

Hebrews 9:1-14 (NKJV)

Then indeed, even the first covenant had ordinances of divine service and the earthly sanctuary. 2For a tabernacle was prepared: the first part, in which was the lampstand, the table, and the showbread, which is called the sanctuary; 3and behind the second veil, the part of the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of All, 4which had the golden censer and the ark of the covenant overlaid on all sides with gold, in which were the golden pot that had the manna, Aaron's rod that budded, and the tablets of the covenant; 5 and above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail. 6Now when these things had been thus prepared, the priests always went into the first part of the tabernacle, performing the services. ⁷But into the second part the high priest went alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and for the people's sins committed in ignorance; 8the Holy Spirit indicating this, that the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first tabernacle was still standing. 9It was symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience-10 concerned only with foods and drinks, various washings, and fleshly ordinances

imposed until the time of reformation. 11But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. 12Not with the blood of goats and calves. but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. 13For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, 14how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Introduction

The tabernacle or sanctuary is the central place or structure of the Jews for worship and communion with God back in the days of the Old Testament until Jesus came into the world.

Unlike our present day sanctuary or church buildings that are designed according to the churches history, culture, or just from the imagination of its congregation, the sanctuary of the Jews was carefully built according to the instructions of God. We can say that the architect of it is God Himself, Moses is the foreman of it.

The sanctuary in the Old Testament times has portions and furnishings that were constructed and made to signify and symbolize the proper worship and communion to God.

I. The Tabernacle Complex a. The Walls of the Tabernacle

- The walls were white and made of fine linen and supported by pillars that were set in sockets of brass and had tops of silver.
- The walls of white linen symbolized the righteousness and holiness of God
- When the Jews looked at the white walls, they were reminded that God is holy and dwells in righteousness.

b. The Gate of the Tabernacle

- There is only one gate into the tabernacle—it was on the east side.
- It was made of fine linen. The colors were blue, purple, and scarlet (red).
- The gate symbolizes that there is only one way to enter God's presence, and that God must be approached. No person shall ever live with God unless he approaches God.

c. The Brazen Altar

- It was a hollow box-like structure made of acacia wood covered with brass with a brass grate across its top.
 There were four horns for tying the sacrificial animals down.
- It symbolized that substitutionary sacrifice is necessary for the forgiveness of sins. There is no forgiveness without the shedding of

the blood of the sacrifice.

-There is no way to approach God and to be saved other than through the death of a substitute.

d. The Laver in the Courtyard

- It is a large basin made of brass that contained the water which the priest used to wash and cleanse themselves before they served God and carried out their ministry for the Lord.
- This symbolized that a person cannot enter God's presence except if he is cleansed and made pure.
- A person cannot serve God unless he is cleansed and made pure.

II. The Holy Place (Outer Sanctuary) a. The Outer Veil or Curtain Door

- It was made of fine linen. The colors were blue, purple and scarlet (red).
- It was supported on five pillars that were overlaid by gold and set into sockets of brass.
- It was the only opening into the Holy Place.
- It symbolized that a person cannot rush into the presence of the holy God.
- There is only one way into the deeper things of God, a deeper knowledge of Him, much more to knowing and experiencing God's presence than just making sacrifices and receiving forgiveness of sins.

b. The Golden Lampstand

- A lampstand made of pure gold and

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



Tapili ang United Christian Academy (UCA) bilang vaccination site para sa mga alagang hayop na isinagawa naga Nagara sa mga alagang hayop na isinagawa noong Hunyo 8, Miyerkules.

Matagumpay na naisagawa ang libreng laban sa rabies sa mga alagang aso at pusa ng ating proteksiyon sa komunidad mga kababayan sa Barangay San Antonio at mga karatig na barangay nito. Ito ay pinamunuan ni Dr. Karen Camille Vicencio na isang beterinaryo.

> Ang bakunang ibinigay sa mga alagang hayop ay nakakatulong upang maiwasan ang pagkakaroon nila ng rabies. Ito ay isang oportunidad upang masiguro hindi lamang ang kaligtasan ng mga hayop kung hindi pati ng mga taong kanilang makakasalamuha. Matagumpay na nabakunahan ang 189 na mga hayop kung saan 109 ang bilang ng mga aso at 80 naman ang bilang ng mga pusa.

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

The Perfect...

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burned pure olive oil.

