Philippians 4:6-7 (NKJV)

⁶Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; ⁷and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Introduction

This Word contains God's promise to all His children in this age, troubled and uncertain.

- Jesus said, "Do not worry."

Matthew 6:25-27 (NIV)

²⁵"Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? ²⁶Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? ²⁷Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?

- Don't worry about the basic needs of life: food, clothing, and shelter. Don't worry about tomorrow.

- Worry may be a symptom of a bigger problem. It is a lack of faith. It is a lack of trust.

- Some Christians expand the worry circle to their families, friends, and churches. They are a lot like the ten spies who spread their fear and doubt to everyone.

Numbers 13:25-28 (NKJV)

²⁵And they returned from spying out the land after forty days. ²⁶Now they departed and came back to Moses and Aaron and all the congregation of the children of Israel in the Wilderness of Paran, at Kadesh; they brought back word to them and to all the congregation, and showed them the fruit of the land. ²⁷Then they told him, and said: "We went to the land where you sent us. It truly flows with milk and honey, and this is its fruit. ²⁸Nevertheless the people who dwell in the land are strong; the cities are fortified and very large; moreover we saw the descendants of Anak there.

- But those who put their trust in God alone can stand alongside Joshua and Caleb, the only ones in the group of 12 spies who God allowed to enter the Promised Land.

- If you have Jesus, *bakit tayo mag-wo-worry?*

- We need not worry.

1.) Surrender your worries to God.

- Trust in God.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; ⁶In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

2.) Meditate on God's Word.

- Don't be afraid.

Isaiah 41:10 (NIV)

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

Deuteronomy 31:6 (NKJV)

"Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you."

3.) Worry is losing sight of God's fatherly care.

Matthew 6:26 (NKJV)

Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?

- Three times in this broader passage, Jesus says, "Do not be anxious (or worry)."

- Worry is rooted in a lack of trust in God.

- *Bakit ginawa Niyang example ang mga ibon? Why?*

- God feeds these birds every single day. If God cares enough to feed birds, how much more will He care for His children who have been redeemed by the blood of His Son?

Matthew 6:27 (NIV)

Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?

4.) Worry is the result of little faith.

Matthew 6:28-30 (NKJV)

²⁸"And why do you worry about clothes? See how the flowers of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. ²⁹Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. ³⁰If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you—you of little faith?"

- Jesus clearly tells us what's at the heart of worry—little faith, not no faith, but little faith.

Matthew 8:26 (NIV)

He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm."

Ang pamumuhay bilang isang tunay na Kristiyano ay nasilayan sa buhay ni Punong Pastor Rev. Dr. William Sy kahit na nagkaroon man ng mga pagkakataon na siya ay sinubok dahil sa mga situwasyon sa kaniyang buhay, lalo na noong siya ay nagsimulang sumunod sa Panginoon. Ngunit hindi sa sariling mga pamamaraan ang nakapagpalapit sa kaniya sa Ama, kung hindi ang Diyos mismo ang kumatagpo sa Kaniya.

"Noong una kong natanggap ang Panginoon, masyadong malalim. It was a transformation and was very life-changing on my part. Hindi ko maintindihan kasi ako iyong taong hindi basta-basta naniniwala lalo na sa mga Christian kasi diyan ako lumaki. From pre-school, I already heard the Word of God. I listened to the Gospel every week. We attended church every Sunday. We prayed every day. But all those years, I never had a conviction of receiving Jesus Christ personally in my life. I just only heard the Gospel. That's it."

Ang kaniyang simulain ay hindi naging madali upang tunay niyang maranasan ang Diyos. Mayroon siyang pagnanais na mahanap ang Diyos. Sa kabila ng lahat ng mga nagawa niya ay mayroon pa rin siyang kakulangang naranasan. Hinahanap niya ang conviction na nagmumula sa Diyos. At sa Kaniyang pagpapatuloy sa pagkilala sa Panginoon ay naunawaan niya na ang Diyos pala ang magbibigay at gagawa ng paraan upang maranasan niya ang buhay kasama ang Diyos.

"Ang buhay Kristiyano kasi ay hindi lamang tinatanggap sa bibig. Ang buhay Kristiyano ay mayroon kang tinatanggap sa

Panginoon which is the Spirit of God. When you receive the Spirit of God, there is an immerse transformation—may pagbabago. Hindi totoo na ang isang Kristiyano ay walang pagbabago."

magdidikta ng susunod kong buhay at gawain. Wala kasing nakaalam na tayo ay tunay na Kristiyano maliban sa ikaw at ang Diyos. Nobody can judge you. Walang puwedeng magsabi na 'Kristiyano ka o hindi ka Kristiyano'. It is only between God and you. Alam natin na tayo ay tunay anak ng Diyos o hindi."

Salamat sa buhay ni Rev. Dr. William Sy na nagbibigay inspirasyon at patotoo na ang Panginoon ay tunay na buhay. Marami man siyang pinagdaanan na sumukat sa kaniyang pagkilala sa Diyos, ngunit ito rin ang nagsilbing kalakasan niya na nagpatunay na si Kristo lamang ang may kayang kumilos sa Kaniyang buhay at magparanas sa kaniya ng kagila-gilalas na mga pangyayari na humantong upang siya ay magkaroon ng bagong buhay.

