Do not fear, God is with us



Numbers 14:1-9 (NKJV)

'So all the congregation lifted up their voices and cried, and the people wept that night. ²And all the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron, and the whole congregation said to them, "If only we had died in the land of Egypt! Or if only we had died in this wilderness! ³Why has the Lord brought us to this land to fall by the sword, that our wives and children should become victims? Would it not be better for us to return to Egypt?" ⁴So they said to one another, "Let us select a leader and return to Egypt." ⁵Then Moses and Aaron fell on their faces before all the assembly of the congregation of the children of Israel. ⁶But Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, who were among those who had spied out the land, tore their clothes; ⁷and they spoke to all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying: "The land we passed through to spy out is an exceedingly good land. ⁸If the Lord delights in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it to us, 'a land which flows with milk and honey.' ⁹Only do not rebel against the Lord, nor fear the people of the land, for they are our bread; their protection has departed from them, and the Lord is with us. Do not fear them."

Background

- Moses sent men to spy out the land that the Lord promised to give them.
- When these men returned, they brought with them the fruits of the land.
- Also, almost all of these men returned back discouraged for they saw that the inhabitants of the land were stronger than they are, and even giants live there.
- But among them, two men moved in faith and told the congregation to not fear and that they should push through and conquer the land—these are Caleb and Joshua.

Despite Caleb and Joshua's persuasion and the sample fruits of the land, the Israelites still refused to enter and conquer the land that the Lord has promised them.

Their fear overshadowed the proof of God's blessings for them.

Numbers 13:27-28 (NKJV)

²⁷Then they told him, and said: "We went to the land where you sent us. It truly flows with milk and honey, and this is its fruit. ²⁸Nevertheless the people who dwell in the land are strong; the cities are fortified and very large; moreover we saw the descendants of Anak there."

Their intimidation set aside the power of God in them.

Numbers 13:30-31 (NKJV)

³⁰Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it." ³¹But the men who had gone up with him said, "We are not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger than we."

Their complaints wavering their faith on God's plans and promises for them.

Numbers 14:2-3 (NKJV)

²And all the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron, and the whole congregation said to them, "If only we had died in the land of Egypt! Or if only we had died in this wilderness! ³Why has the Lord brought us to this land to fall by the sword, that our wives and children should become victims? Would it not be better for us to return to Egypt?"

Their rebellion made them deaf and blind on the word and vision that the Lord gave to them.

Numbers 14:4-10 (NKJV)

⁴So they said to one another, "Let us select a leader and return to Egypt." ⁵Then Moses and Aaron fell on their faces before all the assembly of the

congregation of the children of Israel. ⁶But Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, who were among those who had spied out the land, tore their clothes; ⁷and they spoke to all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying: "The land we passed through to spy out is an exceedingly good land. ⁸If the Lord delights in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it to us, 'a land which flows with milk and honey.' ⁹Only do not rebel against the Lord, nor fear the people of the land, for they are our bread; their protection has departed from them, and the Lord is with us. Do not fear them." ¹⁰And all the congregation said to stone them with stones. Now the glory of the Lord appeared in the tabernacle of meeting before all the children of Israel.

Their fear, intimidation, complaints, and rebellion brought them death, and they did not enter the Promised Land (Numbers 14:26-45).

Let us learn and not repeat the mistakes done by the Israelites.

- Do not let fear overshadow the proofs of God's blessings for us. **Remember** our past experiences of miracles and blessings especially when we are faced again by trials, problems, and situations.



Malawak na pag-abot ng Ebanghelyo

Kasaysayan



dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'

- Do not let intimidation set aside the power of God in us. Believe that the Lord is with us and move forward in faith.

Psalm 56:9 (NKJV)

When I cry out to You, then my enemies will turn back; this I know, because God is for me.

Psalm 118:6 (NKJV)

The Lord is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me?

Isaiah 41:10 (NKJV)

- Do not let complaints waver our faith on God's plans and promises for us. Hold tight on the great hope that we have in God for He is faithful.

Hebrews 10:23 (NASB)

Let's hold firmly to the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

- Do not let rebellion cause us to be deaf and blind on the word and the vision of God for us. Allow God's words and revelations guide us and lead us to greater joy.

Romans 8:31-32 (NKJV)


³¹What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? ³²He who did not spare

Challenge

Remember, believe, hold tight, and allow God to fulfill for us this 2022 Haggai 2:6-9 (NKJV).

"For thus says the Lord of hosts: 'Once more (it is a little while) I will shake heaven and earth, the sea and dry land; ⁷and I will shake all nations, and they shall come to the Desire of All Nations, and I will fill this temple with glory,' says the Lord of hosts. ⁸The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine,' says the Lord of hosts. ⁹The glory of this latter temple shall be greater than the former,' says the Lord of hosts. 'And in this place I will give peace,' says the Lord of hosts."



The Book tells the history of how Israel was enslaved under the rule of Pharaoh; their deliverance from slavery through Moses who led them out of Egypt across the Red Sea and onto Canaan, the Promised Land; God's revelations of the Ten Commandments in Mount Sinai, and God's divine indwelling in the Israelites. And this event was referred to as the Exodus.

This reveals how God saves His chosen people and sustains them though hardships come their way. God hears the prayers of His people and communicates with them in His own way and time. Exodus teaches us to always trust God.
