From God's Wrath to God's Call



Genesis 6:5-12 (NKJV)

⁵Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. ⁶And the Lord was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. ⁷So the Lord said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them." ⁸But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord. ⁹This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God. ¹⁰And Noah begot three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth. ¹¹The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence. ¹²So God looked upon the earth, and indeed it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth.

Introduction Fears

II. The Great Judgment: The Result of God's Wrath

- C. These caused the Lord's judgment to destroy both man and beast of the earth (v. 7a, v. 13; 7:4).

III. The Great Call: The Salvation from God's Wrath

- 2. Noah was perfect in his generations (v. 9c; 7:1).
- 3. Noah walked with God (v. 9d).

- B. Noah was called by God to do His will.

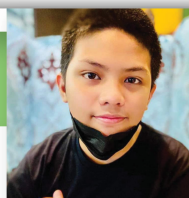

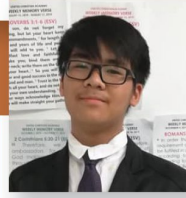

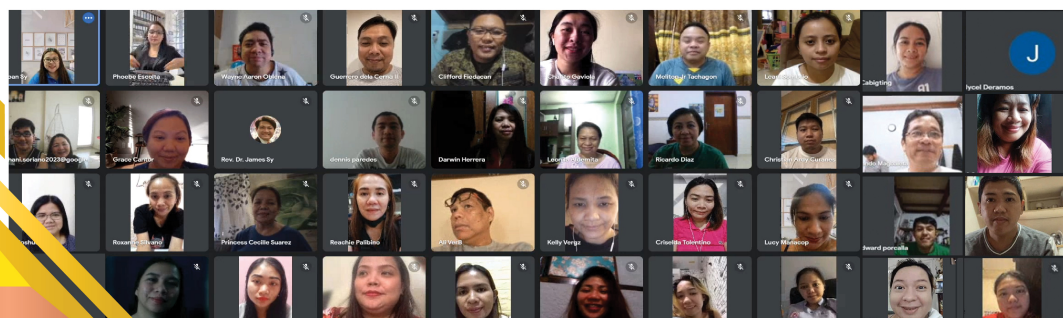
ACCESS TO QUALITY EDUCATION

What is stewardship?

Stewardship is the committed, consistent, and proportionate giving back of what God has entrusted to man.

1. Committed

Stewardship entails a relationship between the giver and recipient that is built on trust

Isaiah 55:11

So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish

what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

Genesis 1:3

Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

Matthew 28:20

"Teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen

Psalms 24:1

The earth is the Lord's, and all its

2. Consistent

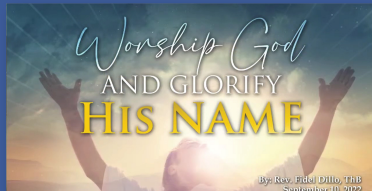

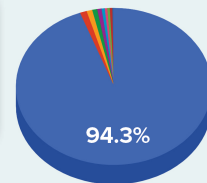

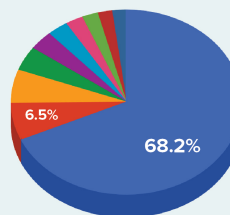

Balikan natin ulit, 'Therefore, submit to God, resist the devil, and he will flee from you.' Medyo madalas natin itong naririnig. Kaya lang minsan, naka-focus tayo doon sa 'resist the devil'. Nakalimutan natin na mayroon siyang isa pang sinabi—submit to God. Ano ba ang submit? Ilagay natin ito sa context ng isang soldier. Kapag sinabi mong soldier,

siya ay nagsa-submit sa kaniyang leader, sumusunod at alam niya ang ginagawa. Kapag sinabi ng leader na 'sugod', susugod na iyon. Kapag sinabi ng leader 'retreat', magre-retreat iyon. Kapag sinabi ng leader 'baril', babaril iyon. Kasi ganoon ang soldier. Ang mandato nila ay mag-submit sa sinomang mas nakakataas. Minsan, nakakalimutan natin iyon dahil naka-focus lang tayo doon sa 'resist the devil and he will flee from you'. Kaya marami kang gagawin at marami kang pamamaraan.