The UCACOA students currently enrolled in Bachelor of Technical Vocational Teacher Education (BTVTEd) participated in the program spearheaded by Dean Dr. Mary Joy Obingayan together with faculty member Ms. Karen Mohammad. The program's purpose is to help young learners increase their literacy in reading. Each UCACOA student was assigned to one student and focused on the basics of reading, such as phonics, phonemic awareness, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension. These components work together to

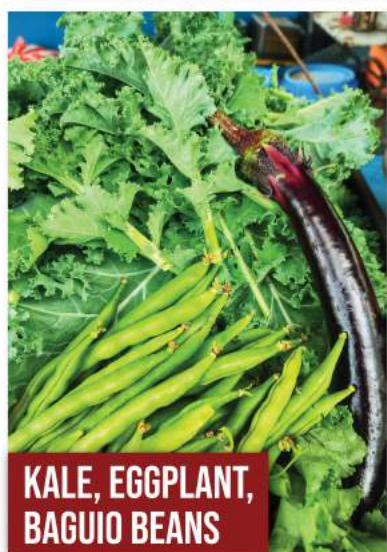

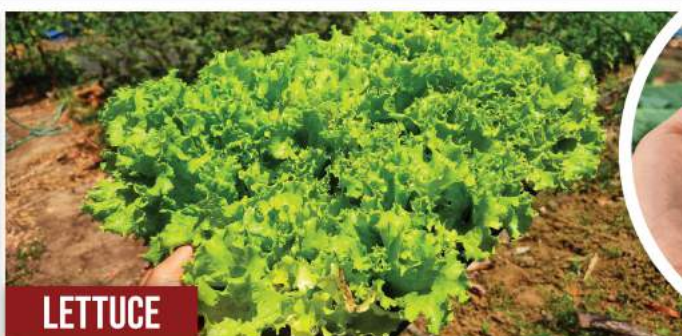
Probisyon sa ministeryo ng Mt. Tabor

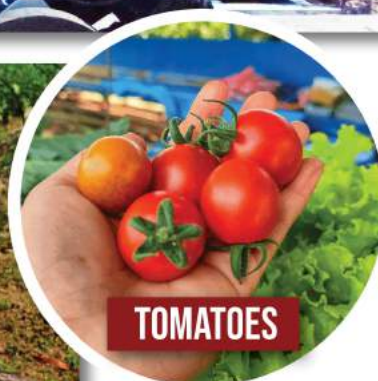

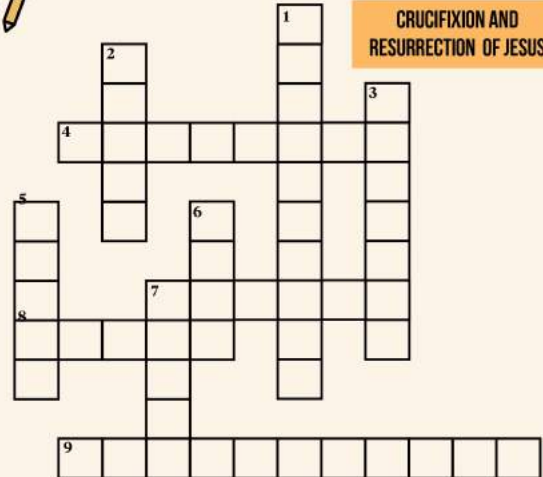

WHY READ THE BOOK OF ROMANS?



The Book of Romans is a letter, or epistle, written by Apostle Paul to the Christian church in Rome. The letter is delivered with the intention of providing encouragement, direction, and guidance to that community.

Paul started remarking the sins of all humans on the tendency of all people to fall short of the ways that we should live in the likeness of Christ. And the result of people going against God, going against what is right, is that all humanity is condemned. However, God, who is merciful and gracious, gave a way for the people to be righteous and that is through His one and only begotten Son, Jesus Christ.

It is by the sacrifice of Jesus Christ that we are saved and cleansed from all sins. But salvation is not the end of our Christian life and faith; it is the beginning. The journey that we are bound to walk on is filled with our natural inclination to sin that separates us from God. The Book of Romans tells us that we cannot make ourselves righteous on our own. Our redemption is only made possible by the mercy that God showed upon us, and now, we are led to a life spent in pursuit of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

¹¹⁹You put away all the wicked of the earth like dross; Therefore I love Your testimonies. ¹²⁰My flesh trembles for fear of You, And I am afraid of Your judgments.

- God promised His sustaining grace for tomorrow and for every day.
- Trust Him today without being consumed with worry about tomorrow.

- Learn how to live free from anxiety by meditating God's Word.

Jeremiah 17:7-8 (NKJV)

"Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, and whose hope is the Lord. ⁸For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes; but its leaf will be green, and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit."
