

Sustaining the peace of God: Standing fast

Philippians 4:1-7 Therefore, beloved and longedfor brethren, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the

Lord, beloved. 2I implore Euodia and I implore Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord. 3And I urge you also, true companion, help these women who labored with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the Book of Life. ⁴Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice! 5Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord is at hand. 6Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; ⁷and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Introduction

We, as believers who surrendered our lives to God, have already attained the peace with God. That means:

- We are not enemies with God.
- We are reconciled with God.
- We are in agreement with God.

Remember, genuine peace can be defined as:

- Not just the absence of war
- Not just one-sided
- It is agreed upon by both parties involved.

We are enemies of God before we surrendered to Him.

It is resolved that we, as believers. already attained peace with God. The question now is:

- How do we sustain that peace?
- How do we keep the peace of God ruling and reigning within our souls?

Peace comes through standing fast (v. 1).

- The word "stand fast" simply means to stand firm, persist, and persevere.
- It is like a soldier standing firm against the attack of an enemy. He refuses to give ground no matter the pressure applied or strength of the enemy.

Exodus 14:13-14

¹³And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. 4 The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace."

As believers, we must stand fast:

- No matter how great the trial
- No matter the pressure of temptation
- No matter the influence, offer, and allurement by the world

How do we stand fast? Stand fast in the Lord.

- By walking in prayer and praises all day long; the peace of God conquers every trial and temptation.




UCA is now a satellite registration office for the National ID. Registration started on February 2 and will run until February 14 (8:00 AM - 3:00 PM), except weekends.

The Book of Joshua is the sixth book in the Holy Bible. It was named after its main character and that man is as significant as its name, which means "Yahweh saves". After the death of Moses, God calls on Joshua to lead the Israelites. Joshua is the man who

led Israel to the Promised Land. Generally, this book records Israel's journey to what God has prepared for His chosen nation. The Book of Joshua focuses on Israel's conquest of the land of Canaan and on the distribution of the conquered territories among the Israelite tribes. It also recounts two parts of God's work of the redemption in the Old Testament period.

First, under the leadership of Moses, the Lord redeemed His people out of the bondage in Egypt and formalized his love for them at Sinai. Second, under the leadership of Joshua, the Lord as a Divine Warrior who brought His people into the land of the Promise and gave them rest.

Most importantly, the Book of Joshua emphasizes God's faithfulness in fulfilling His good promises to the patriarchs, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and the sovereignty of God in giving His people place and rest.


You can see in this book the greatness of God who fulfilled His promise, emphasizing that a battle with Christ as the King is always victorious. Read and discover God who is faithful yesterday, today, and forever. As written in Joshua 21:45, "Not a word failed of any good thing which the Lord had spoken to the house of Israel.
