Introduction

How important is a promise?

- A promise is a covenant or declaration that one will do exactly what he say or something will happen just as pledged.
- When God makes a promise to His people, it will come to pass.

Acts 2:39

For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.

As believers of Christ, we should understand the importance of promises:

I. God's Promises: We can count on.

A. We can count on God's promises because of God's character.

1. First of all, He's not a man. He's not human. He doesn't have a fallen nature.
2. He's never sinned, never lied. He

is the essence of righteousness and can't lie.

3. He is the truth and only speaks the truth.

Numbers 23:19

God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?

B. We can count on God's promises because God is unchanging.

1. Unlike us, God never changes in His person or His purposes.
2. We may change our minds as we age, or our situation changes, or we get more information.
3. But God doesn't decide to do something then a thousand years later realized it was a bad decision.

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

C. We can count on God's promises because of His infinite wisdom.

1. Because of His infinite wisdom, when He makes a promise, it's the best possible promise He can make.
2. He won't discover later He could have made a better promise.
- God never needs to make course

corrections.

3. He doesn't make it up as He goes along. He knows the end from the beginning.

Titus 1:2

In hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began.

Jeremiah 29:11

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

II. Man's Promises: How to be counted on?

A. Remember whose you are.

- As Christians, the Holy Spirit lives inside us. His power is ready to teach us to carefully consider promises before we make them.

1 Corinthians 3:16

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

B. Understand that promises come with responsibility attached.

- If we break them, we will suffer the consequence of lost trust, which is difficult to regain.

Numbers 30:2

If a man makes a vow to the Lord, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.

Malachi 3:8-12

⁸"Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' Students have their last day of classes with their teachers.

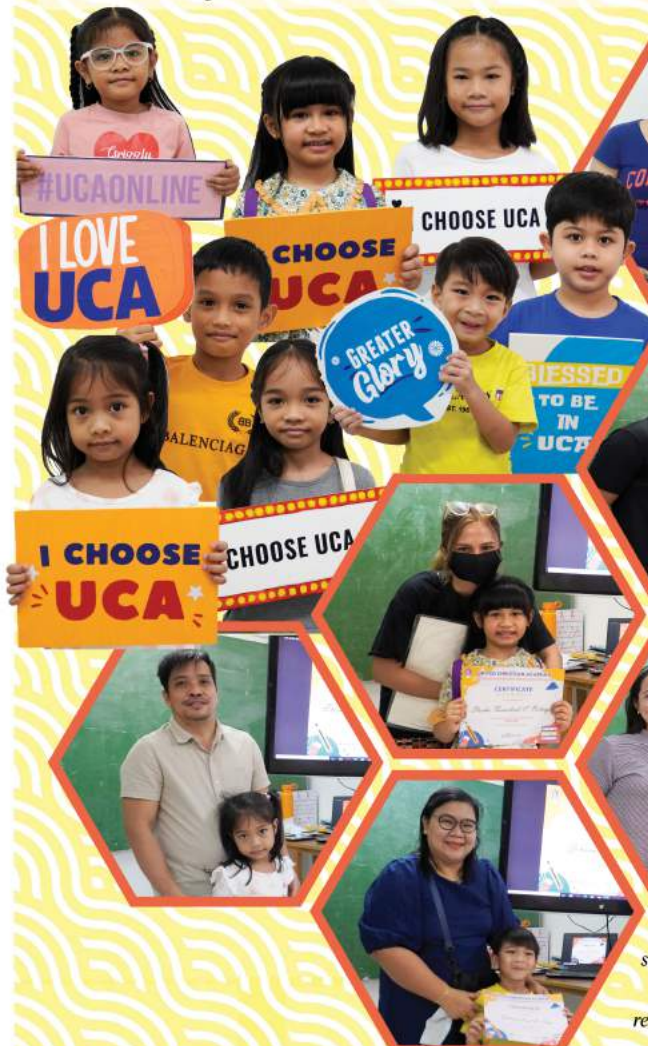

Providing the needs of the community

The opportunity to reach the community has been favored upon United Christian Academy (UCA) as it was chosen again to be a vaccination site to fight the spread of COVID-19.

