Stewardship

Matthew 25:14-30 (NKJV)

¹⁴"For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them. ¹⁵And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey. ¹⁶Then he who had received the five talents went and traded with them, and made another five talents. ¹⁷And likewise he who had received two gained two more also. ¹⁸But he who had received one went and dug in the ground, and hid his lord's money. ¹⁹After a long time the lord of those servants came and settled accounts with them. ²⁰So he who had received five talents came and brought five other talents, saying, 'Lord, you delivered to me five talents; look, I have gained five more talents besides them.' ²¹His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.' ²²He also who had received two talents came and said, 'Lord, you delivered to me two talents; look, I have gained two more talents besides them.' ²³His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things.

Enter into the joy of your lord.' ²⁴Then he who had received the one talent came and said, 'Lord, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not scattered seed. ²⁵And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground. Look, there you have what is yours.' ²⁶But his lord answered and said to him, 'You wicked and lazy servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed. ²⁷So you ought to have deposited my money with the bankers, and at my coming I would have received back my own with interest. ²⁸So take the talent from him, and give it to him who has ten talents. ²⁹For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away. ³⁰And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'"

What is stewardship?

- Stewardship is the committed, consistent, and proportionate giving back of what God has entrusted to man.
- 1. Committed - stewardship entails a relationship between the giver and recipient that is built on trust
- 2. Consistent - fellowship connotes

discipline; in everything we do, we're consistently doing it back to God not because we are obligated, but because it is our duty and responsibility out of love

3. Proportionate - our stewardship must be in accordance with commitment and responsibilities

- To whom much is given, much is required.

Luke 12:48 (NKJV)

But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.

- Blessed is the servant whom his master will be found doing when he comes.

Mark 12:41-44

⁴¹Now Jesus sat opposite the treasury and saw how the people put money into the treasury. And many who were rich put in much. ⁴²Then one poor widow came and threw in two mites, which make a quadrans. ⁴³So He called His disciples to Himself and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you

that this poor widow has put in more than all those who have given to the treasury; ⁴⁴for they all put in out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty put in all that she had, her whole livelihood."

Remember the widow who gave two coins in the offering basket? Jesus said she gave more than the wealthy because she gave out of her poverty while the rich gave out of abundance.

Luke 21:1-4

¹And He looked up and saw the rich putting their gifts into the treasury, ²and He saw also a certain poor widow putting in two mites. ³So He said, "Truly I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all; ⁴for all these out of their abundance have put in offerings for God, but she out of her poverty put in all the livelihood that she had."

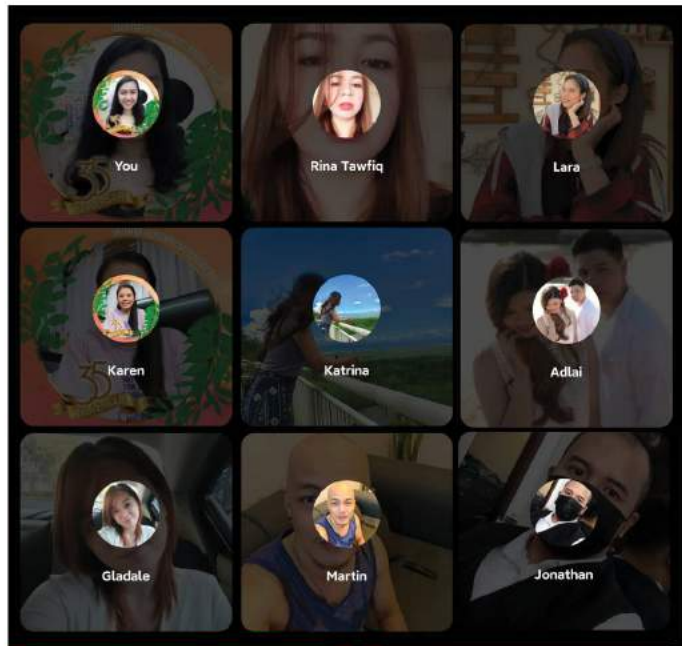
Pagkilala sa Diyos na makapangyarihan

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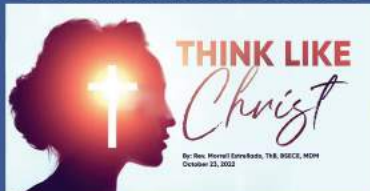

