makasalanan, sinabihan na kung talagang Siya ang Diyos ay iligtas Niya ang Kaniyang sarili pati na rin ang iba, ngunit ang sabi ng nasa Kanyang kaliwa, 'Panginoon, alalahanin Niyo ako pagdating Mo sa kaharian'. Noong panahon na iyon, banayad pa rin Siya sa ginawa sa Kaniyang paghihirap. Mahinahon Niya pa ring sinabing, 'Sige, ngayon din isasama kita.' Ganoong klaseng katangian ang mayroon ang mga nanay.



My disciples, if you have love for one another.

Philippians 2:14-15

¹⁴Do all things without complaining and disputing, ¹⁵that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world.

III. Talk with grace.

a. Be gracious.

Speak to sinners as a fellow sinner who are forgiven and not as a judge.

b. Be interesting.

Salt is used as preservatives and a cleansing agent. Speak to restore and stimulate people's taste to want more.

c. Be sensitive.

Discern your listeners. Jesus confronted the proud Pharisees, but was gentle (although He still dealt with sin) with those who knew they were guilty. Pray for wisdom as you speak, so that you will know how to respond to this person's unique needs.

Conclusion

- Pray with thanksgiving and for God to open opportunity for the gospel.
- Walk in wisdom to shine as the light of the world.
- Talk with grace and communicate the necessary content of the gospel.

WHY READ THE BOOK OF ESTHER?

The main purpose of the Book of Esther is to celebrate the providence of God, especially in regard to His chosen people, Israel. Interestingly, it's the only biblical book that does not mention God by name, yet throughout, it reveals how God works behind the scenes to deliver the Jews in Persia. God uses Esther to help His people (Esther 4:14) and through her faithfulness,

Haman is finally defeated and the Jews enjoy rest from their enemies.

The Book of Esther records the institution of the Feast of Purim and the obligation of its perpetual observation. The word Purim is derived from the Persian word pur ("lot") and recalls how Haman, the enemy of the Jews, cast lots to determine the best day to carry out his plan to exterminate them (Esther 3:7). The Feast of Purim commemorates the great deliverance

of the Jewish nation brought about by God through Esther.

The story of Esther is a lesson to Christians to trust God and allow God to use us in the outworking of His divine purpose. Christians don't need to celebrate Purim, but they do need to pay heed to the history of God's dealings with His chosen people. It's a lesson on how God is sovereign, and how worldly rulers can't have it all in their own way. We learn from the mistakes of those who oppose God and the victories of those who trust God.
