

Titus 2:11-14 (NKJV)

"For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, "zteaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, "slooking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, "who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

God's grace is His unmerited favor. Grace means that God showered favor and blessing on those who did not, in any way, deserve or earn it. They deserved His judgment and wrath. But He showed them favor.

Many believers failed to grasp how the grace of God works. They are so familiar and get used in the world system that it became difficult for them to live the grace of God.

The world works on the merit system. If you do well in school, you get good grades and win awards. If you do well in sports, you make the team and get a lot of applause. If you get into college, the merit system continues to reward excellence. This carries over into the business world after college. Exceptional performance

earns promotions and raises. Sloppy performance will get you fired.

Even the world's religions, except for the biblical believers, work on the merit system. They teach a system of merit-salvation, where you have to add your works to what Christ did on the cross in order to go to heaven. Most of them who die will go to purgatory, where after suffering for a while and with the help of the prayers of their love ones, eventually you will have enough of their sins purged away and enough merit to qualify for heaven.

Most people will answer, "doing good or being a good person" is the way to heaven.

On the other hand, there are those who view grace as their license to sin.

The correct view is God's grace first saves and then trains His people for godliness and good deeds.

I. God's grace brings salvation to all people.

Paul says that the appearance of God's grace (Jesus Christ) brought "salvation to all men". It means that in the person of Jesus Christ, people get saved when they believe and received Him.

John 1:12-13

¹²But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: ¹³who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

This does not mean that all people are saved or will be saved. The Bible is also clear that there are two separate, final destinations for all people. Those who by God's grace believe in Jesus Christ as Savior will go to heaven. Those who do not believe in Christ will pay the penalty of eternal separation from God in hell.

The good news is that no sinner is beyond the reach of God's grace.

Luke 5:31-32

³¹Jesus answered and said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. ³²I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."

One of the hindrances that keeps a person from experiencing God's grace in salvation is self-righteousness.

You don't need salvation unless you are lost and you know that you're lost. If you think that you're doing just fine on your own or that you're

going to be able to make it on your own with a little more effort, you won't cry out for a Savior to deliver you.

II. God's grace trains us who are saved in godliness.

a. Grace trains us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires.

When you experience God's unmerited favor in Jesus Christ, it motivates you to want to please Him in everything that you do. As you search for Him more, it will make you realize that there are many things in your life that needed change. You become a follower who would do anything to please His Lord.

Luke 9:23


Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me."

This also includes saying "no" to ungodliness. Ungodliness is simply living and ignoring God. Your life is so busy with the world that there is no more place for God.



LIFE NOW CROSS

According to the Word of God, sin is equal to death (Romans 3:23). In the Old Testament, when a person commits sin, the punishment is death at the cross. Dying at the cross or being crucified is one of the most severe punishments that could be given to a sinner. As said in Deuteronomy 21:22-23, "If a man has committed a sin deserving of death, and he is put to death, and you hang him on a tree, his body shall not remain overnight on the tree, but you shall surely bury him that day, so that you do not defile the land which the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance; for he who is hanged is accursed of God."

In the New Testament, the symbolism of the cross has changed. Jesus claimed all the sins of the people on earth that they may be forgiven and saved as it is written in John 3:16. To this day onward, the cross is seen as a symbol of Jesus' sacrifice, the Savior of all. The cross serves as a reminder of how Jesus sacrificed Himself in order for the people to be saved. Salvation is given by God's grace through Jesus Christ.

In the Old Testament, the cross pertains to a humiliating and painful death. While in the New Testament, the cross is seen as the sacrifice for man's salvation through Jesus who became the ransom for our sins in order for us to be righteous (2 Peter 2:24).

him. ¹⁶For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

Grace trains you to say no to these things because God and His grace are far sweeter than anything the world can offer.

b. Grace trains us to live sensibly, righteously, and godly in this present age.

- Grace trains us to live sensibly.

It means living in a self-controlled manner, not yielding to various passions and impulses. It is within the fruit of the Spirit, which is self-control.

- Grace trains us to live righteously. It is a life of integrity and uprightness in your dealings with others. It means conforming to God's standards of conduct, as revealed in the commandments of His Word.
- Grace trains us to live godly.

It is holiness and devotion to God, beginning on the heart level. It means to live a God-ward life, knowing that He examines your heart. You confess sinful thoughts to Him and live in the love and fear of God.

III. God's grace trains us who are saved to be zealous for good deeds.

"Good deeds" refer to deeds that are done out of sincere love for God and others in obedience to His Word. "Zealous" is a word that is used to describe the fanatical Jewish sect that was devoted to ridding Israel of Roman domination. The Zealots were totally devoted to their cause, even to the point of risking their own lives to achieve their goals.

Challenge

Could you describe yourself as a fanatic for good deeds?

For a businessman, doing good deeds means deduction from taxes. For a politician, doing good deeds means performance for a vote. For a celebrity, doing good deeds is publicity and to gain more fans.

For a servant who was bought by the Blood of Jesus Christ, doing good deeds must be our total devotion to serve our Master.





ISAIAH

WHY READ THE BOOK OF ISAIAH?

Isaiah is a wellknown prophet in the Old Testament who proclaimed a

warning from God to godless people. The first chapters of this book were about the judgement upon an immoral and idolatrous man. But as the chapters continued, it later on conveyed the message of hope.

Isaiah became a prophet because of the vision that is shown to him. He saw God in His holiness and glory that overwhelmed him. His eyes were opened to God's need for a messenger to the people of Israel. When he became aware of this, Isaiah didn't heed his lack

but immediately offered himself for God's service. Thus, he was commissioned to give voice to the divine Word.

The messages he told were not always pleasant. It was his duty to announce that God had a will to destroy His beloved people for their continued walk in sin. However, he also spoke about the future Messiah and the restoration of Israel. Isaiah lived hundreds of years before the Messiah was born, but he rejoiced in God's promises of restoration and blessing even when he did not see their fulfillment. Because he saw His glory, he walked by faith and not by sight.