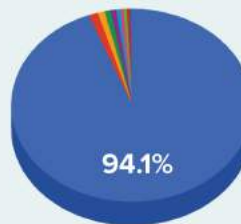

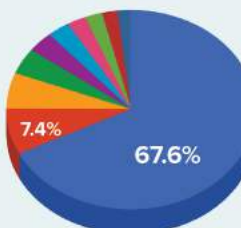
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Dapat bago ang lahat, maunawaan muna natin na ang pagmamahal sa atin ng Diyos ang nauuna sa lahat. Sa

I. Wealth

"Each one was given a talent."

Matthew 25:15

And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey.

- God is the source of all wealth.
- God gives us wealth in different proportions.

Note

- This means we are accountable for the way we use our money.
- In Acts Chapter 5, Ananias and Sapphira were judged not because they used the money. It was theirs to begin with. They were judged because they misrepresented and misused their wealth.
- It is not wrong to enjoy your God-given wealth as long as it is used responsibly.
- Having possessions is not wrong, but it is being selfish about it.
- We need to be on guard against what is called conspicuous consumption, which means obvious to the eye or mind and having too many things we cannot possibly justify.

- Test our heart
If the Lord took away all my financial resources, will I still love Him and want to trust Him or will I curse Him?
- Some false teachers teach that if we are obedient or have enough faith,

God will make us rich. The Scripture does not teach this. Job had complete trust in God but all was taken from him. The Bible does not guarantee He will bless peso for peso. Malachi 3:10 is not an insurance claim for wealth. God will bless us if we give, but the blessing is not always material.

- Our prayer regarding wealth should be as:

Proverbs 30:8-9

⁸Remove falsehood and lies far from me; Give me neither poverty nor riches—Feed me with the food allotted to me; ⁹Lest I be full and deny You, And say, "Who is the Lord?" Or lest I be poor and steal, And profane the name of my God.

- We should pray as Jesus told us—"Give us this day our daily bread."

II. Abilities

Romans 12:6-8

⁶Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; ⁷or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; ⁸he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

God has given us gifts and were told to use them well.

Three ways to use our abilities for God's glory:

- Industry
- Integrity
- Intelligent choices

1. Industry

We must make the most of our abilities and talents in applying them:

- Energetically
- Intensely
- Attentively

We should not give up easily or abandon our work halfway. We must be thorough and conscientious.

Proverbs 12:24

The hand of the diligent will rule, But the lazy man will be put to forced labor.

2. Integrity

In practicing our abilities, we must not compromise our God-given standards. No matter how insignificant the situation may be, let us not have "gray" areas in our work ethics.

3. Intelligent choices

Decisions create an atmosphere of direction, but intelligent choices should be our promise and motivation. Fear of punishments might be a hindering factor, but our decision to glorify God, at the end, should not be compromised. This attitude will help us keep things in perspective if it is God's gift to us.

III. Time

God may not have given us the same amount of wealth or the same gifts, but has given us the same 24 hours a day at our disposal. We do not differ from each other in the amount of time, but in our use of time.

Note

- If we are to be stewards of time, we need to remember the following things:
- Determine our goals.
 - When we have no goals, we are wasting our time doing useless things.

2. Detail your plans.

- Know where you're going and how to get there. Lessen your guesswork.
- 3. Do a listing.
- Write down what you need to do and not to do, so you realize which ones to do or to refuse.
- 4. Decide on your priorities.
- Do and decide the most important and valuable things to do. What are your priorities?
- 5. Do one thing at a time.
- Concentrate and focus on one item. This will allow you to get more things done.
- 6. Develop industriousness.
- Procrastination is one of the best time-killers. Learn to do things now, not later.

Conclusion

Matthew 25:24-30

²⁴"Then he who had received the one talent came and said, 'Lord, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not scattered seed. ²⁵And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground. Look, there you have what is yours.' ²⁶"But his lord answered and said to him, 'You wicked and lazy servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed. ²⁷So you ought to have deposited my money with the bankers, and at my coming I would have received back my own with interest. ²⁸So take the talent from him, and give it to him who has ten talents. ²⁹For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away. ³⁰And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'
