JESUS TEACHING IN PARABLES

In the Old Testament, it was mentioned in Psalms that Jesus will teach in parables and reveal things that are not told in their time yet. Psalms 78:1-2 says, "Give ear, O My people, to My law: Incline your ears to the words of My mouth. I will open My mouth in a parable: I will utter dark sayings of old."

In the New Testament, it was fulfilled when Jesus spoke to people in parables (Matthew 13:34-35). A parable is a way on how Jesus teaches using familiar things to explain the unfamiliar concepts of God. One of the parables that Jesus taught was the parable of the sower. In Matthew 13:3-8, Jesus tells the story of a farmer who sows seeds. By scattering them, they fell to different types of soil. Some fell along the path, some on rocky places, some on thorns, and some on good soil. While on Matthew 13:18-23, Jesus explains the parable that the seed pertains to the Word of God that is heard by many to which some understood and some did not. Those seeds sown along the path pertain to people who heard the Word but when the evil one came, he snatched away what was sown in their heart. The seeds that fell on the ground refer to people who heard the Word and received it with joy but since they have no root, they lasted only for a short time. When trials and persecution came because of the Word, they quickly fell away. While the seeds that fell among the thorns refer to people who heard the Word but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choked the Word, making it unfruitful. And lastly, the seeds that fell on good soil pertain to people who heard the Word and understood it.

Jesus said in Matthew 13:16, "But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear." Let us treasure the kingdom of God that was revealed to us through Jesus Christ. Let us walk through faith despite the trials and persecutions we will face as we continue to obey God in our life.

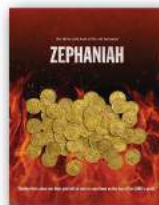
