- Physically desperate, her health was gone.
- Financially desperate, her money was gone.
- Spiritually desperate, she could not enter the temple.
- When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment.

III. Why are some not healed?

A. There are unconfessed sins. John 5:14 (NKJV)

Afterward Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you."

Ezekiel spoke to the people whom God had exiled because of their continued practice of sin and rebellion against Him. This book presents a picture of restoration and resurrection of God's people with the vision of the reconstructed temple in Jerusalem

and the return of God's glory in His dwelling place.

God exiled the people of Jerusalem to bring them to a state of repentance and humility before the one true God. Ezekiel was sent to deliver a message that the people likely didn't want to hear: God is the Lord of heaven and earth, and the judgment that they were experiencing was the result of the sins they committed.

This book reminds us to also reflect on ourselves, on our own doings—whether our actions are still aligned with our one true God, and to seek the Lord whenever we are in the dark and lost.

DEFILEMENT OF MAN

In the Old Testament, the Lord spoke about unclean food that people should not eat or consume because it defiles man or makes man unclean or unpure. Leviticus 11 states the animals which are considered clean and unclean—mammals. water animals, birds, insects, and reptiles. It was then said in Leviticus 11:44-45, "44For I am the Lord your God. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy; for I am holy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth. 45For I am the Lord who brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God. You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy." One purpose of this dietary laws of Israel was to sanctify them from other nations. Not only did unclean animals defile one spiritually, but there was also a hygienic defilement since some animals eat the flesh and blood of other animals, some are carriers of diseases, and some are potentially poisonous. It was also for their health benefit.

However, during the time in the New Testament, Jesus said that it is not what man consumes that defiles him. It is said in Mark 7:15, "There is nothing that enters a man from outside which can defile him; but the things which come out of him, those are the things that defile a man." Jesus explained this to His disciples in verses 18-23, "18 So He said to them, 'Are you thus without understanding also? Do you not perceive that whatever enters a man from outside cannot defile him, 19 because it does not enter his heart but his stomach, and is eliminated, thus purifying all foods?' 20 And He said, 'What comes out of a man, that defiles a man. 21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness. 23 All these evil things come from within and defile a man.'

You need to acknowledge that we have to trust and be dependent upon God. Kapag may problema o sakit tayo, hindi ba ang tinatawag natin ay ang Diyos? We go back to the original call of God. Ang sabi ng Bible ay nagmula tayo sa alabok at babalik tayo sa alabok, where we came from. We came from God, and we will go back to God for the final judgment.

Bilang mga Kristiyano, how do we become more fruitful? We simply share the Word and the work of the Holy Spirit, which will eventually develop souls after souls. Ang ibig sabihin nito, magtanim ka. Kung gusto mong mag-produce ay magtanim ka. Magtanim ka sa pamamagitan ng pamamahagi ng Salita ng Diyos. Share and the work of the Holy Spirit will follow through. That's the reason why when we put God first, we put God in our priority. Then we realize one day that it's not really us, but it is God partnering with us that creates an atmosphere of success.

Read your Bible and read its instructions. You then follow through with what the Word of God says, for us to not go into an area of compromise. Importante ang may Diyos. 


