





PROPHECY ON JESUS

It is written in John 5:39, "You study the Scriptures diligently because you think that in them you have eternal life. These are the very Scriptures that testify about Me." In this verse, Jesus claimed that His career and life were prophesied in the Old Testament by the Hebrew prophets that preceded Him by hundred of years. They also said that their writings were inspired by God. No human mind could have predicted such detail hundreds of years in the future. Because of that, it became a line of evidence that Jesus said that His contemporaries could be used to verify that He did come as part of a Divine Plan.

Many in the Old Testament prophesied about Jesus just like in the Book of Isaiah 7:14, "Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel." This is a well-known prophecy of the Messiah. It was given 700 years before Jesus was born. He was not only born of the virgin but is "Immanuel" as stated in the New Testament in Matthew 1:18-19, "This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit. Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly."

There are a number of references in the Old Testament to the Son of God, and those prophesies were fulfilled in the New Testament. This proves that Jesus is the Messiah who will reign to the very ends of the earth, whose people will be glad and will sing for joy forevermore.
