The sacrifices to win others to Christ



1 Corinthians 9:19-23 (NKJV)

¹⁹For though I am free from all men, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win the more; ²⁰and to the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might win Jews; to those who are under the law, as under the law, that I might win those who are under the law; ²¹to those who are without law, as without law (not being without law toward God, but under law toward Christ), that I might win those who are without law; ²²to the weak I became as weak, that I might win the weak. I have become all things to all men, that I might by all means save some. ²³Now this I do for the gospel's sake, that I may be partaker of it with you.

Introduction

Verse 1-14 shows us a pattern of self-denial. Apostle Paul laid aside the right to support in the ministry.

1 Corinthians 9:13-14

¹³Do you not know that those who minister the holy things eat of the things of the temple, and those who serve at the altar partake of the offerings of the altar? ¹⁴Even so the Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should live from the gospel.

To win others to Christ, we must be

ready to give our lives (money, energy, time) for the gospel. People will look into our lives, in our social media accounts, and ask people about who we are in our community. Many people are posting verses in their social media platforms, displaying religious paraphernalia in their houses, or even wearing it for display, but have they really given their lives for the gospel?

What sacrifices have you done for the gospel?

I. Seek the benefits of others

Though Christians have great liberty in Christ and that all things become lawful (having been freed from the bondage of the Law), all things are not profitable or beneficial for the building up of others or even for one's own spiritual growth.

1 Corinthians 8:9

But beware lest somehow this liberty of yours become a stumbling block to those who are weak.

1 Corinthians 10:23-24

²³All things are lawful for me, but not all things are helpful; all things are lawful for me, but not all things edify. ²⁴Let no one seek his own, but each one the other's well-being.

As we reflect our lives, what are some of the things the Lord may be calling on you to sacrifice or give up in order to fulfill His will and purpose or to minister to someone in need (for the benefit of others)? Though the apostle had liberty in Christ to eat meat or to receive financial compensation for his labor in the gospel, he was willing to sacrifice those rights for the glory of God and the spiritual well-being of others.

II. Putting off - Putting on

Ephesians 4:17-24

¹⁷This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, ¹⁸having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; ¹⁹who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. ²⁰But you have not so learned Christ, ²¹if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: ²²that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, ²³and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, ²⁴and that you put on the new man which was created

according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

In pursuing the holy life God wanted for us, we need to put off our old self and put on the new self. It is not easy to give up ("put off") bad habits like lying, stealing, and foul language. Sometimes some of these practices still linger after we are saved. But we are to put an end to the practices of the "old man" and adopt the practices of the "new man".

Let us practice living like the new man and renounce the practices of the old. Just as the Christian principles for living are different from non-Christians, so are the practices.

1. They all affect our unity in the body – living in community. Those old practices destroy unity.
2. If we practice holiness, we will live according to God's command and will.
3. Every practice to "put off" is accompanied by a practice to "put on". The practices of the old man have to be "put off" before the practices of the new man can be "put on".
4. Every command is accompanied by a practical reason.

Romans 12:6-8 (NKJV)

“Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; ⁷or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; ⁸he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

1 Corinthians 14:12 (NASB 1995)

So also you, since you are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek to abound for the edification of the church.

1 Corinthians 12:7 (NIV)

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.

- God has given us gifts and were told to use them well.

Three ways to use our abilities for God's glory;

1. Industry
2. Integrity
3. Intelligent choices

1. Industry

We must make the most of our abilities and talents in applying them.

- Energetically
- Intensely
- Attentively

We should not give up easily or abandon our work halfway. We must be thorough and conscientious.

Lucas 16:10 (MBBTAG)

2. Integrity

In practicing our abilities, we must not compromise our God-given standards. No matter how insignificant the situation may be, let us not have gray areas in our work ethics.

3. Intelligent choices

- Decisions create an atmosphere of direction, but intelligent choices should be our promise and motivation. Fear of punishments might be a hindering factor, but our decision to glorify God, at the end, should not be compromised. This attitude will help us keep things in perspective if it is God's gift to us.

Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

Joshua 24:25 (NKJV)

"But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."

Deuteronomy 8:18 (NKJV)

"And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day."

III. Time

God may not have given us the same amount of wealth or the same gifts, but has given us the same 24 hours a day at our disposal. We do not differ from each other in the amount of time but in our use of time.

Psalms 90:12 (NKJV)

So teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.

Matthew 24:46 (NKJV)

Blessed is that servant whom his master, when he comes, will find so doing.

Note

If we are to be stewards of time, we need to remember the following things:

1. Determine our goals

- When we have no goals, we are wasting our time doing useless things.

Philippians 3:14 (NKJV)

I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

2. Detailing your plans

- Know where you're going and how to get there. Lessen your guesswork.

