Romans 5:15-17 (NKJV)

¹⁵For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father."
¹⁶The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, ¹⁷and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

Definition of Adoption

1. We are no longer slaves but adopted sons of God.

Romans 8:15 (NKJV)

For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father."

2. As adopted sons, we are now called children of God by whom we cry "Abba, Father."

Romans 8:16 (NKJV)

The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.

3. As sons of God, we become heirs of God and co-heirs with

Christ to the full inheritance of God's blessings.

Romans 8:17 (NKJV)

And if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

Note:

The following are the stages of salvation that we discussed previously:

1. Justification
2. Sanctification
3. Adoption

- They may have different approaches and aspects, but they are the same work of grace as part of the new birth we experience.

- In justification, God declares the sinners righteous and has reconciled with God. The result is the peace of God.

- In sanctification, we are set apart and have been dedicated to God.

- In adoption, the justified and the sanctified believers are received into the family of God.

Romans 1:16 (NKJV)

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

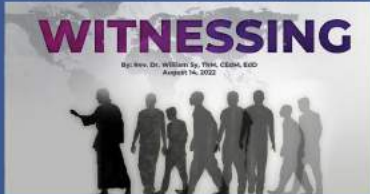

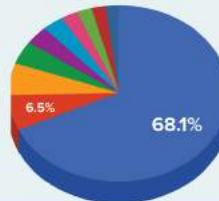

Kung magkakaroon tayo ng opportunity para mag-witness, tingin ko ay mas maganda na tayo ay mag-witness para kay Kristo. Ang

pinakapundasyon ng salitang witness ay ang salitang katotohanan. Noong unang panahon, kaya nagkaroon ng witness ay dahil gusto nila malaman kung sino ang nagsasabi ng totoo. Kasi noong unang panahon, ang mga tao ay nalulong na sa kasalanan ng kasinungalingan.

Sinasabi ng Salita ng Diyos na mahalaga ang mga nagpapatotoo. Una ay ang pagpapatotoo sa langit at ikalawa ang pagpapatotoo dito sa lupa. The question now is, 'Is Jesus really the Messiah? Is He the Son of God?' If a person believes these witnesses, then he believes in God. The task of man is to receive the testimony of the witnesses and to believe the testimony about His Son, Jesus Christ.

The first is that there is a mission of Jesus and it was John who declared and testified.

Ang sinasabi niya ay His baptism by water and His death by the blood. Both His baptism and death declared Him to be the Son of God.

Kapag binasa natin ang verse sa John 1:32-34, in-interpret ito nang maigi at inunawa, alam nating lahat na si John the Baptist ay isang propeta ng Diyos na kinausap ng Panginoon upang ihanda para sa pagdadating ng Messiah. Siya ang inutusan ng Diyos para bawtismohan ang tao sa tubig. Pero makikita natin na hindi niya lang basta inimbento iyon. Inutusan siya ng Diyos na gawin iyon. Pinapatotoo ni John the Baptist na siya rin iyon at kung sino ang kakasihan ng Banal na Espiritu o iyong sabi nga niya na "the Spirit descended from heaven like a dove and rested upon him. He was baptized by the Holy Ghost. Nakakatuwa dahil ibig sabihin pala, napakahalaga ng Banal na Espiritu na nag-anyong kalapati noong panahon na iyon na si Kristo ay binawtismohan. Alam niyo bakit? Because that is a sign not for the people but that is a sign for John the Baptist dahil kailangan niya iyong makita. Kailangan niyang makita para mapatotoo niya. Pero nakakagulat dahil if you read carefully, hindi ganoon ang nangyari. Sa totoo lang, malayo pa lang si Jesus, noong nakita Siya ni John the Baptist ay namukhaan Siya kaagad. Ang sabi niya, 'The Son of God! The Lamb of God!' Hindi pa siya binabawtismohan noon.

Tayo, madalas kapag nagpi-pray ay humihingi tayo ng sign sa Lord. At minsan, kailangan makita mo iyong sign para maniwala ka. Si John the Baptist ay hindi ganoon. Although nagbigay ang Diyos ng sign sa kaniya pero malayo palang si Jesus ay namukhaan na niya. Palapit palang si Jesus sa kaniya ay sinabi niya, 'Ako ang bawtismohan Mo.' Hindi niya pa nakikita ang sign pero bilang lingkod ng Diyos, nadi-discern niya iyon. Hindi pa man niya nakita si Jesus face-to-face, and that is the first meeting of John the Baptist and Jesus, kilala na ni John kung sino iyong taong lumalapit sa kaniya.

Noong binawtismohan niya si Jesus, bumukas ang langit at matinig na nagsalita. Ang sabi, 'Ito ang Aking Anak. Lubos Akong nagagalak.' At lahat ng nandoon ay narinig iyon and they were all witnesses of that event.

Bakit ko ito sinasabi ngayon? Dahil kailangan mo ng patotoo. Hindi ka magpapatuloy sa paglakad mo sa Diyos kapag wala kang patotoo. Ang patotoo ang nagpapaalala sa iyo. Ang patotoo ang nagbibigay sa iyo ng lakas para magpatuloy ka dahil mayroon kang karanasan. At kahit na balibaliktarin nila ang istorya, kahit siya ang mauna o ang kabila ang mauna at kahit na sirain pa nila ang istorya, hindi puwedeng masira sa puso mo iyon. Hindi puwedeng malito ang isip mo kasi karanasan mo iyon. Hindi mo iyon puwedeng malimutan. At kahit sabihin nating magkaroon ka pa ng amnesia, dahil naranasan mo iyon, maaalala mo iyon.

Ang patotoo ang nagpapaalala sa iyo. Ang patotoo ang nagbibigay sa iyo ng lakas para magpatuloy ka dahil mayroon kang karanasan.

We all know that God sent John the Baptist to prepare the way for the coming Messiah. And we also know that it was John who first initiated the so-called water baptism. During the time that John is baptizing people, wala namang nakitang bumaba ang Espiritu ng Diyos at wala ring narinig na tinig sa langit na nagsalita. Those two are unusual. At ang dalawa na iyon ay nangyari lang noong si Hesus na ang babawtismohan. Bakit? Kasi iyon ang tanda. Isang tanda iyon na sinabi sa kaniya ng Panginoon upang makilala niya na ang babawtismohan niyang iyon ay ang Anak ng Diyos, ang Messiah.

Kaya napakahalaga ng testimonya ni John. Dahil doon, lahat ng disipulo ni John ay namangha. And later on, ang sabi ni John ay kailangan si Jesus ang mag-increase at siya naman ay mag-decrease until the time came when he was beheaded and so begun the ministry of Jesus Christ.

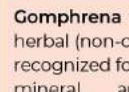

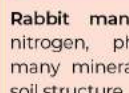
