

# Am I Grateful?

**Luke 17:11-19 (NKJV)**

"Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. <sup>12</sup>Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. <sup>13</sup>And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" <sup>14</sup>So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed. <sup>15</sup>And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, <sup>16</sup>and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan. <sup>17</sup>So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? <sup>18</sup> Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" <sup>19</sup>And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

**Introduction**

Am I thankful or am I grateful?

- Being thankful is feeling pleased and relieved when something exciting happens.
- Being grateful is an act of appreciation under any circumstance even when nothing exciting happens.

As children of God, we should understand how to be grateful:

**I. Be grateful even if you are in difficult circumstances: Faith**

A. These ten men had the worst disease of their day: leprosy.  
 1. The physical complications are awful. Leprosy attacks the body, leaving sores, missing fingers, missing toes, and damaged limbs. In many cases, the initial pain of leprosy gives way to something more terrible than that—a loss of sensation in nerve endings, leading to more damage to more body parts.  
 2. The emotional pain of a leper, however, must have been even worse than the physical pain. He was removed from his family and from his community. There could be no contact whatsoever with his children or grandchildren.  
 3. Lepers tended to roam together, looking for food, begging for assistance from a great distance, learning to yell in loud voices, both from the need to warn others and to beg for help from across the way.

B. These ten lepers encountered Jesus, and heard Him say the most unusual thing. "We want to be well!" they screamed at Jesus. And the

great Teacher responds, "Go and show yourselves to the priest."

1. The local priest had duties other than leading worship on each Sabbath. He was also something of a health official.

2. If a person was miraculously healed of leprosy, it was up to the priest to inspect the body, to test for a complete removal of the disease, and to announce the person healed.

C. All of these lepers were no better off than they had ten minutes earlier, but they obeyed Jesus. They headed off in search of the priests. And on their way, they were healed and cleansed.

1. But in order for the miracle to happen, these men had to start walking in faith before their circumstances had changed one tiny bit.

2. You cannot wait until the problems are over to start walking in faith.

3. God gives you the opportunity to be thankful when nothing about your circumstances gives you that motivation.

**Job 2:9-10 (NKJV)**

"Then his wife said to him, "Do you still hold fast to your integrity? Curse God and die!" <sup>10</sup>But he said to her, "You speak as one of the foolish

women speaks. Shall we indeed accept good from God, and shall we not accept adversity?" In all this Job did not sin with his lips.

**II. Be grateful in the work of God's goodness: Worship**

A. One of the healed lepers came back to Jesus and glorified God. He took time to acknowledge God for His goodness.

B. This one healed leper was thankful. He thanked Jesus for what He has done to him.

C. This one healed leper was public about it. He was loud—he wasn't shy at all.

**III. Make sure your thankfulness leads to action.**

A. One healed leper came back. One caught himself in the midst of the celebration and returned to Jesus.

- 1. He put his family on hold.
- 2. He put the priest on hold.
- 3. He came back to the cause of his celebration.
- 4. His response and life situation were unique, but in the simplest sense of what he did. Thankfulness led to action.

B. He was a Samaritan from a mixed race, but still have the heart to thank and praise God for His works.

C. "Where are the other nine?" Jesus asked.

1. Jesus never commanded that any of them express thankfulness to God or return to Him, the Healer.

2. Nevertheless, that is what Jesus expected.

D. "Rise and go; your faith has made you well." This is used for people who escaped dangerous situations.

### Challenge

Are you grateful for what God has done to your life?

1. Live a life that does God's will.
2. Share to others what God has done to you.
3. Serve God with all your heart according to His call in your life.



Habakkuk is the only prophet to focus exclusively on the justice of God's rule over the world. The challenge of Habakkuk is presented as a conversation between the prophet and God, in which Habakkuk's opening complains about injustices in Judean society (1:2-4) and the violence of the Chaldeans themselves (1:12-2:1).

## WHY READ THE BOOK OF HABAKKUK?

Habakkuk was concerned that Judah was plagued with wickedness, conflict, and injustice, but it seemed as though God was doing nothing.

His concerns further grew when he learned that the Lord was planning to intervene through the "ruthless" Babylonians (1:6): How could God, who is "too pure to look on evil" (1:13), appoint such a nation "to execute judgment" (1:12) on people "more righteous than themselves" (1:13)? Habakkuk believes that the issue that has to be resolved is the

affirmation of God's character and His covenant with His people rather than His righteous response to evil (or lack of it) (1:13).

However, God makes it obvious that the corrupt destroyer would ultimately perish by itself. In the end, Habakkuk discovers how to wait on God in a spirit of worship while resting in His sovereign appointments. He learns to wait patiently in faith (2:3-4) for God's kingdom to be expressed universally (2:14).
