Colossians 3:1-11 (NKJV)


Sis. Jasmin Jimenez







But God still promised. Parang isang cycle kapag tayo ay nagkakasala. We ask for forgiveness and we say sorry, ‘Lord, forgive me from my sins.’ And then, sasabihin na lang ng Lord, ‘My Son, I love you. Mahal Kita.’ Ito ang pangako ng Diyos.

God promised other signs to Jerusalem—the time to sing for joy, the time to rejoice with joyful hearts, the time not to be afraid, the time to have power with victory, the time to be rescued, the time to turn their shame to power, the time to be known, the time to be famous and praiseworthy, and lastly, the time to be prosperous again. What a promise.

Hanggang hindi talaga dumadating ang tamang oras, the great day of the Lord, the second coming of the Lord, may chance pa tayo. Pero hanggang kalian? Paano kung maabutan tayo ng paggawa ng hindi tama sa harapan ng Diyos at Siya'y biglang dumating? Nandiyan pa ba ang pangako sa atin? Hindi na natin mararanasan ang pangako na iyon when that time comes. Kailan tayo hihingi ng tawad sa Panginoon? Today, we have a chance to return back to God and to forget all those sins. Tunay na pagsamba ang hinahanap ng Diyos sa atin because as we worship, we should worship Him in spirit and in truth. That is what the Bible says.