Individuals near the vicinity went to UCA Campus last July 15, Friday, to receive their vaccines provided by the Barangay Vaccination Team headed by Medical Officer Dra. Catherine Anne Malaki. The said vaccination program offered vaccines and boosters of Pfizer, Sinovac, and Moderna to children, adults, and senior citizens. All participants and even health workers followed the safety and health protocols, such as physical distancing, wearing of face masks, and hand sanitation outside and inside the premise.

The vaccination ended successfully with the assistance and accommodation of Rev. Dr. William Sy and some UCA and UCF workers.

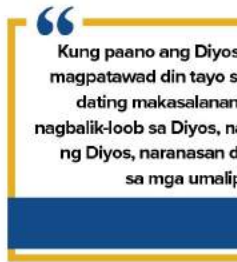

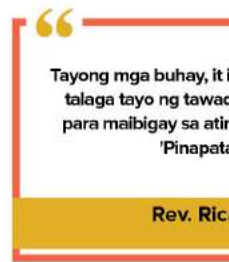

The greatest commandment

Matthew 22:36-40 (NKJV)

³⁶Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law? ³⁷Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." ³⁸This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

Introduction

In the Ten Commandments in

Exodus, you will notice that the first four commandments are commandments that talk about our relationship with God. That's why Jesus summarized it, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind."

And the remaining commandments are commandments pertaining to our relationship with other people, our neighbors. That is why Jesus told us, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Love the Lord with all your heart, soul, and mind.

Matthew 22:37 (NKJV)

Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind."

Roma 3:23-24 (MBBTAG)

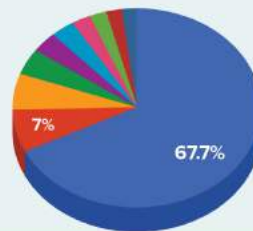

Repentance is different from confession. It is not about saying sorry. The first step to receive the salvation that God

offers in Christ Jesus is repentance. Without repentance, there is no salvation; not because of Jesus Christ but because we cannot come back to God. Jesus is the Savior. But how can we come back to God? It is through repentance. That's why after His testing in the wilderness, Jesus began saying, "Repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand." How is this Word so important that the first sermon of Jesus Christ is the temptation in the wilderness?

"WITHOUT REPENTANCE, THERE IS NO SALVATION; NOT BECAUSE OF JESUS CHRIST BUT BECAUSE WE CANNOT COME BACK TO GOD."

What is repentance? This is not feeling guilty. It is not when you just acknowledge your sin and you feel guilty. It is not being sorry when we experience those consequences of the sins that we did. We felt that kind of remorse. It is not trying to be a good person or being self-righteous. And it is not being religious just to show people that we practice forgiveness and repentance. So, these four are not repentance.

Most of the time the word "repentance" is misunderstood because of these words. And most people, if they feel guilty and they say sorry, automatically they say that they already

repent. That is not repentance. Kapag binasa natin ang James 2, pinapahiwatig sa atin na mainam na naniniwala tayo sa Diyos. Maraming tao ang nagsasabi na naniniwala sila sa Diyos pero ano ang katotohanan doon? Enough ba na naniniwala ka na may Diyos? Base dito, hindi. Bakit kaya kino-compare ni James ang brethren sa demons? It's a clear comparison. Tandaan ninyo na sa Book of James, ang kinakausap niya dito ay mga believer. Sinasabi niya na, "Kayo, naniniwala kayo sa Diyos. Mainam iyan pero ang demonyo rin ay naniniwala sa Diyos. Ano ang pagkakaiba niyo?" Sabi niya, "Ang demonyo ay nanginginig pa." Kayo ba nanginginig? Iyon ang gustong sabihin ni James sa pahayag niya. Hindi sapat na sabihin mong naniniwala ka sa Diyos. May mga taong nagsasabing naniniwala sila at may takot sila sa Diyos pero hindi iyon ang nakikita sa buhay nila. Bagkus sa totoo lang ay lip service lang iyon.

"KAPAG INAMIN MO NA ANG MGA KASALANAN MO, PUWEDE KA NA PUMUNTA SA NUMBER TWO. IT IS TURNING AWAY FROM YOUR SIN."

