Introduction

Being faithful is one of the most important characteristics a genuine

believer and follower of God should have. In our present times, this characteristic is also one of the most tried in every Christian.

Most of us can easily say "I am a Christian" but showing it by being faithful is seemingly a very difficult task for many of us.

What is being faithful?

- Full of faith; disposed to believe, especially in the declarations of God's words and promises
- Firm to adherence to promises, oaths, treaties, and other engagements
- True and constant in affection or allegiance to a person to whom one is bound by a vow
- Worthy of confidence and belief

Our Model of being Faithful

Who should be our model of being faithful? No one else but God.

- Faithfulness is one of the characteristics of God's ethical nature.
- Faithfulness denotes God's firmness or constancy of His relations with His people.
- Being faithful is one aspect of God's truth and His unchangeableness.
- God is true not only because He is

really God, but also because He is constant or faithful in keeping His promises and therefore worthy of trust.

The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob

- This line in the Old Testament is one example of how faithful God is to His covenant.
- This is what God said when he revealed Himself to Moses.
- This shows that He is not just faithful to His promises to the Patriarch (Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob), but He continues to be faithful to Moses and to the people of Israel.

Deuteronomy 7:9 (NKJV)

Therefore know that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments

Even though we read in the Old Testament that Israel, in multiple instances, disobeyed God, He did not fail to be faithful to His covenant with them.

The faithfulness of God cannot be

made void by human faithlessness. Because the fulfilment of God's promises does not depend on human conduct but on His faithfulness.

2 Timothy 2:13 (NKJV)

If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.

God's faithfulness is His unchangeable constancy and fidelity to His covenant promises.

Romans 11:25-29 (NKJV)

God wants us to have Jesus Christ as an example in our lives. In the Book of Thessalonians 1:2-10, '2We give thanks to God always for you

all, making mention of you in our prayers, ³remembering without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father, "knowing, beloved brethren, your election by God. 5For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake. 6And you became followers of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Spirit, 7so that you became examples to all in Macedonia and Achaia who believe. ⁸For from you the word of the Lord has sounded forth, not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place. Your faith toward God has gone out, so that we do not need to say anything. ⁹For they themselves declare concerning us what manner of entry we had to you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, ¹⁰and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, even Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.'

In this passage, Paul and his companions were faithful to preach the gospel to the Thessalonians. At hindi biro ang pinagdaanan ng mga taga-Thessalonica. The people were in the midst of persecution. Nagkakaroon sila ng trade ng mga produkto. And those people just want to get income for their lives. But when Paul and his companions arrived in that place, people are responding. But because the people there do not believe in God, they are persecuting those Christians.



According to this passage, we can learn a characteristic of the Thessalonian church-they turned to God at all times. Sa lahat ng oras ng kanilang buhay after they have known Jesus Christ in their lives, they turned to God. Paano nangyari iyon? Sinabi nina Apostol Pablo, 'Remember without ceasing your work of faith.' Thessalonians have known Jesus in their lives and they worked out their faith every day. Sila ay lalo pang naghanap sa Diyos. Bata pa lang sila sa pananampalataya nila at hindi pa nila masyadong alam ang buong Salita ng Diyos, but they continued searching the Word of God. That's why their faith grew.

Ang mga taga-Thessalonica ay nagsimula nang bata sa kanilang pananampalataya pero ang importante ay hindi tinitingnan ng Diyos ang iyong edad. God does not look at your age, but God looks upon your heart—how your heart seeks God. Work out your faith. Going to church is an opportunity for you to have fellowship. FIRST FRUIT OFFERING

In the Old Testament, the word "first fruit" points to the first produce of the harvest, the portion that was first gathered and consecrated to God as an offering of gratitude (Leviticus 23:10; Deuteronomy 26:2). "The first of the first fruits of your land you shall bring into the house of the LORD your God" (Exodus 23:19). This harvest constituted the best of the first fruits (Numbers 18:12-13). The ancient Israelites were commanded to present the first sheaf of the barley harvest to the priest, who waved it before the Lord as a pledge of the full harvest that was to follow (Ezekiel 44:30).

In the New Testament, the term "first fruits" takes on a symbolic meaning. In 1 Corinthians 15:20, Paul mentioned Christ as the "first fruits of those who have fallen asleep". Jesus was God's first fruit—His one and only Son, and the best that humanity had to offer. God gave Jesus, who died on the cross and raised from the grave for us. In the same way, we are to offer the best we have for Him. What started as a specific instruction for bringing crops to the temple priest was expanded later in the Scripture (Ezekiel 44:30). It no longer refers to literal produce of the harvest-first fruits now mean any income, wealth, or blessings that a Christian has received over the course of the year that we offer to God in our church today as an offering of gratitude.



WHY READ THE BOOK OFJONAH?



Book of Jonah is the fifth of the 12 Old Testament books bearing

the name of the Minor Prophets. Jonah is portrayed as an unruly prophet who flees from God's summons to prophesy against the wickedness of the city of Nineveh. Jonah is called by God to go to Nineveh and prophesy disaster because of the city's excessive wickedness. However, Jonah feels that the city must inevitably fall because of God's judgment against

it. Thus, Jonah does not want to prophesy, because Nineveh might repent and thereby be saved.

While Jonah eventually departed and proclaimed God's message, the lesson of his story does not end there. Jonah prophesied to Nineveh but he wasn't happy about it (Jonah 4:1). The Book of Jonah teaches us that aligning our desires with God's is always a process. Just because we go through the motions of following God's will does not mean our hearts are aligned with His. God wanted Jonah's actions and his heart. And He wants ours as well.
