- He was a sinner. Even though Nicodemus was considered religious and a leader in the community, he also needed God.

Ephesians 4:31-32 (NKJV)

³¹Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. ³²And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

Luke 23:34 (NKJV)

Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots.

Ephesians 4:30 (NKJV)

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

Ephesians 4:26 (NKJV)

"Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath.

Romans 12:19 (NKJV)

Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord.

All are in need of forgiveness.

Romans 3:23 (NKJV)

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

- From a spiritual perspective, we were all born with a sin problem, eternally separated from God. We'd be lost forever without God intervening and offering us forgiveness.
- God is there with open arms to offer forgiveness.

1 John 1:9 (NKJV)

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Forgiving others is a prerequisite for our own forgiveness.

Matthew 6:14-15 (NKJV)

¹⁴"Forifyou forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. ¹⁵But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses."

- God stands ready and willing to forgive us but asks that we extend the same forgiveness to others first.
- If we have resentment and bitterness in our hearts, it's time to give it over to God. Let Him heal us and give us the ability to forgive. Our eternity is dependent on it.

Bible Reference

Genesis 4 (Cain and Abel)

John 10:28 (NKJV)

And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

Galatians 5:22-23 (ESV)

²²But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Unforgiveness breaks our relationship with God.

Matthew 5:23-24 (NKJV)

²³Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, ²⁴leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

- The Bible is very clear that harboring bitterness in our hearts is sin. And, if we aren't actively seeking to kill it, it will break our fellowship with God. We won't experience everything God has to offer us.

We owe others forgiveness even when they don't ask for it.

Matthew 18:15-16 (NKJV)

¹⁵"Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother. ¹⁶But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that 'by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established."

John 3:16 (KJV)

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

We owe forgiveness to those who don't deserve it.

Acts 7:59-60 (NKJV)

⁵⁹And they stoned Stephen as he was calling on God and saying, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." ⁶⁰Then he knelt down and cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, do not charge them with this sin." And when he had said this, he fell asleep.

- Every time we find it difficult to forgive those who don't deserve it, always remember that we also are not deserving, yet our heavenly Father found in His heart to love us and forgive us.

Daniel 9:9 (NKJV)

To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against Him.

We owe others an unlimited amount of forgiveness.

Matthew 18:21-22 (NKJV)

²¹Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" ²²Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven."

- Forgiving is hard, but doing it over and over again can seem impossible. But, with God, anything is possible.
- Jesus is clear in this passage that there is no "final straw" that warrants us withholding our forgiveness. God doesn't have a "final straw" for us.
- To be clear, this doesn't mean allowing others to take advantage of your forgiveness. God also gave us the ability to be reasonable and make smart choices with our lives.
- Holding on to resentment only takes our joy, while doing no harm to the other party.
- We should forgive repeatedly because God commands it and He knows what's best for our lives.

Mateo 5:44 (MBBTAG)

There are consequences for choosing not to forgive.

Matthew 18:34-35 (NKJV)

³⁴And his master was angry, and delivered him to the torturers until he should pay all that was due to him. ³⁵"So My heavenly Father also will do to you if each of you, from his heart, does not forgive his brother his trespasses."

- God takes forgiveness seriously, and this parable is proof. If we don't forgive others, there are consequences—eternal consequences.

Marcos 11:26 (MBBTAG)

God gives us the ability to forgive others.

- Forgiving can be one of the hardest things that God requires of us. But the good news is He doesn't command it of us and then leaves us to do it on our own. - He gives us Jesus as an example. And He gives us the power through the Holy Spirit.





It was the priests in the Old Testament who approached God, as intermediaries between God and humankind: they prayed, offered, sacrificed, and purified the whole people. God's commandment was transmitted to them and then to the whole of Israel, and they were to be pure and clean (Leviticus 11).

In the New Testament, Christ is a holy High Priest, without guile, without stain, separate from sinners and raised above the heavens; one who has no need to perform daily sacrifices for His sins and those of the people, as did the high priests during the Old Testament, because He did so once and for all when He offered Himself (Hebrews 7: 26-27).

The Apostles received this priesthood from Christ Himself, after His Resurrection, during the 40-day period of his presence on earth following this. Apart from teaching them 'about things concerning the kingdom of God' (Acts 1:3), Christ also transmitted to them the Holy Spirit, as well as the authority to remit or retain sins (John 20: 22-23). He also passed on to them the offices associated with His priesthood: the hieratic, that is the celebration of the sacraments; the royal, the authority to shepherd the flock of his Church; and the prophetic, the authority to preach the Gospel.
