

Deuteronomy 10:12-22 (NKJV)

12"And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ¹³and to keep the commandments of the Lord and His statutes which I command you today for your good? 14Indeed heaven and the highest heavens belong to the Lord your God, also the earth with all that is in it. 15The Lord delighted only in your fathers, to love them; and He chose their descendants after them, you above all peoples, as it is this day. 16Therefore circumcise the foreskin of your heart, and be stiff-necked no longer. 17For the Lord your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe. 18He administers justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and clothing. 19Therefore love the stranger, for you were strangers in

Introduction

- As we prepare for greater things from God this year, we should do the following as the Lord God requires His children:

A. To Fear the Lord your God (v. 12b, v. 20a)

- 1. To acknowledge that God owns the heaven (v. 14a)
- 2. To acknowledge that God owns the earth and all that is in it (v. 14b) 3. To fear the Lord your God is to seek and do the things that the Lord your God wants.

Proverbs 1:7 (NKJV)

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, But fools despise wisdom and instruction.

B. To Walk in All God's Ways (v. 12c)

1. To please God like what Abraham did (v. 15a)

James 2:21-23 (CEV)

²¹Well, our ancestor Abraham pleased God by putting his son Isaac on the altar to sacrifice him. ²²Now you see how Abraham's faith and deeds worked together. He proved that his faith was real by what he did. ²³This is what the Scriptures mean by saying, "Abraham had faith in God, and God was pleased with him." That's how Abraham became God's friend.

2. To live a life as to what God have called you (v. 15c)

Ephesians 4:1 (NKJV)

I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called.

1 Thessalonians 4:7 (NKJV)

For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.

C. To Love God (v. 12d)

- 1. To love God as He has loved you. (v. 15b)
- 2. To circumcise your heart (v. 16a)
- 3. Be stiff-necked no longer (v. 16b)

Mark 12:33 (NKJV)

"And to love Him with all the heart, with all the understanding, with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love one's neighbor as oneself, is more than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices."

D. To Serve the Lord your God (v. 12e, v. 20b)

- 1. With all your heart: good intentions, right attitude, best efforts, and hardworks
- 2. With all your soul: with all your emotions, mind, and will even at the point of death





- 3. Why "serve God with all"?

 a. Because of who God is (v. 17)
- b. Because of every great and awesome things God has done to you. (vv. 21-22)
- 4. By serving your brethren in need: the fatherless, widows, and strangers (vv. 18-19)

Matthew 25:37-40 (NKJV)

³⁷"Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? ³⁸When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You? ³⁹Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?' ⁴⁰And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.'"

E. To Keep God's Commandments and Statutes (v. 13)

- 1. Commandments: the comprehensive list of laws given by the Lord in the Books of Moses
- 2. Statutes: secondary laws that go further and expand upon the commandments
- 3. To God you shall hold fast (v. 20c)

Hebrews 10:23 (NKJV)

Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.


4. To God you shall take oaths in His Name (v.20d)

Psalm 116:12-14 (NIV)

¹²What shall I return to the Lord for all His goodness to me? ¹³I will lift up the cup of salvation and call on the name of the Lord. ¹⁴I will fulfill my vows to the Lord in the presence of all His people.

Challenge

- When you do these things that God requires, these are all for your good (v. 13).
- Greater things are yet to come.
- 1. Prepare
- 2. Have more of God and less of you.



The Book of Judges introduced to us various judges like Othniel and Deborah among others, who were called as the inspired leaders who rescued Israel time after time. The primary message of Judges is that God will not allow sin to go unpunished. In Judges, He disciplined them for

following other gods, disobeying His sacrificial laws, engaging in blatant immorality, and descending into anarchy at times.

The people were unfaithful to God's covenant established at Mount Sinai. Yet because they were His people, Israel repeatedly turned to the Lord for help, and the Lord listened to their cries for mercy and repeatedly raised charismatic judges to lead Israel, but they were unable to transcend Israel's anarchy and lawlessness. Due to this, the people of Israel were in danger of losing this Promised Land.