Proverbs 19:21 (NKJV)

There are many plans in a man's heart, Nevertheless the Lord's counsel—that will stand.

Matthew 24:32-35 (The Parable of the Fig Tree)

3. Do a listing

- Write down what you need to do and not to do, so you realize which ones to do or to refuse.

4. Decide on your priorities

- Do and decide the most important and valuable things to do. What are your priorities?

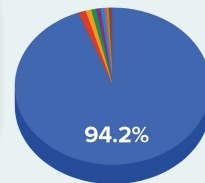

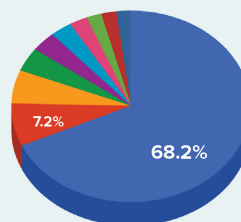

Masayang panuorin ang mga show na iyon kaso the more na pinapakinggan ang iniisip niya, the more na nakukuha ito ng mga manunuod. PASSOVER

In the Old Testament, Israelites were delivered from the slavery of Egyptians. The Lord sent a plague where all the firstborns in the family of the Egyptians shall be killed. To protect the Israelites from the coming plague, the Lord commanded each family in Israel to sacrifice a lamb, to sprinkle its blood on their doorposts, and then to eat unleavened bread for seven more days. The blood of the Passover lamb will be a sign that the destroying angel will pass over them (Exodus 12:13).

In the New Testament, it is written in Luke 22 when Jesus Christ shared the Passover feast with His apostles saying, "I have been very eager to eat this Passover meal with you before my suffering begins. For I tell you now that I won't eat this meal again until its meaning is fulfilled in the Kingdom of God" (Luke 22:15-16, NLT).

Jesus became the Passover. He is the Lamb of God, sacrificed to set us free from the bondage of sin (John 1:29, Psalm 22, Isaiah 53). The blood of Jesus covers and protects us, as said in 1 Corinthians 5:7-8, "Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us. Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."

"Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another.

In the Christian life, truth takes the place of lying; trust takes the place of mistrust; honesty takes the place of dishonesty. To lie to another member of the body of Christ is to deceive someone with whom we are inseparably bound together by the Holy Spirit "for we are members one of another".

Truth is the basis of Christian unity. You cannot deal with someone who lies to you; there is no basis for a relationship. Lying is a serious problem. If we are going to "put on the new man...in true righteousness and holiness", we must speak the truth with each other in love.

John 8:44

You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.

Matthew 5:37

But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one.

b. Exercising Self-Control... Not Anger

Ephesians 4:26-27

²⁶"Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath, ²⁷nor give place to the devil.

Angry people usually lose control over themselves and this causes rifts in the body, tears us apart, and quenches the work of the Holy Spirit. Anger is an emotion that does not characterize the new man. But that does not mean that Christians ought not to be angry at all. The point here is: "If you become angry, do not sin." To paraphrase it: "Anger must be avoided at all cost but if you get angry do not indulge such anger, so that you do not sin."

James 1:19-20

¹⁹So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; ²⁰for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

Anger is sinful when it degenerates to hate, resentment, and bitterness; when it is prolonged and unchecked; and when it is marked by personal animosity. Anger can do irreparable damage in the body of Christ. It ought never to be displayed among the saints of God. It destroys harmony and causes broken relationships with our neighbor. Before it gets hold of you, unburden yourself before the Lord. Before it becomes a sin, judge it before God.

Sin can be avoided. Don't hold it over to the next day, don't prolong it, and don't give place to the devil. Don't give the devil a foothold in your life. This is a strong motivation for not allowing anger to become sin. Satan loves to take a strong emotion like anger and make it part of your nature, to become a grievance or grudge or bitterness, an unforgiving spirit.

c. Working... Not Stealing

Ephesians 4:28

Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with his hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need.

Thieves justify their actions by saying that it is owed to them: "Take what you can; you deserve it; it's owing to you." Sometimes we can adopt thinking like that when an opportunity presents itself to balance the scales with someone who, we rationalize, owes us something. Perhaps you've called in to work sick when there was nothing wrong with you and you justified it that the company owed it to you. After all, it is in your benefit package. Why not take advantage of it? And besides, everybody does it!

Perhaps you steal time from your employer by talking when you should be working, taking an extra few minutes for lunch each day, talking on the phone with your friends during work hours, or using the internet at

work for non-employment purposes.

As new people in Christ, we should use our hands to work, not steal: ...but rather let him labor, working with his hands what is good. The root causes of theft are laziness and selfishness. Those who are lazy have idle hands. Paul classified those who do not work as disorderly, busybodies. He told them to work with their hands and if they "will not work neither shall they eat".