- It was a perpetual (unending) light. It was never allowed to burn out, and it was the only light source in the room because there were no windows in the Holy Place.
- It symbolized that a person needs light and illumination in order to know God and to serve God.
- Without light and illumination, a person will be in pitch darkness and totally unable to know and serve God.

c. The Table of the Showbread

- It was a small table made of acacia wood covered with gold. It has rings on each corner, so that a pole could be inserted, and the table be transported from place to place.
- It was used to display 12 loaves of bread sprinkled with frankincense.
 Fresh loaves of bread were placed on the table every Sabbath, and the frankincense was removed from old loaves and burned as a special offering to God.
- It symbolized that God and the worship of Him is the bread of life. It is the nourishment that man really needs.
- The frankincense symbolized that God is pleased with man worshipping Him.

d. The Altar of Incense

- It was a small altar made of acacia wood overlaid with gold. It also has rings for poles to be inserted for transport.
- It was used for the burning of incense to God. The incense was a perpetual offering sent to God, and it was never

allowed to stop burning.

- Once a year, the blood of the atonement sacrifice was sprinkled upon it.
- The incense symbolized the prayers of the people being offered up to God.
 Prayer and intercession are essential for worshipping God, and it should be continually offered up to God.
 There should be unbroken prayer and communion with God.

III. The Most Holy Place

a. The Inner Veil or Curtain Door

- It was made of fine linen. The colors were blue, purple and scarlet (red) with figures of cherubims embroidered into the linen.
- It was supported by pillars made from acacia wood overlaid with gold and set in sockets of brass. The curtain was held up by golden hooks.
- It separated the Most Holy Place, which is the symbol of God's presence, from all other acts of worship in the tabernacle.
- No one was allowed to enter the Most Holy Place except the High Priest and could only enter once a year on the Day of Atonement.
- It symbolized that fellowship and communion with God Himself is the supreme act of worship.
- God is righteous and holy, far removed from man and his world that is totally apart and separated from the corruption and uncleanness of man.
- God must be approached in reverence, awe, and fear.

b. The Ark of the Covenant

- -It was built like a chest or box made of acacia wood overlaid with gold inside and outside and also had rings for poles to be inserted for transport.
- The cover or top of the ark was called

the Mercy Seat. It was a slab of pure gold. Arising from both ends of the ark were two angelic creatures called cherubim who reached over and shadowed the mercy seat. The very presence of God was supposed to rest upon the mercy seat.

- The ark contained three important items: the ten commandments, the golden pot of manna, and Aaron's rod that budded.
- It was upon the mercy seat that the blood of atonement was sprinkled, symbolizing that God could be approached only through the sacrifice of a life for sins.
- It symbolized that a person is acceptable to God only through the substitutionary sacrifice of a pure life.
 Sins can only be forgiven through the substitutionary blood of a pure sacrifice.

The earthly sanctuary is not enough.

The tabernacle was for the worship of God, but it was only an earthly sanctuary, and it was totally inadequate in reaching God and making a person acceptable to God. Why?

- Because the tabernacle was made with earthly things. Although each portion has religious meanings, those were still earthly—only a shadow and faint copy of real worship. Same with our sanctuaries nowadays.
- 2. The one that carried the ministry and acts of worship for the people are the priests, who were also humans. No matter how much ministry they performed for the people, they could not make the people perfect, and they could not make the people acceptable to God. Same with our pastors and leaders nowadays.
- 3. Because the approach to God

through gifts and sacrifices cannot make a person perfect and acceptable to God. We cannot bribe God. Offering gifts to God and sacrificing animals as substitute for sins are still earthly acts. It helps us to see and understand God to some degree, yet they are just shadows and faint copies of perfect worship, and they cannot remove our guilt or make us perfect.

Jesus is the Perfect Sanctuary.

Every portion and symbolisms of the earthly sanctuary or the tabernacle is fulfilled by Jesus Christ.

- Righteousness and holiness of God (2 Corinthians 5:21, Ephesians 4:24)
- Only gate to enter God's presence (John 10:9, John 14:6)
- Substitutionary sacrifice for forgiveness of sin (Mark 10:45, Isaiah 53:7, John 1:29)
- Cleansing and making one pure (Ephesians 5:25-26, Hebrews 9:14, 1John 1:7)
- The way to a deeper knowledge of God (John 17:3, 1 Corinthians 1:30, 2 Peter 1:2-4)
- The light and illumination to know and serve God (John 8:12, John 1:4, 2 Corinthians 4:6)
- The bread and nourishment of life (John 6:48, John 6:33-35)
- Perpetual intercession for the people (Romans 8:34, Hebrews 7:25)
- Pure, sinless sacrifice for men (1 John 2:2, Galatians 1:4, Titus 2:14)

Conclusion

Jesus Christ alone can make us perfect and acceptable to God. He is our perfect sanctuary.