Maraming mga bagay ang gagawin mo on your own, but forgetting the first one—'Therefore, submit to God'. Bakit mahalaga iyon? Mayroon kasing secret na hindi ipinapakita sa atin ang kalaban. Alam niyo ba ang pinakamatinding weapon natin against the enemy? Ang prayer ba natin o ang ating pagbabasa ng Bible? Tama naman ang pagbabasa pero minsan, may mga panahon pa rin na bumibigay tayo.

Ayon sa mga kasabihan, maging close ka sa mga kaibigan mo pero mas maging close ka sa kaaway. Know your enemy. Bakit kailangan mong kilalanin ang kalaban mo? Para alam mo kung paano siya tatalunin. Sino ang kalaban natin? Si Satan. Sinungaling siya at father of lies. Pero ang main characteristic niya, siya ay proud. Mataas ang tingin niya sa sarili kaya nga siya napatalsik kasama ang mga ibang anghel dati kasi gusto niyang hindi lang siya kapantay ng Diyos, ngunit gusto niya lagpasan pa ang Diyos. Ang tingin niya sa sarili niya ay magaling siya. Totoo ang sabi ng Bible na siya ang pinakamaganda at pinaka-talented na anghel. Mayroon siyang superiority, kaya lang ay tumaas ito. Lumaki ang ulo niya. Iyon ang naging downfall niya—ang pride.

Paano mo kakalabanin ang kalaban? You need to resist. Pigilan, labanan at gawin mo ang kabaliktaran ng ginagawa ng kalaban mo. Kung si Satan ay proud, dapat tayo ay humble. At iyon ang

essence ng 'Therefore, submit to God'. How can we oppose Satan? Be humble.

Si Satan ay isang proud spirit. Pride ang fini-feed niya sa atin. Sinasabi ng kalaban sa iyo na hindi mo kaya iyan at ito ang gawin mo kaya nakakaisip ka ng pamamaraan. Sa huli, ang paraan ay magiging problema hanggang sa mag-fail na ang lahat at ang magiging last resort mo ay ipagpasa-Diyos mo na lang. Masama ba iyon? By principle, oo kasi huli na lang si Lord. Kapag nagawa mo na ang lahat, then saka ka tatawag sa Panginoon. At iyon ay baliktad.

Hindi ba ang sabi, 'submit to God'? Ito ang una, tapos ay resist the devil at saka siya magfi-flee. Iyon ang kadalasan nating nagiging downfall. Pakiramdam mo ay kaya mo na ang lahat kasi nga ang sabi mo, 'I am more than conqueror' pero nakalimutan mo ang 'through Christ Jesus'. Ang sabi mo, 'I can do all things', ngunit may kasunod ulit iyon na 'through Christ Jesus who strengthens me'.

FORGIVENESS OF SINS

In the Old Testament, in order for the people's sins to be forgiven, animals must be sacrificed following specific instructions on how to sacrifice them. These are mentioned in Leviticus Chapter 6. It says that if an anointed priest sins, he must offer a young bull without defect (verse 3). If the whole Israelite community sin, they must offer a young bull without defect also (verses 13-14). If a leader sins, he must offer a male goat without defect (verses 22-23). If any member of the community sins, he must offer a female goat or a female lamb without defect (verses 27-32).

However, in the New Testament, when we sin against the Lord, we have to repent from our sins and turn to God. Acts 3:19 says, "Repent, then, and turn to God, so that He will forgive your sins." We do not need to offer any kind of animals in order for us to be forgiven because it is Jesus Christ who has paid the ransom of our sins. Jesus redeemed us from sins through His death on the cross, for the wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus (Romans 6:23). We need to repent to God, turn away from our sins, and live a life obeying God's commandments.

Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes, for false witnesses rise up against me, spouting malicious accusations.





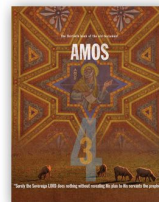

WHY READ THE BOOK OF AMOS?

The Book of Amos talks about how the people of Israel are enjoying their time of success yet taking advantage of others, not loving their neighbors, and only looking out for their own concerns. And the Lord was totally displeased with these selfish actions. With that, God directed Amos. God called a quiet shepherd and farmer to carry His message of judgement to a sinful nation of Israelites.