Repentance, according to Psalm 32:5 is, "I acknowledge my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the Lord, 'And You forgave the iniquity of my sin.'" Repentance is being truthful about your sin. Hindi ka magiging totoo sa kasalanan mo kasi kapag sinabi mong totoo ka sa kasalanan mo, ipinamumuhay mo na ito. Kailangan matutunan mong ihayag ang katotohanan. Huwag mong ikahiya. Yes, nagkasala ka pero hindi mo na gustong ipagpatuloy iyon. Kailangan tanggapan mo ang katotohanan na iyon na nagkasala ka. Kailangan aminin mo na nagkasala ka. Mayroong tinatawag na mga unspoken rule. Mayroong tinatawag na principles behind all those rules. The first principle about sin is that we all have sinned. The second principle is that the wages of sin is death. Sa langit, kung ano ang nakalagay sa batas, mangyayari iyon.

Maraming nagsasabi na ang Diyos daw ay pag-ibig. Tama iyon. The problem is isang side lang iyon. Ang Diyos din ay hustisya.

"DATI, NANDOON KA SA PANIG NILA (NG KASALANAN). PERO NGAYON, NAINTINDIHAN MO NA MALI IYON KAYA ANG GINAWA MO AY INIWAN MO IYON."

Kaya nga may impierno kasi may mga taong naririnig na ang Salita ng Diyos pero ayaw pa nilang sumunod. Nandito ako hindi para magbigay ng judgement dahil ang judge natin ay si Jesus. Ako ay nandito para magbigay ng babala. Kapag inamin mo na ang mga kasalanan mo, puwede ka na pumunta sa number two. Ano ang number two? It is turning away from your sin. Hindi mo agad nauunawaan nang isang upuan ang kasalanan. Mayroon siyang detalye. Habang pinapaunawa sa iyo ng Holy Spirit, then naunawaan mo na unti-unti kang magbabago.

Gawin mo muna ang number one. Unawain mo muna iyon. Tanggapin mo muna kasi hindi ka makakapunta sa number two. Lagi ka lang mangangatuwiran. Hindi mo alam kung bakit. Ang natatanggap mo na lang ay puro sakit. Hindi mo naintindihan kung bakit. Nagiging hyper ang emotion at hindi gumagana ang utak nang tama kaya walang pang-unawa at puro nararamdaman lang. Ganoon din ang kasalanan. Minsan, kapag tayo ay gumagawa ng kasalanan, nag-e-enjoy ka. Halimbawa, sinabihan ka na bawal mag-ingay pero ang gagawin mo, sasadyain mong mag-ingay. Para ano? Para sikat ka. Kaso lang, hindi mo naintindihan na may judgement doon. Ang judgement doon ay delikado. Ide-deny niya lahat ng kasalanan niya kapag nalaman na niya kung ano ang kaparusahan. Ganoon ang tao.

Ang tao na pinagtatakan ang kaniyang kasalanan ay hindi mamamayagpag. Kung sinuman ang maghayag ng kasalanan at iwan ito ay siyang kaaawaan. Kapag naintindihan mo ang number one at naintindihan mo ang number two, pupunta ka na sa number three. It is hating sin. Dati, nandoon ka sa panig nila. Pero ngayon, naintindihan mo na mali iyon kaya ang ginawa mo ay iniwan mo iyon. Inamin mo tapos iniwan mo at nagsimula ka nang lumakad papunta sa tamang daan.

During the time in the Bible, there were no cellphones, telephones, fax machines, and other technologies to help them in communicating with one another. They knew information mostly through word of mouth and signage posted in public places, which were handwritten. Another way was through messengers, who would ride camels, horses, or boats to get to their destination to deliver a certain message. And that would take days, weeks, and even months to be delivered.

Just as when Paul wrote letters to various churches while he was in prison, he sent Titus to send his Letter to the Corinthians, Epaphroditus to deliver his Letter to the Philippians, and others who delivered the rest of Paul's letters to different churches to warn, to encourage, and to pray for them. Even though Paul was far from the churches and it took a long time and effort to have his message delivered, it did not hinder Paul to share the Word of God with them.

Now, with various media and technologies available, people can easily communicate with one another even when they are from different parts of the world with just a few taps of our fingers. With this kind of convenience, it is easier and faster to share information with other people—what more the Word of God, which will bring great impact on people's lives? We should take advantage of this and maximize our resources to reach out to people with the Gospel.
