God's Time or Man's Time?

John 7:1-13 (NKJV)

¹After these things Jesus walked in Galilee; for He did not want to walk in Judea, because the Jews sought to kill Him. ²Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was at hand. ³His brothers therefore said to Him, "Depart from here and go into Judea, that Your disciples also may see the works that You are doing. ⁴For no one does anything in secret while he himself seeks to be known openly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world." ⁵For even His brothers did not believe in Him. ⁶Then Jesus said to them, "My time has not yet come, but your time is always ready. ⁷The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it that its works are evil. ⁸You go up to this feast. I am not yet going up to this feast, for My time has not yet fully come." ⁹When He had said these things to them, He remained in Galilee. ¹⁰But when His brothers had gone up, then He also went up to the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret. ¹¹Then the Jews sought Him at the feast, and said, "Where is He?" ¹²And there was much complaining among the people concerning Him. Some said, "He is good"; others said, "No, on the contrary, He deceives the people." ¹³However, no one spoke openly of Him for fear of the Jews.

Introduction

How important is your time?

As believers of Christ, we should understand the importance of time:

I. Life is short and eternity is forever.

A. If Jesus had been born in our time, His parents would have recognized that He was an unusually gifted child.

1. They would have begun His education early, put Him on the gifted child track, and had Him preaching by the age of 12 when He made an impression on the scholars in the temple.
2. By the time He was 20, He would have a huge international following. With a good public relations man, He could have learned to tone down some of His more offensive comments so that the religious leaders would not have plotted to kill Him.
3. Think how much more He could have accomplished if He had lived to 70 or 80!

B. But Jesus, living by God's time, didn't begin His ministry until He was about 30 and after three short years, He could pray the accomplished life.

John 17:4 (NKJV)

I have glorified You on the earth. I have

finished the work which You have given Me to do.

C. If we want to think like Jesus, we need to live with the awareness of how short life is and that one day we will give an account to God for how we spent our lives.

Psalm 90:17 (NASB 1995)

Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us; And confirm for us the work of our hands; Yes, confirm the work of our hands.

II. Jesus' brothers were living by man's time: Their time was always opportune.

A. Those living by man's time are not living under the lordship of Christ.

John 7:5 (NKJV)

For even His brothers did not believe in Him.

B. Those living by man's time go along with their culture apart from Christ.

Luke 12:16-21 (NKJV)

¹⁶Then He spoke a parable to them, saying: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded plentifully. ¹⁷And

he thought within himself, saying, 'What shall I do, since I have no room to store my crops?' ¹⁸So he said, 'I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build greater, and there I will store all my crops and my goods. ¹⁹And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, and be merry." ' ²⁰But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?' ²¹So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God."

C. Those living by man's time operate by worldly wisdom, not by God's wisdom.

John 7:4 (NKJV)

For no one does anything in secret while he himself seeks to be known openly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world.

1 Corinthians 2:23-25 (NKJV)

²³But we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness, ²⁴but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. ²⁵Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

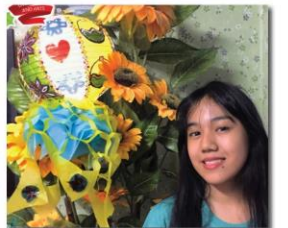

Tuloy-tuloy pa rin ang pagbibigay ng libreng bakuna laban sa COVID-19 sa Barangay San Antonio, Parañaque City. Sa pangunguna ng punong barangay na si Kap. Leopoldo "Pol" Casale, isinagawa ang malawakang pagbakuna noong Mayo 27, Biyernes, kung saan napili ang United Christian Academy (UCA) bilang *vaccination site*.

Ang mga bakunang ibinigay ay Sinovac, AstraZeneca, Moderna at Pfizer para sa mga sumailalim sa *first dose, second dose, first booster at second booster*. Ang higit 400 na nabakunahan ay mga bata na may edad limang taong gulang hanggang sa mga *senior citizen*. Ito ay binuksan din para sa iba pang kababayan natin na mula sa iba't ibang barangay sa Parañaque.

UCA, built from God's vision

As Rev. Dr. William Sy remains faithful to his calling as God's servant, he received a vision from God in February 1992 wherein colorful glasses from different directions gathered in front of Rev. Dr. Sy, forming books in various colors and forms. At first, Rev. Dr. Sy thought that God was instructing him to establish a Bible school. But in March 1997, God spoke to Rev. Dr. Sy once again with a clear message of building an academic school, giving birth to United Christian Academy (UCA).

Rev. Dr. Sy planted a seed of faith of PHP 100,000 to establish the school, starting with only a handful of teachers and students. And each year, the number of students increases as UCA becomes more known in Parañaque and its neighboring cities as a school that provides quality education and spiritual guidance to its students.



UCA was certified by the Private Education Assistance Committee (PEAC) to provide Educational Service Contracting (ESC) scholarships to students from public schools. This became a way for more students to access quality yet affordable education.



A milestone was achieved by UCA after more than a decade of waiting as the number of students soared to more than 500.



The Lord's provision to the school is still evident as it reaches out to more students locally and internationally with the launching of UCA Online in 2020.

UCA was granted by the Department of Education (DepEd) with government recognition for its kindergarten and elementary courses. The following year, the school received recognition for its secondary course.

III. Jesus lived by God's time: He submitted fully to God's plan for His life.

A. To live by God's time, be directly accountable to Him for how you spend your time.

1. Jesus did not allow His brothers' advice to govern when He went up to the feast, but went in response to the Father's timetable.
2. Jesus was accountable to the Father to do everything in His life and ministry as the Father directed.

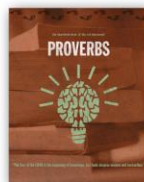

WHY READ THE BOOK OF PROVERBS?

The Book of Proverbs is considered as one of the books of wisdom, among them are the books of Job and Ecclesiastes, and was written by the wisest, wealthiest, and most powerful man scripted in the Bible, King Solomon, the son of David.

This book compiles numerous short instructions for living an effective life on earth. Other books in the Bible appear to be prophetic and are based on theological truths. This book's concern is to instruct people on the path of wisdom. It reminds us to fear the Lord in order to live a happy and peaceful life in accordance with the will of God.
