

1 Peter 1:13-16 (NKJV)

¹³Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; ¹⁴as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; ¹⁵but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, ¹⁶because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

A. Mentally Ready to Serve God (v. 13a)

Prepare your minds for actions. In old times, the concept of girding up is referred to the gathering up of one's robe. They tighten up a cord or tie up a rope in preparation for an action like running or any action that gives them more freedom to move unlike when the robe is on the way.

Peter applies this process to the mind metaphorically—that the way a person thinks is especially important in serving God. It is also through our minds that often kept us from fulfilling our calling in Christ.

Matthew 5:22

But I say to you that whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, 'Raca!' shall be in danger of the council. But whoever says, 'You fool!' shall be in danger of hell fire.

Matthew 5:28

But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

What are some thoughts that hinder us from fulfilling our calling?

1. Anxieties and worries

Proverbs 12:25a

Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression.

Matthew 13:22

Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful.

2. Condemning thoughts

Romans 8:1

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh,

but according to the Spirit.

3. Comparison with others

1 Corinthians 12:15-16

I am not a hand, I am not of the body," is it therefore not of the body? ¹⁶And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I am not of the body," is it therefore not of the body?

2 Corinthians 10:12

For we dare not class ourselves or compare ourselves with those who commend themselves. But they, measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise.

4. Fear of man (worrying about what others think)

Proverbs 29:25a

The fear of man brings a snare.

We must no longer conform to this world's mindset but be renewed/ transformed to the biblical mindset.

Romans 12:2a

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.

There is safety in multitude of counselors.

Proverbs 24:6b

And in a multitude of counselors there is safety.

And don't forget...

Philippians 4:8-9

⁸Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. ⁹The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.

B. Sober and Disciplined (v. 13b)

To be sober means to be free from any intoxicants. The Devil uses schemes to allure us from the truth.

Luke 15:17

"But when he came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!"

There are many Christians who are not spiritually sober. They are still intoxicated with the things of this world.

WHY READ THE BOOK OF GALATIANS?



In the Book of Calatians, Paul explains the relationship with God that is built through faith in Christ Jesus. Paul emphasizes that through Jesus' death, people are justified (Galatians 2:16). They are now adopted as children of God. Whether people have differences, they are all one in Christ Jesus. And as children of the Father, they were given

His Spirit so that they may be empowered to do good works.

Paul also reminded that as they accept Jesus in their lives, they should no longer turn back from their old and wicked lives, for when this happens, Christ's death will have no value anymore (Galatians 2:21). Those who are in Christ do not give in to the desires and passions of the flesh. Since the Spirit of God is in their hearts, they should refrain from following those in contrary to the Spirit. As believers, they should continue to do good and not easily be deceived. Therefore, as they live, they shall love one another and live by faith rather in worldly laws (Galatians 5:13).

In the final chapters of the letter, Paul clarified that justification-an act of grace through faith—need not to result in a sinful lifestyle. Because Christians have been freed from bondage of the sinful nature, we now have the righteousness of Jesus in us

1 John 2:15-16

¹⁵Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

C. Hopeful and Expectant in Future Grace (v.13c)

Hope is very important because it gives us direction, a future to look forward to.

Faith in future promises is Hope.

"Do this in remembrance of Me."

1 Corinthians 11:23-26

²³For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; ²⁴and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." ²⁵In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in

remembrance of Me." ²⁶For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

D. Obedient Children (v. 14a)

Obedience begins when you want to please your Father. Biblical obedience is beyond sacrifices (Obedience is better than sacrifice). It is seeking to do (fulfill) your Father's desire (not my will, but Your will be done).

John 14:15

"If you love Me, keep My commandments."


Conclusion
