Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. 3And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; ⁴and perseverance, character; and character, hope. 5Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us. For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. 8But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. "And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through

our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation. 12Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned- 13(For until the law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law. "Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who had not sinned according to the likeness of the transgression of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come. 15But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many, 16And the gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned. For the judgment which came from one offense resulted in condemnation, but the free gift which came from many offenses resulted in justification. ¹⁷For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.) 18Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men,

resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life. ¹⁹For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous.

Introduction

What is justification?

It is like a story of a young man and the judge.

I. Man's status prior to justification

1. We are all sinners.

Romans 5:8

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

2. We are all powerless and ungodly.

Romans 5:6

For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

Note

But because God so loved the world, He gave His Son to be our justification.

II. Definition of justification

Justification is both a state of being and an act.

 a. As a state, it means that we are void of offense toward God.

- We are declared not guilty in Christ Jesus.
- We are acquitted of the guilt and punishment.
- We are made righteous by the work of Christ.

b. As an act, justification is the work of God by which our sins are forgiven and our relationship with Him is changed from enmity to friendship.

2. Justification has two definitions and two-fold nature.

 a. When we are justified, our sins are not only forgiven, our guilt and punishment are also cancelled out.

Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Supposedly, the wages of our sins is death, but because we have repented of our sins and believe in Christ, God forgives and removes the penalty for our sins.

b. When we are justified, we are reconciled to God.



UCA is fully compliant







WHY READ THE BOOK OF DANIEL?



The Book of Daniel is one of the few Bible books that takes place during a

period of judgment and in a foreign nation. It was written during his time in Babylon as a Jewish exile from Israel.

Daniel wrote his experiences and prophecies during his time in Babylon. Mainly, this book makes a compelling argument for the absolute sovereignty of God, even over a variety of self-absorbed foreign rulers, in both the historical and prophetic passages. Numerous times, this concept of sovereignty has been evident in various situations, including Daniel's deliverance from the lions' den, his friends' rescue from the fiery furnace, and the future arrival of the Ancient of Days to save His people from the forces of evil (Daniel 3:23–30; 6:19–23; 7:9–22).

Even when everything appears lost and the consequences of sin seem overpowering, the Book of Daniel makes it apparent that the true God is the absolute ruler over heaven and earth (Daniel 4:17). Though there are many trials and consequences of sin that man experiences in his life, the story of Daniel shows us how to serve God faithfully in the midst of such circumstances and how to still be hopeful even when there is no immediate solution to the issues that bring us down.
