RIGHTEOUSNESS

The Law clearly defined what God required of His people. In the Old Testament, while the Law revealed the standard, it did not give anyone the ability to live up to the standard (Psalm 78:10; Jeremiah 22:21). Though men tried, they failed because the Law then could not change hearts, and it still cannot do that today. Then comes the New Testament or the New Covenant. The major theme of the New Testament is grace. While the Law is still present to reveal how God wants us to live and to make us aware of sin, grace does what the law could not do (Romans 6:14).

Grace opens the door for salvation for us to be declared righteous (Galatians 2:21). This does not occur because we can keep the Law since men still can't keep it. Grace allows us to put our trust in the one who kept the Law perfectly for us, who is Jesus (John 1:17). Grace makes what is impossible, possible. Our ability to be declared righteous by observing the law was impossible. However, our ability to be justified by grace through faith in Jesus Christ is possible (Ephesians 2:8).

While the Old Testament revealed our sin (the Law), the New Testament shows us how to deal with our sin (grace). We are made righteous through our faith in Jesus Christ (Philippians 3:9).

The world "under the sun," which is often mentioned in several verses, illustrates all the earthly. temporary, and human things, that apart from God are frustrating, cruel, unfair, and brief. Even the best achievements a man could ever have is worth nothing in the long run. But with Christ, life will only be with glories that await in heaven and is only accessible through Him.