2 Thessalonians 3:7-9

⁷For you yourselves know how you ought to follow us, for we were not disorderly among you; ⁸nor did we eat anyone's bread free of charge, but worked with labor and toil night and day, that we might not be a burden to any of you, ⁹not because we do not have authority, but to make ourselves an example of how you should follow us.

Those who are selfish steal from others for personal gain. They think only of themselves and what they want. They think the world owes them a living, and, if others have what they want, they are justified in getting it by any means.

We should place a high value on hard work. Work is hard, but it produces good for the laborer's own family and for others in need. Work is a means of sharing, not for personal benefit but communal benefit. The community of faith is to care for the needy.

Romans 12:13

Distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.

d. Speaking Constructively... Not Destructively

Ephesians 4:29-30

²⁹Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. ³⁰And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

Words have the power to either crush or build up. Speech that tears down is destructive because it

corrupts. Destructive speech tears down the spirit of a person and destroys the soul. It harms God's people by defiling the mind, rotting the character, and decaying morals. It is evil and unwholesome—the opposite of speech that is holy, good, and pure. Corrupt speech sounds rotten and putrefies the soul. It reeks of obscenities, abusive language, malicious talk, vulgarity, and destructive words.

But speech that builds up is constructive because it nourishes. It builds up our faith, strengthens unity, and enhances fellowship. It nourishes our souls and feeds our communion with God. Constructive speech is the language of the community of faith. It edifies and builds up the body of Christ. It provides encouragement, comfort, and good will.

What comes out of the mouth indicates what is in your heart, for "out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies."

Matthew 15:18-19

¹⁸But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and they defile a man. ¹⁹For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies.

Matthew 12:36-37

³⁶"But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. ³⁷For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

Do not use destructive speech but use constructive, edifying speech: ... what is good for necessary edification. Our speech must not harm others but instead impart grace to the hearers. "Let your speech be always with grace seasoned with salt".

Colossians 4:6

Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.

When we grieve the Holy Spirit through wrong practices of living, communal life is disrupted in the church, for He is the Spirit of unity, indwelling and uniting all believers. So, don't think that you can act anyway you want and get away with it.

Every word, deed, and thought impacts our personal life and our corporate life. Lying generates mistrust and breaks relationships. Anger allows the devil to play havoc and trap us in sin's snare. Stealing takes away from others and robs us of the privilege of giving. Evil talk corrupts communication and destroys spiritual power. Instead of speaking words that hurt, use words that heal. Instead of words that kill, use words that give life.

The Holy Spirit has united us and hates discord among us. Lying, inappropriate anger, stealing, and corrupt speech cause discord.

e. Showing Kindness... Not Animosity

Ephesians 4:31-32

³¹Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. ³²And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

Kind people don't repeat malicious gossip but emphasize the good in others. Kindness to one another infers goodness of heart, Christ-likeness. To be tender-hearted is to be compassionate towards others. Forgiving one another involves acting in grace, even as God in Christ forgave you. Let us put on these expressions

of kindness which nourish the community of faith.

III. A servant to all

Apostle Paul shows us three things about how he preached the gospel boldly and yet avoided needless personal offense: There is an attitude to adopt; a perception to gain; and a balance to maintain.

a. There is an attitude to adopt: I am a slave to all.

A slave does not view himself as being over others, but rather as being under them to serve. He doesn't think of himself first, but of those he serves.

Philippians 2:3-4

³Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. ⁴Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

Romans 12:17-21

¹⁷Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. ¹⁸If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. ¹⁹Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. ²⁰Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head." ²¹Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

b. There is a perception to gain: where is this person at?

Apostle Paul had one message, the gospel, which he never changed. But culturally, he considered the

perspective of his hearers and tried to think and act as they did, as long as it wasn't sinful, so that they would hear the message.

Paul's overall point is that we need to understand where a person is at and not do things in our behavior or manners that needlessly offend them. The message of the cross may well offend them, but we should not be personally offensive to them. Don't make non-gospel issues the issue. Make the gospel the issue.

c. There is a balance to maintain: to be all things to all people, while being all for God.

This is always a struggle on both sides of the coin. Some professing Christians withdraw themselves from the world and are so culturally distinct that they have virtually no impact in terms of saving any.

On the other hand, other professing Christians become so much like the world that they lose their holiness and compromise the gospel. For example, there are pastors that freely use vulgar/ curse words and other churches use secular hard rock music (with lewd lyrics) to lure young people into the building.

Jesus calls us to be in the world, but not to be of the world.

John 17:15-16

¹⁵I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. ¹⁶They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

Jesus was known as the friend of sinners, but He never compromised

His holiness. One way to keep our balance is to keep our goal in view at all times: "to save some". Your reason for going into the world is to snatch them out of the flames.
