Galatians 5:16-25 (NIV)

¹⁶So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. ¹⁷For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. ¹⁸But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. ¹⁹The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; ²⁰idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions ²¹and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. ²²But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. ²⁴Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

Titus 3:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, ⁶whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior.

- All believers have the presence of the indwelling Holy Spirit.

Romans 8:9-10 (NIV)

⁹You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ. ¹⁰But if Christ is in you, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life because of righteousness.

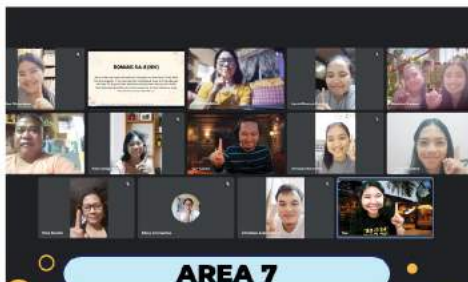

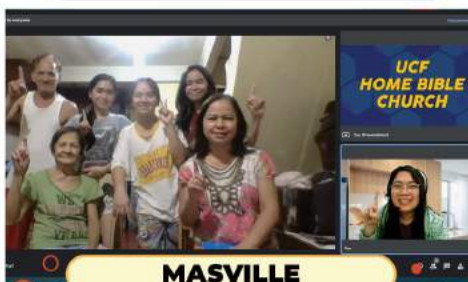

¹⁰Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. ¹¹Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹²For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

We are living in a world which places much value upon material things and tends to deny the existence of spiritual things. Any spiritual encounter is explained away as subjective religious experiences of fanatics. This kind of thinking creeps into the church at times and causes us to neglect spiritual causes of our problems. At other times, we tend to "over-spiritualize"

everything. My aim is to reach a balance and come to the biblical and healthy perspective with regards to the spiritual world.

John 10:10 (NKJV)

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

In Ephesians 6:12, Paul tells us that our battle is not against flesh and blood, but against the evil forces and rulers of this dark world. If we are in the middle of a war, a spiritual war, the following are the things we need to know and undertake:

- I. Know your enemy and his schemes.
- II. Know your strength and the equipment to use.

III. Know your present state and be ready to war to withstand.

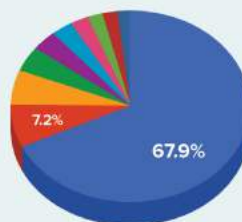

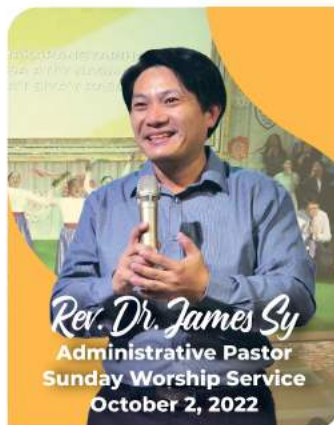

HIGH PRIEST

In the Old Testament, the Feast of Atonement is a holy day in which the high priest is dressed in his holy white linen tunic. His entire body had to be cleansed in water because he alone would enter the most holy place and stand directly in the presence of the mercy seat to make atonement for himself, the nation of Israel, and for the holy place itself (Leviticus 16:1-3, 17).

Leviticus 16:16 describes the necessity of cleansing the holy place, "And he shall make atonement for the holy place, because of the impurities of the sons of Israel, and because of their transgressions, in regard to all their sins, and thus he shall do for the tent of meeting which abides with them in the midst of their impurities."

An abundance of sacrifices are noted including the peculiar double goat sin offering—one for the Lord and the other lot for the scapegoat (Leviticus 16:8). This day was a Sabbath of rest for Israel. "It is on this day that atonement shall be made for you to cleanse you; you shall be clean from all your sins before the Lord" (Leviticus 16:30).

In the New Testament, Hebrews chapters 8 and 9 give a beautifully vivid portrait of the work of the eternal High Priest, Jesus Christ. The first covenant was not as much faultless as it was not able to take away sins; it could only cover them. Jesus' blood sacrifice makes them obsolete and takes sins away (Hebrews 9:12).

The temple was not the same as the literal Holy of Holies in heaven, so Jesus entered there Himself, bringing in His own blood in the "presence of God on our behalf" and it was done once and for all. Since He was the perfect sacrifice, this didn't have to be done over and over again. This "put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself" (Hebrews 8:6-7, 13; 9:26).

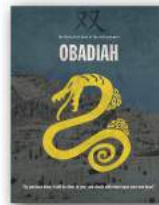

WHY READ THE BOOK OF OBADIAH?



Though the Book of Obadiah is the shortest book in the Bible, it contains a powerful message. It is both a book of despair and a book of hope.

The book recounts the downfall of Jerusalem in 586 BCE (Before the Common Era). This book is a historic condemnation of Edom for its part in the fall of Jerusalem. Yet even as the prophet recounts this catastrophe in the simplest of terms, he also assures that Israel will be restored and Edom will be destroyed. Obadiah

reminds us that despite our failings, in the end, God will pass a negative judgment on those who oppose Israel.

This provides the reader with a consistent message—that denial of wrongdoings does no good and that both personal and national repentance occur only when we, as individuals and as a nation, accept responsibility for our personal and collective actions. Obadiah reminds us that blaming others or declaring oneself as a "victim" never leads to personal or national healing or renewal.
