1 Corinthians 2:5-16 (NKJV)

God. ¹³These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. ¹⁴But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. ¹⁵But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one. ¹⁶For "who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ.

I. Introduction

a. Mind is very important to a man. It is the component of a man's soul which enables him to think.

b. The way a man thinks determines his limitation.

1. Poor mind-set – *"Basta kumain lang ng tatlong beses sa isang araw."*
2. Complacency – *"Okay lang 'yan."*
3. Lazy lifestyle – *"Bahala na."*
4. Bad character – *"Ganito na ako."*
5. Close-minded – *"Hindi ko kaya 'yan."*
6. Self-centered – *"Gusto ko."*

c. The way a man thinks affects his decision. Therefore, it impacts his future as well.

1. Planning – short-range vs long-range
2. Over-thinking – causes doubts, worries, and fears
3. Impulsive – emotions over mind

II. What is the mind of Christ?

a. The mind of Christ stands in sharp contrast to the wisdom of man (vv. 5-6).

Isaiah 55:8-9 (NKJV)

⁸"For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. ⁹"For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts."

b. The mind of Christ involves wisdom from God, once hidden but now revealed (vv. 7-9).

Luke 24:45 (NKJV)

And He opened their understanding, that they might

comprehend the Scriptures.

c. The mind of Christ is given to the believers through the Spirit of God.

1 Corinthians 2:10-12 (NKJV)

¹⁰But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. ¹¹For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. ¹²Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

d. The mind of Christ cannot be understood by those without the Spirit.

INSTILL AWARENESS, SAVE LIVES

Preparedness for natural calamities is key to saving one's life and to avoiding the worst casualties. United Christian Academy (UCA) prioritizes the safety of its students even during pandemic, showing full commitment to health and safety and educating its community about earthquake awareness and emergency response.

In partnership with the Parañaque Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (PDRRMO), UCA conducted the Earthquake Awareness Seminar and Drill last October 21, Friday, at the UCA Campus and through Google Meet for both face-to-face and online students. UCA Risk Reduction and Management Head Ms. Karen Mohammad coordinated the program with the supervision of School Head Rev. Dr. James Sy, addressing the importance of learning life-saving skills in times of earthquake disaster and emergency. The PDRRMO was headed by Mr. Renee Ebuña, alongside his team Mr. Ruben Taquiqui, Mr. Edward Reed, Mr. Rolando Floro, and Mr. Vincent Esmores, who are response experts and professional trainers.

This seminar prepared everyone for a possible emergency and gave basic knowledge that each student can apply. Truly, UCA cares for its students!

Awareness Seminar

The PDRRMO Head Mr. Renee Ebuña was the guest speaker of the earthquake preparedness seminar. He discussed what an earthquake is and how it could lead to other disasters like fire, tsunami, etc. Guidelines on what to do during an earthquake are also tackled.

Online Awareness Seminar

The seminar was also delivered to students enrolled online both in the Philippines and abroad. Students listened to the discussion and participated actively during earthquake simulation. Questions were also answered to better help them understand earthquakes.

Evacuation Drill

UCA students, parents, faculty, and staff cooperated in the activity on how to properly respond to earthquakes. Each one seriously participated in all the activities. All were alert and of sound mind as the drill happened while being observed by PDRRMO.



All students from Pre-school to Grade 12 participate in the earthquake evacuation drill. UCA's plan of evacuation is carried out properly and all protocols are applied. At the end, UCA shows its gratitude by giving out Certificates of Appreciation to the PDRRMO team.

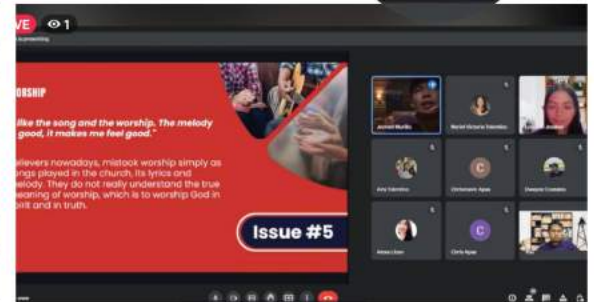
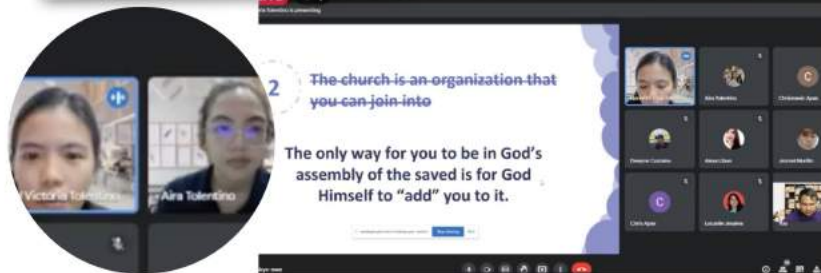
UCFTS is about to mark the end of another sequence as students present their projects last October 21 through Google Meet. Students carefully

Jesus bore our sins on the cross. Dahil sa Kaniyang pagtitiis at dahil sa mga bugbog na Kaniyang dinanas ay marami ang gumaling sa bawat karamdaman. Dahil sa Kaniya, marami ang nakatanggap. paring ang Panginoong Hesus. Nang marinig niya ang pangalan ni Hesus, bumangon siya sa kaniyang kinalalagyan. Marahil hirap na hirap siyang lumakad. Ang sabi niya, 'Mahipo ko lang ang laylayan ng Panginoong Hesus, ako ay gagaling.' Nagsumikap siyang umalis sa kaniyang kinalalagyan para makalapit. At nagkaroon siya ng pagkakataon. 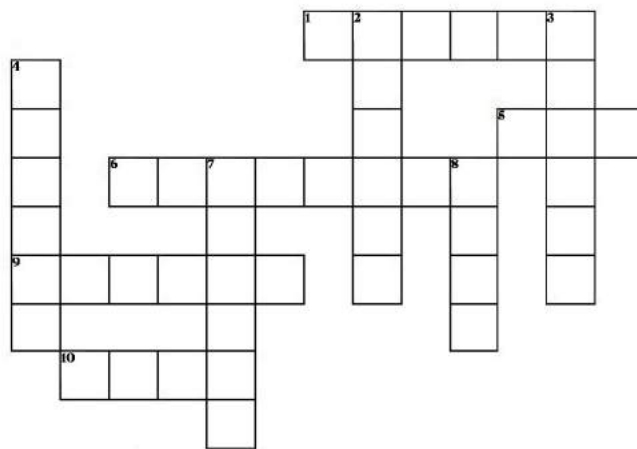

WHY READ THE BOOK OF MICAH?



The Book of Micah is the sixth book of the 12 Minor Prophets.

Most of the Book of Micah revolves around two significant predictions: one is the judgment on Israel and Judah (Micah 1:1-3:12), and the other is the restoration of God's people in the millennial kingdom (4:1-5:15). Judgment and restoration inspire fear and hope—two ideas wrapped up in the final sequence of Micah's prophecy which is a courtroom scene in

which God's people stand in trial before their Creator for turning away from Him and from others (6:1-7:20). In this sequence, God reminds the people of His good works on their behalf and how He cared for them while they cared only for themselves. But rather than leave God's people with the fear and sting of judgment, the Book of Micah concludes with the prophet's call on the Lord as his only source of salvation and mercy (7:7), pointing the people toward an everlasting hope in their everlasting God.
