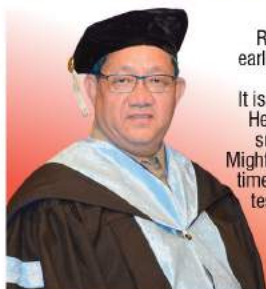

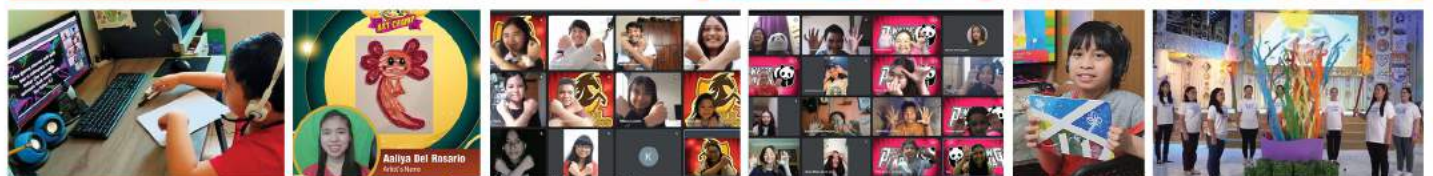

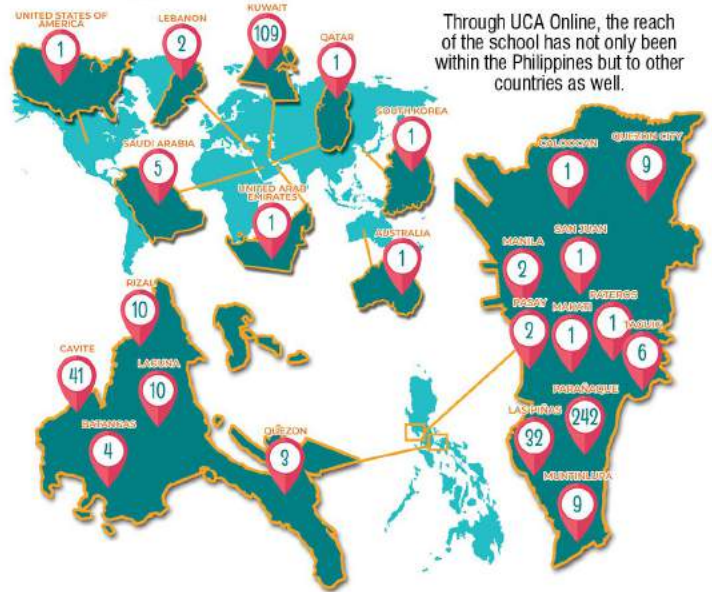

It was in 1992 that the curriculum of the Bible school was developed. The seminary was first called as United Christian Bible Training Center in 1993. In the preceding years, a number of seminarians graduated. However, the seminary had to be closed temporarily. Came 2009 that it was reopened by Rev. Dr. William Sy, and on the same year, 29 UCF workers graduated. UCFTS, today, will continue to train believers to become servants of the Lord.
