DWELLING IN THE Presence of God

Exodus 33:1-4; 12-16 (NKJV)

¹Then the Lord said to Moses, "Depart and go up from here, you and the people whom you have brought out of the land of Egypt, to the land of which I swore to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, 'To your descendants I will give it.' ²And I will send My Angel before you, and I will drive out the Canaanite and the Amorite and the Hittite and the Perizzite and the Hivite and the Jebusite. ³Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; for I will not go up in your midst, lest I consume you on the way, for you are a stiff-necked people." ⁴And when the people heard this bad news, they mourned, and no one put on his ornaments.

¹²Then Moses said to the Lord, "See, You say to me, 'Bring up this people.' But You have not let me know whom You will send with me. Yet You have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found grace in My sight.' ¹³Now therefore, I pray, if I have found grace in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know You and that I may find grace in Your sight. And consider that this nation is Your people." ¹⁴And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." ¹⁵Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here."

¹⁶For how then will it be known that Your people and I have found grace in Your sight, except You go with us? So we shall be separate, Your people and I, from all the people who are upon the face of the earth."

I. The Promise of His Presence

A. The greatest promise the Lord has made to His people is to be present with them.

B. When God threatened to withdraw His presence, Israel regarded it as bad news.

Exodus 33:4 (NKJV)

And when the people heard this bad news, they mourned, and no one put on his ornaments.

C. Moses will not go if God's presence will not go with him.

Exodus 33:15 (NKJV)

Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here."

II. The Preparation for His Presence

A. Realize that God is ever present with His obedient children.

- It is one thing to know that God is present all the time; it is another thing to be conscious or aware of His presence. These are two different things.

Ezekiel 36:26-27 (NKJV)

²⁶I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.

B. Desire for His presence above all else.

Psalms 42:1-2 (NKJV)

¹As the deer pants for the water brooks, so pants my soul for You, O God. ²My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?

Psalms 73:25 (NKJV)

Whom have I in heaven but You? And there is none upon earth that I desire besides You.

III. The Practice of His Presence

A. Be empowered with the Holy Spirit up to the ends of the earth.

Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

B. Let the Holy Spirit dwell in you always.

1 Corinthians 3:16-17 (NKJV)

¹⁶Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? ¹⁷If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are.

1 John 3:9 (ESV)

No one born of God makes a practice of sinning, for God's seed abides in him; and he cannot keep on sinning, because he has been born of God.

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MINISTRY UPDATE



Sa nagdaang linggo ay samu't sari ang mga naging konstruksiyon sa UCF Mt. Tabor Church Re-Creation Center na siguradong magpapalawak pa ng paggamit sa ministeryo ng Panginoon.

Matthew 28:19-20 (NKJV)

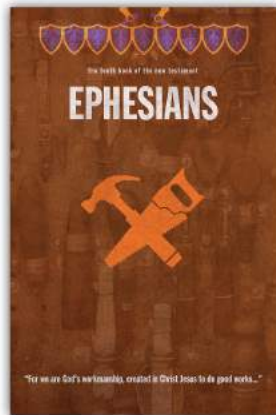

WHY READ THE BOOK OF EPHESIANS?



The Book of Ephesians is addressed to the Christians in Ephesus and was written by Apostle Paul when he was imprisoned by the Romans. This book teaches us about our identity in Christ and that He chose us in Him even before the foundation of the world as adopted sons and daughters of God to be holy and without blame before Him (Ephesians 1:4).

In Ephesians 1:7, Paul wrote that we are redeemed and are forgiven of our transgressions through the blood of Jesus Christ. After we heard the Word of truth and began trusting the gospel of our salvation, He has promised the seal of the Holy Spirit who is the 'guarantee of our inheritance' for His glory (Ephesians 1:13-14). Just as we have received Jesus Christ, we, who were once dead in our sins, were made alive in Christ as a result of His great love towards us which was demonstrated through His Son (Ephesians 2:4).

This book also discusses that salvation is a free gift of God, emphasizing that it is through faith in Jesus Christ that we are saved, not by works (Ephesians 2:8). As one body, we are now fitted together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit with Jesus Christ Himself as the chief cornerstone (Ephesians 2:20-22).

In conclusion, Paul reminded them to be strong in the Lord and the power of His might and to put on the full armor of God (Ephesians 6:10) because "we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places" (Ephesians 6:12).
