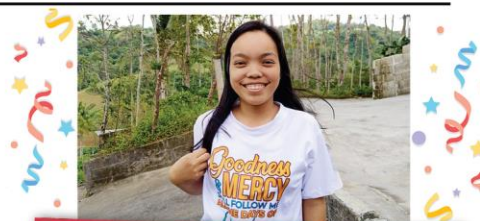

UCA is Nat'l ID registration site

At the beginning of February, a new door of opportunity was opened to United Christian Academy (UCA) as UCA was commissioned by the Parañaque City Local Government to be an on-site National ID Registration Satellite that would run from February 2 up to February 14.

To check the facilities of UCA and plan how the registration stations will be positioned, an ocular inspection was held last January 31, Monday, at the UCA Campus. It was represented by Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) staff together with the OIC of the City Civil Registrar's Office, Joan Sandil-Nemenzo, assisted by Rev. Dr. William Sy, Rev. Dr. James Sy, and Mrs. Dely Sy.



The registration was open to the public starting February 2, Wednesday, from 8:00am to 3:00pm at the UCA Campus. The said registration was overseen by the staff from the barangay office.



Other than that, UCA staff and UCF volunteers also made time to be of service to their constituents in Parañaque.

Register at <https://register.philsys.gov.ph/> (Walk-ins are also allowed starting February 2 to February 14.)

Go to the UCA Campus with your vaccination card, original Birth Certificate and two (2) valid IDs. Wear facemasks and appropriate clothes (no sleeveless).

2

Fill out the forms, take attendance, and wait in line for the biometrics.

3

Claim the form required for the release of the National ID. Keep the form and present it on the day of delivery.

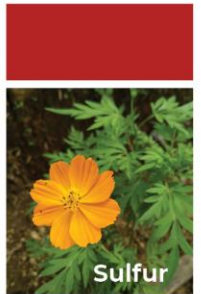

In the Old Testament, when worshipping God, some believers worshipped Him in temples (1 Kings 6). In the Book of Exodus, Moses built a tabernacle, as instructed by the Lord, called the "dwelling place" that was inhabited by the glory of God. It was a place where the Israelites could worship and honor the Lord. On the other hand, Paul and Silas worshipped the Lord even when they were in prison (Book of Acts), singing hymns and rejoicing unto the Lord even in the midst of persecutions and trials. In another account in the New Testament, specifically in John 4:24, Jesus told the Samaritan woman that worshippers must worship Him in Spirit and in truth. Worship is not about the church or the building itself, but it is about knowing the truth of God's Word and your relationship with Him as your heart yearns for the Lord. We can worship God anywhere and anytime.
